FARM HAGES IN CANADA 1 , JANUARY 1951
Ottawa, Varch 3, 1951.- The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues today estimates of wages paid to male hired Lelp on farms as at January 15, 1951 and, for comparative purposes the corresponding figures for 1949 and 1950. Average wages rates are shown on the basis of rates paic with bourd provided by the employer, and without board. Fine estimetes contained in tinis bulletin are based on reports provided by ferm correspondents located in all provinces in Canada. The number of reports received from each of the haritime Provinces was insufficient to provide reliable averape wace rates for these provinces. Consequently it bas been necessary to combine them in the presentation of these data.
