





#### RULES GOVERNING THE CLASSIFICATION OF RAILWAY EMPLOYEES AND THEIR COMPENSATION

#### 1. Classification of Employees

Employees shall be classified with respect to occupation in accordance with the definitions of classes included therein and reported on the prescribed form illustrated on page 3. Where the duties of an employee are such as to place him in two or more occupational classes, he shall be counted in that class indicated by the greater part of his duties and his time and compensation shall be distributed between the classes in which he has worked.

#### 2. Definition of Employee

The term "employee" as used herein, is intended to include any person in the service of the reporting carrier whether on a full-time or seasonal basis and subject to its continuing authority to supervise and direct the manner of rendition of his service. Persons engaged to render only specifically defined service and not subject to the continuing authority of the carrier to supervise and control their acts, such as customhouse brokers, lawyers retained only for specific cases and not under general or continuing retainer, etc., are not employees within the meaning of the term used herein.

Part time workers whose compensation is not intended to be their chief means of livelihood, such as caretakers and similar classes of workers paid stipulated amounts for performing duties requiring only a few hours each day, are not to be considered as employees (see Section 6).

#### 3. Counting Employees

Employees shall be counted once each month and the average of the twelve monthly counts, for each division entered in the column headed "Number of Employees—Monthly Average". Employees whose assigned day off may fall on the day of the count and employees absent on vacation or leave with pay shall be included in the count; employees absent on leave without pay shall be excluded.

For Divisions 1 to 67 and 80 to 84, the count for each month shall be the number of employees working on the 15th day of the month. If the 15th falls on a Saturday, Sunday or a holiday the count shall be made on the last preceding working day. Where a short time work schedule is in force the count shall be made on the working day nearest to the 15th.

For Divisions 68 to 79, the count for each month shall be the number of employees working, or available for service, or subject to call for duty on the 15th day of the month. The count shall thus include, whether or not they actually perform service, employees in assigned service, in unassigned or pool service, on relief work and those on working spare boards available for call.

#### 4. Time on Duty (To be reported in hours)

The number of hours actually worked, or held for duty under pay, are to be ascertained and recorded for every class of employee. Holidays and part holidays not worked, vacations, absences on leave, etc., whether paid for or not, shall be excluded in determining "Time on Duty". Meal periods shall be included when paid for but excluded when not paid for. These requirements apply equally to enginemen and trainmen paid on the basis of trips or miles run, employees paid at piece rates and employees paid on hourly, daily, weekly, monthly, or other time basis. For enginemen and trainmen, preparatory time, initial and final terminal time, and final inspection shall, for all reporting purposes, be considered as time worked.

Time on duty for officers and employees who do not receive payment for overtime should be reported as the number of hours in each month at 8 hours per day contemplated for the position.

#### 5. Compensation

The compensation shall be the total salaries and wages earned by the employees and charged to operating, capital and other accounts, including vacations and holidays with pay and before deduction for income tax, unemployment insurance, etc.

#### 6. Part Time Workers

All persons engaged in this type of work as defined in Section 2 shall be reported separately as provided for in the form. Time worked need not be compiled, but these workers shall be counted once each month and this information together with the total compensation they earn shall be reported.

#### 7. Joint Employees

Each person jointly employed, shall, if carried on the payrolls of the several joint employers, be counted by each employer and represented on its return of number of employees by a fraction based on the number of employers reporting him; for example, if a person is reportable by three employers, each should include him in its number of employees as one-third of an employee. When the entire compensation of a joint employee is shown on the payroll of a single joint employer and is paid to the employee by that employer, such employee should, for the purpose of returns, be treated as if employed solely by such employer.

The above rules and the following classification are solely for the purpose of establishing a uniform basis of reporting data on railway employees and their compensation in the reports to the Board of Transport Commissioners for Canada and the Dominion Bureau of Statistics and are not intended to affect in any way the working agreements between the railways and the employees nor the rates of wages.
