December 2009

Monthly lumber production by sawmills decreased 14.3% to 3 435.9 thousand cubic metres in December. Compared with the same month in 2008, lumber production decreased 0.9% in December.

Sawmills shipped 3 657.6 thousand cubic metres of lumber in December, a decline of 9.7% from November.
