Effective with this release of flows and stocks of fixed residential capital, estimates for table 030-0002 have been converted from a 2002 reference year to 2007 reference year. Constant dollars and the associated price index will henceforth be expressed in terms of 2007 prices. These changes affect data from 1941 to date.

Final data on domestic travel from the Travel Survey of Residents of Canada for every quarter of 2011 as well as the year 2011 are now available on CANSIM.

#### Note to readers

The Travel Survey of Residents of Canada has undergone a redesign in 2011. The survey scope is more inclusive and allows more trips to be collected. Moreover, its new design makes it easier to report trips. These changes are increasing the survey estimates from previous years. This creates a break in the domestic tourism series.
