Oilseed processors crushed 537 724 tonnes of canola in February. Oil production totalled 234 430 tonnes, while meal production amounted to 305 201 tonnes.

Large urban transit, January 2014

In January, total operating revenue (excluding subsidies) for 10 of Canada's largest urban transit systems was unchanged from January 2013 at \$280.7 million.

Over the same period, ridership levels fell 0.8% to 142.8 million passenger trips.
