

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## Natural gas sales

March 2011 (preliminary)

Natural gas sales totalled 8 492 million cubic metres in March, up 13.9% compared with March 2010.

The volume of sales were higher in the residential (+20.0%), commercial (+19.4%) and industrial sectors (+9.0%) in March compared with March 2010.

Total sales in March were 5.6% lower compared with February.

#### Large urban transit

March 2011 (preliminary)

Total operating revenue (excluding subsidies) for 10 of Canada's largest urban transit properties rose 6.1% from March 2010 to \$262.5 million in March.

These 10 companies represent about 80% of total urban transit across the country.

Ridership levels rose to 147.0 million passenger trips in March, a 5.7% increase from the same month a year earlier.

Preliminary data on the salaries of full-time teaching staff at 68 Canadian universities for the 2009/2010 academic year was released in *The Daily* on September 28, 2010. Additional information was released in *The Daily* on March 7, 2011.
