Vital Statistics records are collected and recorded primarily for their legal value in recording the fact that a birth, death or marriage has occurred, and certificates are accepted in most courts as "prima facie" evidence of these happenings in the lives of the individuals. Of great value to the individual indirectly and of even greater value to the State, is the use of Vital Statistics data to interpret the significance of these events in relationship to the health and welfare of the people and the application of preventive medicine to the population.

No Health Officer can expect to discharge his duties intelligently or apply control measures effectually without vital statistics. It is extremely important, therefore, that he should have detailed information as to the mass biological phenomena in the population under his immediate jurisdiction, and the adjoining health areas. To fully appreciate the significance of these data and interpret their true meaning, the Health Officer in his application of specific control measures should have a knowledge of the techniques used in the analysis of the vital statistics material.

Canada's National System of Vital Statistics is organized upon a voluntary co-operative arrangement between the provinces and the Dominion Government. One objective of the agreement entered into by the various Governments was to bring about a uniform procedure in the collection, compilation and publication of the

Vital Statistics of Canada. In trying to attain this objective it was necessary to strive for standardization in administrative techniques, uniformity in vital statistics legislation, and uniformity in the basic questions on the forms for recording and transcribing births, deaths and marriages. Much has been accomplished in this direction.

During the past decade major improvements have been brought about in the system of coding, punching and tabulating vital statistics material, but in a statistical study of the events in human life in Canada, it is essential that one should be familiar with the principles and methods employed by the Vital Statistics Division of the Dominion Bureau of Statistics, in the preparation of both Provincial and Federal Vital Statistics data. It has, therefore, been suggested that the Dominion Bureau of Statistics publish an Instruction Manual describing the details and composition of the various codes and the punching techniques employed in the preparation of Canada's Vital Statistics.

The International List of Causes of Death which is revised decennially by an International Commission is just one instance of the value of using a uniform coding system in the preparation of our vital statistics. By its use one allocates to the proper classification or code list title, the various causes of death stated on the death registrations or transcripts. This International List is now in use in practically every country collecting vital statistics as the means of indicating the mortality incidence of all diseases.

Three practical uses of such an Instruction Manual immediately come to mind, viz:

- (1) the EDUCATIONAL VALUE of indicating to the collector or registrar the type and nature of the data which should be entered in answer

- to the questions on the original registrations;
- (2) the UNIFORMITY VALUE in assembling and collecting vital statistics in the nine provinces and for local tabulation where provinces or large cities find it advisable and practical to use codes;
 - (3) the INDICATIVE VALUE to the consumer or user of vital statistics as to the composition of the classification or code list titles, published in the Provincial and Federal Annual Reports, such as - Place of Birth, Racial Origin, Religion, etc.

The Instruction Manual will, of necessity, be prepared in sections as time permits and as the sections are completed they will be distributed for use to the Provinces.

The "Classification of Occupations" and "Classification of Industries" prepared by the Census Division for the Eighth Census of Canada, 1941, will be used in coding the industry and occupation for the Vital Statistics of Canada.

PART I.

INTRODUCTION

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics is pleased to present in Part I. of the Vital Statistics Instruction Manual three codes which have been adopted for use in classification of Vital Statistics of Canada.

The code has been designed to meet three classification needs in statistical analysis, namely:

- (1) PLACE OF BIRTH
- (2) RACIAL ORIGIN
- (3) CITIZENSHIP (NATIONALITY)

The forms used in the collection of the Vital Statistics of Canada have included questions for recording data regarding PLACE OF BIRTH, RACIAL ORIGIN and CITIZENSHIP (NATIONALITY), in close alignment with similar data collected in the enumeration of the Census of Canada.

The following table shows on which of the four forms the questions appear and for whom the information is collected. Unless otherwise indicated tabulations have been made for all Provinces since 1920; except Quebec (1926) -

- (1) Recorded but not tabulated until January 1st, 1942.
- (2) Single form for Stillbirths adopted in all Provinces, information tabulated from January 1, 1941.
- (3) Information tabulated from January 1st, 1942.

The code (1) for classification of PLACE OF BIRTH has been designed to meet several group needs, namely:

- (1) Those Dominions and Colonies which comprise the British Commonwealth of Nations - the Provinces of Canada and British Possessions in America; the British Isles and British Possessions in other hemispheres.
- (2) The other Countries of the World, grouped according to location by hemisphere.

