Sawmills, April 2015

Lumber production by sawmills decreased 0.7% from March to 5 617.2 thousand cubic metres in April. Compared with April 2014, lumber production rose by 6.9%.

Sawmills shipped 5 434.9 thousand cubic metres of lumber in April, down 0.9% from March.

Note to readers

These data are subject to revision and are not seasonally adjusted.

The monthly survey, Sawmills, measures quantities of lumber produced and shipped by Canadian manufacturers.
