




CENSUS • RECENSEMENT

In 2016, field crops and hay covered **92.7** million acres. Over the last 50 years the average acreage of field crops and hay has tripled to **479** acres per farm operation.

Lentil acreage has more than tripled over the last 15 years to 5.6 million acres.

Soybean acreage has doubled over the last 15 years to 5.6 million acres.

- In 2016, 1 in 6 farms reported growing canola, an oilseed developed in Canada.
