FARM JES 1 COMA VALVA JULIY 1952

Ottawa, March 7, 1952.— The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues today estimates of wages paid to male hired help on farms as at January 15, 1952 and for comparative purposes the corresponding figures for 1950 and 1951. Average wage rates are shown on the basis of rates paid with board provided by the employer, and without board. The estimates contained in this bulletin are based on reports provided by farm correspondents located in all provinces in Canada. The number of reports received from each of the Maritime Provinces was insufficient to provide reliable average wage rates for these provinces. Consequently it has been necessary to combine them in the presentation of these data.
