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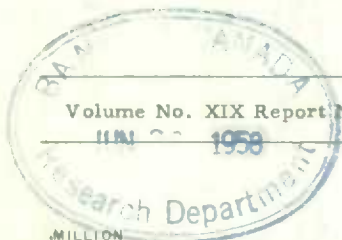
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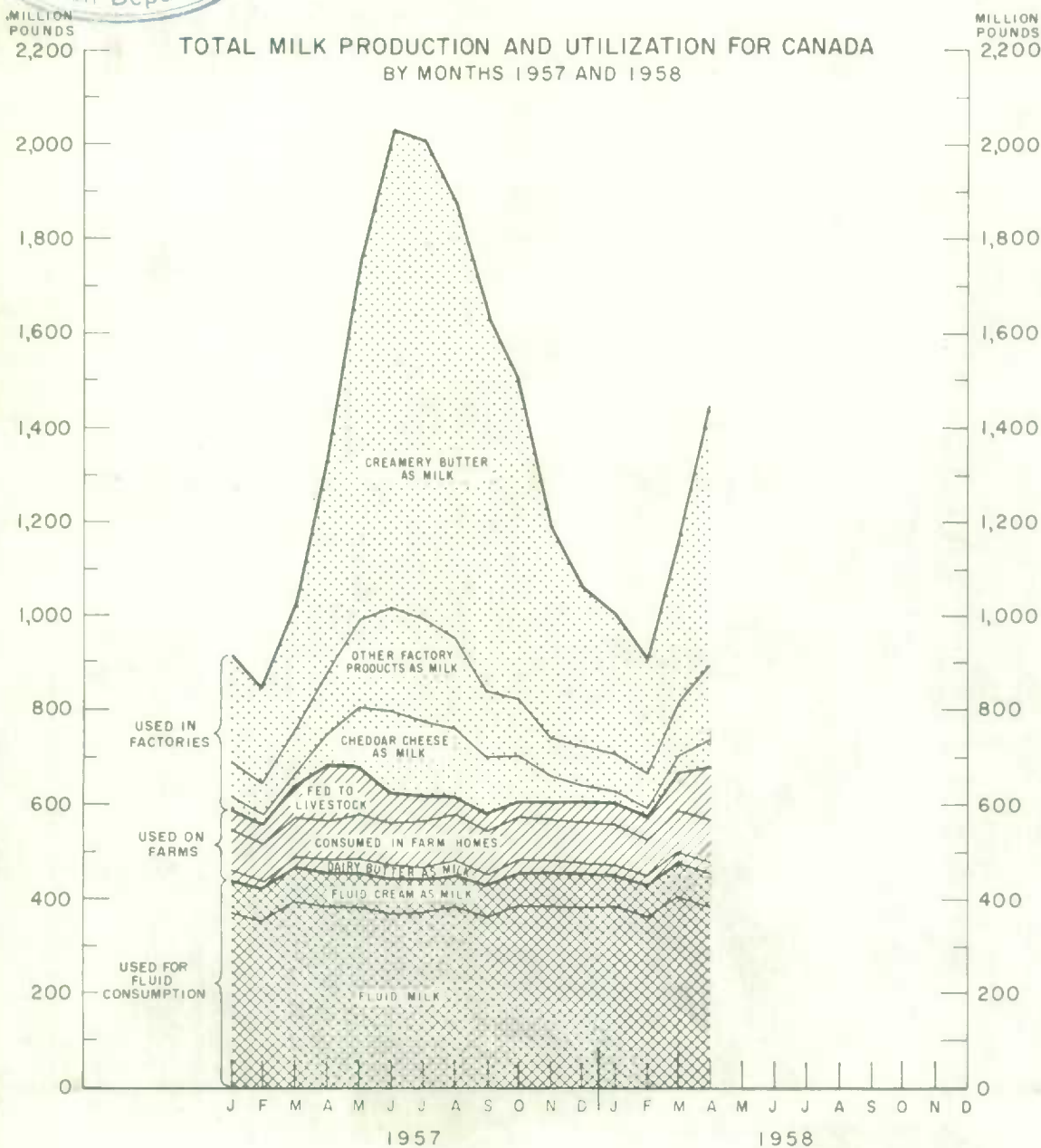

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THE DAIRY SITUATION, MAY 1958

Total production of milk on Canadian farms during the month of May is tentatively estimated to have been about 1,831,000,000 pounds, 4.1 per cent more than in May 1957. Cumulative January-May milk production would then have been about 6,347,000,000 pounds or 8 per cent more than the first five months of 1957.

