Ottawa, April 20, 1928. The Dominion Bureau of Statistics reports the receipt of a cablegram from the Canadian Trade Commissioner at Buenos Aires communicating the third official forecast of the yields of wheat, flaxseed and oats in Argentina for the season 1927-28; Wheat 239,201,000 bushels from 19,645,000 acres, as compared with 220,826,000 bushels from 18,260,000 acres in 1926-27, and with 203,387,000 bushels from 16,160,000 acres, the annual average for the five years, 1921-22 to 1925-26; Flaxseed 79,524,000 bushels from 6,919,000 acres, as compared with 69,092,000 bushels from 6,228,000 acres in 1926-27, and with 52,359,000 bushels from 4,936,000 acres, the five year average; Oats 49,280,000 bushels from 3,163,000 acres, as compared with 66,276,000 bushels from 2,219,000 acres in 1926-27, and with 59,286,000 bushels from 1,824,000 acres, the five year average.
