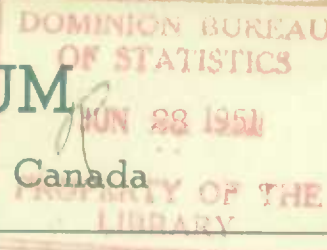

FARM WAGES IN CANADA 1/, MAY 1951

OTTAWA, June 22, 1951: Today the Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues a bulletin giving the average rates of wages paid to male hired help on farms as at May 15, 1951 and, for comparative purposes, the corresponding figures for 1949 and 1950. Average wage rates are shown on the basis of rates paid with board provided by the employer, and without board. The figures included in this report were provided by farm correspondents located in all provinces of Canada.
