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


Quarterly Change in GDP and Exports Croissance trimestrielle du PIB et des exportations








Unemployment Rate by Age


Average Hourly Earnings and Inflation Gains horaires moyens et inflation







Taux de chômage - Provinces de l'Atlantique




CPI - Atlantic Provinces


Unemployment Rate - Central Provinces






Japan Inflation and Unemployment






Germany Inflation and Unemployment
