Natural gas sales, March 2013

Natural gas sales totalled 9 050 million cubic metres in March, up 11% compared with March 2012.

The volume of sales to the industrial (+6.5%), commercial (+14.6%) and residential (+19.3%) sectors increased during the same period.

Total sales in March were 1.6% lower compared with February.

Aircraft movement statistics: Major airports, March 2013

Aircraft take-offs and landings at the 93 Canadian airports with NAV CANADA air traffic control towers and flight service stations decreased 1.8% in March from March 2012. These airports reported 448,480 movements in March.