The Code (2) for Classification of RACIAL ORIGIN AND/OR CITIZENSHIP (NATIONALITY) is a single code constructed in such a way that it may be used to meet needs in coding either or both Racial Origin or Citizenship. Classification of Code List Titles indicated thus (+) have been added to facilitate special requirements.

PLACE OF BIRTH

The following definition of PLACE OF BIRTH is used in completing the Census schedules and for recording the Vital Statistics of Canada.

PLACE OF BIRTH is defined in the terms of

- (a) The PROVINCE OR TERRITORY of birth if the person was born in Canada.
- (b) The COUNTRY OF BIRTH, if the person was born outside Canada.

In recording Place of Birth for PERSONS BORN IN CANADA the accepted abbreviations may be used for Provinces, but for PERSONS BORN OUTSIDE CANADA the full name of the Country should be given, such as; England, Scotland, Wales, Northern Ireland, Irish Free State (Eire), Isle of Man, etc.

PERSONS BORN IN CONTINENTAL EUROPE should enter the country of birth as it was constituted in 1936, i.e. those persons born in what was known as Austria before the German invasion should state the Country of Birth as Austria, not Germany.

PERSONS BORN AT SEA should enter Place of Birth as "At Sea", together with the Country of the Ship's Registry if known.

RACIAL ORIGIN

For the purposes of Vital Statistics registration the following definition appears on the forms of all the Provinces:

"RACIAL ORIGIN is defined in terms of the people or race to which the person - traced through the father - belongs whether English, Irish, Scottish, French, German, Russian, Ukrainian, etc. The terms "CANADIAN" or "AMERICAN" should not be used for RACIAL ORIGIN, as they express CITIZENSHIP (NATIONALITY)."

Origin is said to carry with it certain hereditary traits, variations and susceptibilities and its inclusion in the Vital Statistics of Canada is of utmost importance to those persons interested in the study of "mankind in the aggregate". This is particularly true in public health research, for racial tendencies may be a determining factor in the application of measures for disease prevention and control.

The North American Indian is said to be highly susceptible to Tuberculosis, in fact data already analyzed would tend to indicate that this may be true, while on the other hand the Jewish people are said to show a very low death-rate from Tuberculosis and a high death-rate from Cancer and some of the other diseases. Again, others claim racial tendencies have an important bearing on Fertility. These statements are then conclusive proof of the value of studying racial phenomena in close relation to the incidence of disease, the age of the population, the religious beliefs of the population and the biological and sociological phenomena. In a young country like Canada, comprising as it does a population of many widely divergent types of people, through immigration from Europe, Africa and Asia an excellent opportunity is afforded for

comprehensive racial analyses.

The Racial Groups used in the compilation of the Vital Statistics of Canada conform to the groupings used in the Census. While not ethnologically correct, they have been designed to meet modern requirements of specific groupings of immigrants or ethnic communities and their progeny within the population.

The term "RACIAL ORIGIN", then, is used in relatively the same sense as that outlined in a former publication of the Dominion Bureau of Statistics.

USE OF THE TERM "ORIGIN" AS DISTINGUISHED FROM "RACE" (1)

"In a strictly biological sense, the term "race" signifies a subgroup of the human species related by ties of physical kinship. Scientists have attempted to divide and subdivide the human species into groups on the basis of biological traits, such as shape of the head, stature, colour of skin, etc., and to such groups and to such only, would the biologist apply the term "race". The use of the term, however, even in this strictly scientific sense is neither definite nor free from confusion, for there is no universally accepted classification. Furthermore, the identification of certain types of culture with definite biological types has led inevitably to the result that, even in the hands of the ethnologist, the term "race" has acquired a cultural as well as a biological implication.

Most modern national groups are composed of widely varying racial strains. The English type, if such exists in the biological sense, is the product of the commingling of perhaps half a dozen primitive stocks. The same applies to the French, Italians and indeed to any European group. Whether these peoples, during the past thousand years, have evolved distinct and homogeneous biological types which would approximately be termed "races" is a matter for debate. Homogeneity is always relative; so with race differentiation. The technical biological question as such, however, is of minor importance as far as the census is concerned. Even in

(1) Origin, Birthplace, Nationality and Language of the Canadian people.

such cases as Scottish and Irish, where it is well known that distinct strains exist, the cultural consideration is predominant.

