June 2011

Monthly lumber production by sawmills decreased 1.0% to 4 490.0 thousand cubic metres in June. Compared with the same month in 2010, lumber production decreased 2.3%.

In June, sawmills shipped 4 923.0 thousand cubic metres of lumber, up 6.4% from May.

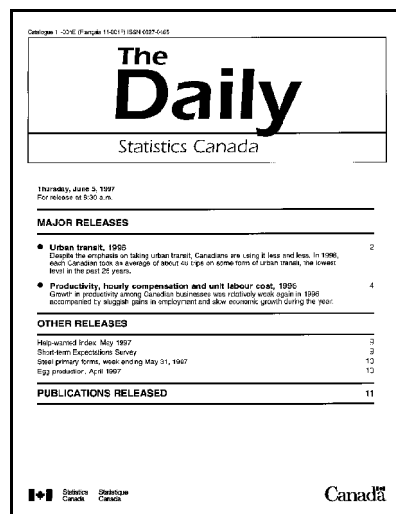
