FOREWORD

Statistics Canada is almost unique among federal departments and agencies in that the principal reason for its existence is to disseminate information as a service to the Canadian public. This is clearly spelled out in Section 3 of the Statistics Act which requires the bureau to "collect, compile, analyse, abstract and publish statistical information relating to the commercial, industrial, financial, social, economic and general activities and condition of the people".

In recent years, the rapid development of information processing technology has opened up new avenues of dissemination for Statistics Canada's products, and users are increasingly taking advantage of the availability of computer tapes, special computer printouts, microfiches, interactive access to computerized databanks, etc. But for a great many Canadians, and indeed for users in other parts of the world, the bureau's statutory obligation to publish is substantially fulfilled through its range of conventional print publications.

The bureau's official publications are listed in its annual catalogue, the 1984 edition of which contains 970 currently available titles, classified according to broad subject-matter areas. About a third of these are periodical publications of up to biennial frequency presenting summary results of recurring statistical programs. There is also an extensive range of publications based on the results of the 1976 and 1981 Censuses of Population and Agriculture respectively, and some 100 occasional, or monograph, publications other than census. Most publications in the catalogue are priced and ordering instructions are included in the catalogue. Single, complimentary copies of the Catalogue may be ordered from any Statistics Canada Regional Office.

While the Statistics Canada Catalogue lists what might be called "mainstream" publications, the bureau has for many years consistently generated a small but significant quantity of supplementary documentation, in the form of technical papers and memoranda, discussion or working papers, etc. The availability of this documentation is less well-known but, in principle, it is equally available to the public and has in fact been distributed by the responsible author divisions to users who have expressed an interest in it. The reason such documentation is not publicized and made available through the formal channels referred to above is that it is often of a tentative, transitory or speculative nature, its purpose being to report on progress, to invite further discussion, or to make available useful research findings which the bureau does not necessarily wish to endorse officially. Again, this kind of information may describe methodological or operational procedures at a level of detail going considerably beyond what is required for an ordinary understanding of the bureau's statistical outputs, and will thus be principally of interest to technically specialized clientele.

Some of these departmental papers are featured in the Statistics Canada Catalogue. However, the bulk of them are contained in this publication which will be updated annually.

HOW TO OBTAIN PUBLICATIONS

1. A limited number of copies of all titles shown in this listing are available for reference in the Statistics Canada Library. Libraries may borrow any titles through Interlibrary Loan arrangements. However, in the case where the title has been published in a journal or other secondary source, libraries are asked to check their holdings beforehand. These publications are not part of the free publication service granted to selective and full depository libraries.

AVANT-PROPOS

Statistique Canada est presque unique en son genre parmi les ministères et organismes fédéraux, car son rôle principal consiste à diffuser des renseignements au public canadien. C'est ce que stipule l'article 3 de la Loi sur la statistique qui prévoit que le Bureau doit "recueillir, établir, analyser, résumer et publier des renseignements statistiques sur les mouvements commerciaux, industriels, financiers, sociaux, économiques et généraux, et sur la condition de la population".

Ces dernières années, le développement rapide des techniques de traitement des données a ouvert de nouvelles avenues à Statistique Canada pour la diffusion de ses produits, et les utilisateurs ont de plus en plus recours aux bandes magnétiques, aux imprimés d'ordinateur spéciaux, aux microfiches, à l'accès interactif aux banques de données automatisées, etc. Mais le Bureau s'acquitte de son obligation de publier en offrant ses nombreuses publications imprimées traditionnelles à un très grand nombre de Canadiens et aux utilisateurs des autres parties du monde.

Les publications officielles du Bureau sont répertoriées dans son catalogue annuel, dont l'édition de 1984 comprend 970 titres courants classés selon de grands domaines spécialisés. Environ le tiers de ces publications sont des périodiques qui paraissent à des intervalles allant jusqu'à deux ans et qui présentent les résultats sommaires des programmes statistiques à répétition. Il y a également une vaste gamme de publications fondées sur les résultats des recensements de la population et de l'agriculture de 1976 et de 1981 ainsi que quelque 100 publications hors série (monographies) autres que celles du recensement. La plupart des publications qui y apparaissent sont disponibles pour la vente. Veuillez vous référer au catalogue des publications pour connaître les directives d'achat. Une seule copie à titre gracieux pourra être commandée d'un des bureaux régionaux de Statistique Canada.

Le Catalogue énumère ce que l'on pourrait appeler les publications "régulières" de Statistique Canada, mais le Bureau produit depuis bon nombre d'années une petite quantité, mais une quantité tout de même non négligeable, de documents supplémentaires sous forme de rapports et mémoires techniques, de documents de travail, etc. L'existence de cette documentation est moins connue mais, en principe, elle est à la disposition du grand public et a déjà été distribuée par les divisions responsables aux utilisateurs qui ont manifesté le désir de l'obtenir. Ces documents ne font pas l'objet d'une publicité et d'une diffusion par les voies officielles dont nous avons parlé plus haut parce qu'ils sont souvent de nature expérimentale, transitoire ou spéculative, leur object étant de faire le point sur l'état d'avancement des travaux, de susciter des discussions plus poussées ou de faire connaître les résultats de recherches intéressantes que le Bureau ne désire pas nécessairement endosser d'une façon officielle. Soulignons que ces documents traitent de procédures méthodologiques ou opérationnelles à un niveau de détail beaucoup plus poussé qu'il n'est nécessaire pour comprendre les produits statistiques du Bureau. Par conséquent, ils s'adressent avant tout à une clientèle spécialisée sur le plan technique.

Quelques-uns de ces documents du ministère apparaissent dans le catalogue de Statistique Canada. Cependant, la plupart sont contenus dans cette publication et seront mis à jour annuellement.

COMMENT OBTENIR DES PUBLICATIONS

1. Un nombre limité d'exemplaires des ouvrages qui figurent sur cette liste peuvent être consultés à la bibliothèque de Statistique Canada. Les bibliothèques qui désirent les emprunter peuvent demander un prêt entre bibliothèques. Toutefois, lorsque l'ouvrage a paru dans un journal ou une autre source d'information secondaire, les bibliothèques sont priées de vérifier les ouvrages qu'elles ont en main. Ces publications ne font pas partie du service gratuit de publications offertes au bibliothèques de dépôt partiel ou complet.

2. In most cases the Library is able to provide only photocopies of these documents because the majority of titles are out of print. A charge of \$0.15 per page will be levied for reproduction and the Statistics Canada Library will arrange for the billing. Please do not pre-pay.