The significant fact in the present connection is this. The combined biological and cultural effect on Canada of the infiltration of a group of English is clearly different from that produced by a similar number of, say, Ukrainians coming to the country. This is partly due to the different biological strains and partly to different cultural environment in the home country. It would be futile from a practical point of view to attempt to separate the biological and the cultural influence. It is known, for example, that biologically the Orientals are not assimilable in Canada, even if culturally assimilation were possible. On the other hand, neither Mennonites nor Doukhobors are easily assimilated culturally, though biologically an infusion could be effected. But the relative importance of the biological and cultural factors is not subject to quantitative measurement. Both, however, are combined under the term "origin".

The term "origin", therefore, as used by the census, usually has a combined biological, cultural and geographical significance. It suggests whence our people come and the implied biological strain and cultural background. Following popular usage, the terms, "English stock", "French stock", "Italian stock", etc., are employed to describe the sum total of the biological and cultural characteristics which distinguish such groups from others. Such usage is familiar to the public in general, and only when our "origin" classifications follow such lines, can they be collected by a census, be understood by the people or have any significance from the practical standpoint of the development of a Canadian nation."

In determining Racial Origin - "descendants of a common ancestor"- and in completing entries dealing therewith some of the difficulties which arise may be overcome by referring to the following paragraphs taken from "Instructions to Commissioners and Enumerators" for the Eighth Census of Canada, 1911, and made apply to the requirements of Vital Statistics.

- "(a) It is imperative to understand that a person's racial origin, and citizenship (nationality) very often are different, for instance the Canadian citizenship comprises many different racial origins, e.g., English, French, Irish, Scottish, Welsh, Italian, German, etc.

- (b) The name of a country from which a person came to Canada gives no indication of that person's racial origin, e.g., a person may have come to Canada from Austria, but may be Polish, or German, or Italian, etc. A striking example are the Ukrainians (Ruthenians). They have no Ukrainian (Ruthenian) citizenship (nationality), but have come to this country from the nations of Poland, Russia, Austria, Hungary, and other nations of Europe through which they are dispersed. No matter what country they come from, their racial origin is "Ukrainian".
- (c) The word CANADIAN does not denote a racial origin, but citizenship (nationality); the same applies to the word AMERICAN.
- (d) It is, therefore, necessary for the Enumerator to ascertain a person's racial origin separately from his country of birth, or citizenship (nationality)."

WHAT DETERMINES RACIAL ORIGIN? As a general rule a person's racial origin is to be traced through his father, e.g., if a person's father is English and his mother French, the racial origin shall be entered as English, while a person whose father is French and whose mother is English shall be entered as French, and similarly for other combinations.

- (a) CANADIAN ABORIGINES. For the Canadian aborigines, the entry will be Indian or Eskimo as the case may be. For a person of White and Indian blood, the entry shall be "Half-Breed".
- (b) COLOURED STOCKS. For persons belonging to stock involving difference in colour (i.e., the black, yellow and brown races) the entry shall be Negro, Japanese, Chinese, Hindu, Malayan, etc., respectively, thus indicating the branch within the distinct ethnic stock, to which such persons belong.
- (c) MIXED BLOOD. The children begotten of marriages between white and black or white and Chinese, etc., shall be entered in the Column as Negro, Chinese, etc., as the case may be."

Special provision has been made for a uniform decision of choice in cases where indefinite terms are used to express "Racial Origin" and no further qualification of the terms can be obtained.

For instance such terms as Costa Rican, Panaman, Bolivian, Chilean and Mexican are met with, and, as the people of these countries who come to Canada are predominantly of Spanish descent, the Racial Origin has been assigned to "Spanish", Code List Title 72. Native Indians and Mestizos (Half-Castes) of Central and South American countries very rarely migrate to Canada. When encountered in the Vital Statistics of Canada, the former are assigned to "Indian (not a word of Canada)", Code List Title 16; the latter to "Half-breed", Code List Title 17.

