# Crude oil and natural gas: Supply and disposition

December 2010 (preliminary)

Domestic production of crude oil and equivalent hydrocarbons totalled 15.2 million cubic metres in December, up 13.8% from the same month one year earlier.

Crude oil exports rose 2.0% between December 2009 and December 2010. About 68% of Canada's total domestic production went to the export market in December.

Marketable natural gas production totalled 14.0 billion cubic metres in December, up 2.3% from the same month a year earlier.

Domestic sales of natural gas increased 2.5% between December 2009 and December 2010, while natural gas exports rose 13.3%. Exports accounted for about 69% of marketable natural gas production in December.

Domestic production of crude oil and equivalent hydrocarbons rose 2.5% from November to December, while marketable production of natural gas rose 18.7%.
