Annual telecommunications statistics, 2012

Operating revenues for the telecommunication industry were \$56.4 billion in 2012, up 2.0% from 2011. Over the same period, operating expenses increased by 2.3% to \$44.7 billion. This resulted in a 20.8% operating profit margin, down from 21.1% in 2011.

Mobile and paging services, the largest component of the industry, accounted for \$20.6 billion, or 36.4%, of total operating revenues.

Oilseed processors crushed 580 606 tonnes of canola in April. Oil production totalled 252 672 tonnes, while meal production amounted to 332 636 tonnes.

Moreover, its new design makes it easier to report trips. These changes are increasing the survey estimates from previous years. This creates a break in the domestic tourism series.
