Sawmills, February 2013

Lumber production by sawmills decreased 0.1% from January to 4 902.3 thousand cubic metres in February. Compared with February 2012, lumber production increased 4.8%.

Sawmills shipped 4 462.1 thousand cubic metres of lumber in February, up 2.1% from January.

Aircraft movement statistics: Major airports, February 2013

Aircraft take-offs and landings at the 93 Canadian airports with NAV CANADA air traffic control towers and flight service stations decreased 10.2% in February from February 2012. These airports reported 365,679 movements in February. The decline in aircraft movements can be partially attributed to the extra day in February for the leap year in 2012. The extra day in 2012 represented 3.3% of the decrease in 2013.
