
### Employment and labour income Emploi et revenu du travail




### Employment in goods and services Emploi dans les industries de biens et services




### Employment/pop. ratio and unemployment Rapport emploi/population et chômage




### Participation rate by age Taux d'activité par âge












**Unemployment rate - Atlantic Provinces**  
Taux de chômage - Provinces de l'Atlantique




**Unemployment rate - Central Provinces**  
Taux de chômage - Provinces centrales




**Unemployment rate - Western Provinces**

Variation annuelle en pourcentage


