Aircraft movement statistics: Small airports

April 2011

The number of take-offs and landings at the 132 airports without air traffic control towers reached 54,627 movements in April. Moosonee, Ontario (4,363 movements) and Peterborough, Ontario (2,541 movements) were the most active sites. Increases were reported by 52 of the 130 airports for which year-over-year comparisons were possible.

Registrations and completions in registered apprenticeship training programs are now available for 2009. Also available are related information about trade programs, gender, age, types of certification and leavers.

Note: Data on registered apprenticeship training in 2009 are included in the Registered Apprenticeship Information System (RAIS). The RAIS database contains individual record information from 1991 to 2009, on the number of registered apprentices in a trade or occupation designed to offer apprenticeship training. In addition, it contains data on the number of certificates granted to apprentices and trade qualifiers (challengers).
