FARM WAGES IN CANADA

Ottawa, June 21, 1947: The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues today a Aletin giving the average rates of wages paid to male hired help on farms as at May 15. erage wage rates are shown on the basis of rates paid with board provided by the uployer, and without board. The figures included in this report were provided by farm rrespondents located in all provinces of Canada.

FARM WAGE RATES - MAY 15, 1945, 1946 AND 1947

Scarcity of labor and the maintenance of a high level of farm income has shed the May wage rates for farm workers to their highest level since comparable atistics became available in 1940. With the month of August usually marking the high oint for farm wages in any year, it is significant to note that current May wages in my provinces were approximately the same as those prevailing at August 15, 1946. The case of monthly wages with board, British Columbia farm wages led the celd, while Frince Edward Island set the pace for minimum rates of pay. The average tes for Canada as reported at May 15, 1947 were \$3,59 per day and \$77.01 r month where the employer provided the board as compared with rates of \$5.25 and 1.36 respectively at the same date a year ago. Where the employee provided his own eard, the average rates were \$4.55 per day and \$103.96 per month respectively as against 1.15 and \$96.27 as reported at May 15, 1946.