Similarly when the term "Brazilian" is used the Racial Origin has been assigned to "Portuguese", Code List Title 70, as the people of Brazil are, for the most part, of Portuguese descent.

Likewise the indefinite terms "American", "British" and "Canadian" when used to express "Racial Origin" have been assigned to Code List Titles 99 "Unspecified or Unknown" and 37 "Other British Races", respectively.

CITIZENSHIP

For Vital Statistics purposes the following definition appears on the registration forms of all provinces:

"Citizenship (Nationality)" is defined in terms of the Country to which the person owes allegiance. The term "Canadian" should be used as descriptive of a person who was born in Canada or who has rights of citizenship in Canada, unless he or she has become the citizen of another country."

Questions concerning the citizenship or nationality of the population have been included in the Censuses since 1901. The inclusion of such a question in the Vital Statistics forms is of fairly recent origin dating from the latter part of the year 1932.

The Vital Statistics Section of the Canadian Public Health Association at the Annual Meeting in May, 1932, passed a resolution recommending to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics that the addition of an extra question as to Citizenship (Nationality) be provided in the Vital Statistics forms.

Nova Scotia was the first province to include a citizenship question regarding the father and mother of the child on the form for registration of births. The following list shows the date of approval by each province:

When the new death certificate was adopted in Canada in January, 1935, the question regarding Citizenship of the deceased was added to the forms for all provinces.

The Citizenship question on the birth and death forms has proven so useful that some of the provinces are considering the inclusion of similar questions concerning the Bridegroom and Bride on their marriage forms.

Legally this question has been of real value, both to the individual and to various agencies of the Government, in establishing citizenship rights. Proof of Citizenship is of importance in obtaining employment in war industries, defence and enlistment in mechanized units, etc.

Statistically Citizenship is of importance in providing valuable data on migration and the numerical and geographical distribution of the various nationals within the population.

The Census being again the source of basic citizenship material, we must follow closely its methodology of recording. The following is a summary taken from the "Instructions to Commissioners and Enumerators" for the 1941 Census regarding the recording of Citizenship (Nationality).

"A Canadian is a person who is a national of Canada. The following are nationals of Canada.

- (a) EVERY PERSON BORN IN CANADA, unless such a person has become the citizen of another country.
- (b) EVERY PERSON BORN OUT OF CANADA, whose father was a Canadian citizen at the time of that person's birth, unless such a person has become the citizen of some other country.
- (c) EVERY BRITISH SUBJECT who has lived in Canada for five years after his entry as an immigrant. A British subject born outside of Canada does not become a Canadian citizen until Canadian domicile has been acquired. A British subject can only acquire Canadian domicile by living in this country for a period of five years after his entry as an immigrant.
- (d) A PERSON NATURALIZED under the laws of Canada who has not subsequently become an alien or lost Canadian domicile.

The following general instructions on who is a British subject are given by the Naturalization Branch for the guidance of Enumerators.

BRITISH SUBJECT BY BIRTH. Any person born within the British Empire or on board a British ship is a British subject by birth. (See names of countries in Tabular List of Place of Birth Code - Code List Titles Nos. 1 to 37.) It will be observed, however, that persons born in the above countries may have become citizens of another country.

ANY PERSON BORN ANYWHERE OF NATURAL BORN BRITISH SUBJECT PARENTS - e.g., a child born in the United States of America of a British subject father is a British subject. The naturalization of the father in the United States of America after the birth of the child in that country does not affect the British status of the child.

ANY PERSON BORN IN A FOREIGN COUNTRY since the 1st of January, 1915, of a father who is a British subject by naturalization is a British subject unless he or she has renounced British nationality after becoming of age.

PERSONS OF THE SECOND OR FURTHER GENERATION (i.e., children, grandchildren, etc., of a man born in a foreign country of parents who were British subjects) born in a foreign country since 1922 are deemed to be British subjects only when their births have been registered with a British Consul. This is provided, of course, that the father had not renounced his British citizenship prior to the birth of the child.

BRITISH SUBJECT BY NATURALIZATION. Prior to 1915, naturalization granted in Canada as well as in England and other British Dominions was only local - that is, the person naturalized was not considered to be a British subject outside the frontiers of the country in which naturalization took place.

Since 1915 any person naturalized in Canada or England is considered to be a British subject throughout the world, as well as a person naturalized in Newfoundland since the 14th of May, 1916, in Australia since the 1st of January, 1921, and in South Africa since the 21st of May, 1926. Consequently, are in Canada deemed to be **BRITISH SUBJECTS BY NATURALIZATION**:

1. Any person naturalized in Canada prior to 1915.
2. Minor children of parents becoming naturalized in Canada prior to 1915, if such children were residing in Canada at the time of the naturalization of their parents or

came to Canada, as minors, after the naturalization of their parents but before January 1st, 1915, although their names were not endorsed on the naturalization certificate of their parents.

3. A person naturalized in Canada and England since 1915; in Newfoundland since the 14th of May, 1916, in Australia since the 1st of January, 1921, and in South Africa since the 21st of May, 1926, as well as their foreign-born children whose names have been endorsed on the naturalization certificate.

Note: Adoption or subsequent change of nationality of foster parents does not affect in Canada the status of adopted children. Similarly, the re-marriage of a woman or the subsequent change of nationality of her husband does not affect the status of her children by a previous marriage.

It is to be carefully noted that a married woman does not now automatically become naturalized when her husband is naturalized, so that a married woman's nationality must now be ascertained separately and independently from that of her husband.

BRITISH SUBJECTS BY MARRIAGE:

1. MARRIAGE TO A BRITISH SUBJECT. A woman who marries a British subject shall be deemed to be a British subject even when her name does not appear on the husband's certificate of naturalization.
2. NATURALIZATION OF HUSBAND prior to January 15, 1932. The wife of a man naturalized prior to the 15th of January, 1932, is a British subject with the husband, even when her name does not appear on the certificate.
3. NATURALIZATION OF HUSBAND on or after January 15th, 1932. In the case of a man naturalized on or after the 15th of January, 1932, the wife shall not be deemed to be a British subject unless a certificate has been subsequently issued to her personally.
4. WOMAN MARRYING AN ALIEN before January 15th, 1932. Marriage to an alien prior to the 15th of January, 1932, caused a woman to lose her British nationality.
5. WOMAN MARRYING AN ALIEN after January 15th, 1932. Since the 15th of January, 1932, a woman does not cease to be a British

subject on marrying an alien unless she acquires the foreign nationality of her husband by this marriage. She does not lose British nationality by marriage to a citizen of the United States of America, France, the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics (U.S.S.R.), Argentina, Cuba, Guatemala and Uruguay.

6. CHANGE IN NATIONALITY OF HUSBAND prior to January 15th, 1932. Prior to the 15th of January, 1932, the naturalization in a foreign country of a male British subject caused, in every case, the loss of British nationality for his wife.
7. CHANGE IN NATIONALITY OF HUSBAND since January 15th, 1932. Since the 15th of January, 1932, the naturalization of a male British subject in a foreign country causes the loss of British nationality for his wife only when on account of the change of his nationality she acquires with him the new nationality.
8. WIDOWS. The death of a man does not affect the present status of his widow.

OTHER THAN CANADIAN. When a person living in this country is not a Canadian citizen his or her citizenship (nationality) shall be shown by entering the name of the country of which such a person is a citizen, as - "England", "France", "Italy".

LOSS OF BRITISH NATIONALITY. As British nationality may be lost by naturalization in a foreign country, by declaration of alienage, and in certain cases by marriage or by the revocation of naturalization by the Governor in Council, it is important whether or not the person has lost his or her British nationality. In the affirmative, this would also affect minor children whose names appear on the certificate.

STATELESS PERSONS. There is in Canada a certain number of persons who do not owe allegiance to any country. This is due mainly to the fact that they have lost their foreign nationality by taking the oath of allegiance to His Majesty, during the last war, or to other causes, and have not acquired British nationality. In such cases, enter "stateless".

For the reasons given above it is necessary to ascertain the nationality of all wives married since January 15th, 1932, and whether British nationality has been lost through one of the reasons given or whether the person has become stateless."

The term "American" has from common practice been used to express citizenship for nationals of the United States of America, while "British" which embraces citizenship of all nationals within the Commonwealth of Nations, when used without qualification, has been assigned to Code List Title 37 "Other British Citizenship".