In May, the increase in milk utilized for the manufacture of dairy factory products over the same month last year was less pronounced than the corresponding increase shown in previous months this year. Creamery butter and concentrated whole milk products, the two most important dairy factory classifications, continued to use more milk than the same month last year, although the percentage increase over the corresponding month in 1957 was the smallest to date this year. Milk used for cheddar cheese manufacture was sharply down from May 1957, and less milk was used this May for ice cream manufacture. The table below shows a more detailed analysis of these products both on a January to May and on a May comparison basis.

Sales of fluid milk and cream for the three months of February, March and April exceeded the corresponding sales last year by 1.4 per cent and fluid sales in May, for the purpose of the tentative estimate, are assumed to have exceeded those of May 1957 by about 1.4 per cent also.

Indications from the Dairy Correspondent's monthly survey are that 1.5 per cent more milk was consumed in farm homes and 6.3 per cent less milk was fed to livestock in May 1958 than in the corresponding month in 1957. On a cumulative basis, milk consumed in farm homes exceeded last year by 1.6 per cent while milk fed to livestock exceeded last year by 2.6 per cent. Less milk was fed to livestock in April and May 1958, which appears to be compensation for the sharp increase over last year in milk fed to livestock through February and March. The number of calves fed whole milk was higher than last year in February and March, the same in April, and lower than last year in May. Dairy butter production in April, was very close to that for the same month in 1957.

The monthly survey also shows cow numbers to be down 2 per cent from May 1957 and cows milked to be down 2.1 per cent. This is the first month in 1958 that fewer cows have been milked than in the corresponding month in 1957. The decrease in cow numbers was more than compensated for by the increase in production per cow.

The weather in May was favourable to dairying in all regions except the Prairies. Most cattle were turned out to pasture in May. The Maritimes experienced a cool, cloudy month and moisture conditions were adequate to bring on pasture and hay in quantity. Some Maritime correspondents reported pasture damage caused by cattle trampling wet pastures. Cool weather was also experienced in Quebec and Ontario, and pasture growth was slow, many cattle not being turned out until the latter part of the month. On the prairies, spring began early, but was temporarily set back by the blizzards which occurred in late April. Moisture conditions were adequate to start growth in early May, but high winds and lack of rain depleted the moisture supply until by the end of May, pasture growth had been significantly retarded and rain was badly needed. A different picture is true for British Columbia where warm weather has advanced the season by about two weeks and pastures are reported to be in good condition.

FARM MILK PRODUCTION, UTILIZATION AND INCOME IN APRIL, 1958

Farm Milk Production: The estimated quantity of milk produced on farms in April amounted to 1,445,739,000 pounds. This represents an increase of 105 million pounds or 7.8 per cent above that of April, 1957. Of this amount, 765 million pounds or 52 per cent was utilized in factory production, while fluid sales absorbed approximately 455 million pounds or 32 per cent of the total milk supply. During January-April the estimated production was 4,515 million pounds, an increase of 396 million pounds more than that produced in the same period of the previous year. The quantity of milk utilized for factory production in January-April amounted to 1,987 million pounds while fluid sales accounted for 1,813 million pounds.

Fluid Sales: Sales of fluid milk and cream, the latter expressed as milk, amounted to 455,231,000 pounds in April, a decrease of approximately 1 million pounds in comparison with April of the previous year. This included about 385 million pounds of fluid milk, comprising about 27 per cent of the farm milk supply, and fluid cream sales of 70 million pounds representing 5 per cent. During the four month period, January-April, fluid sales totalled 1,813,167,000 pounds, an increase of 32 million pounds or approximately 1.8 per cent over those of the 1957 period.

Dairy Butter: The dairy butter make in April amounted to 1,060,000 pounds, increasing 1 per cent over the corresponding month in 1957. For the four months, January-April, 3,672,000 pounds were produced, also an increase of 1 per cent over the same period last year.

Farm Cash Income: Cash income from the sale of dairy products in April amounted to \$38,381,000. This represented an increase of approximately 11.8 per cent or \$4,051,000 in comparison with the same month last year. The weighted average price of \$3.14 per hundred pounds of milk was 6 cents higher than in April, 1957. Fluid milk at \$4.63 per hundred was 15 cents higher than April, 1957. Creamery butter-fat increased from 60.7 cents to 65.7 cents per pound, and dairy butter at 61 cents was 2 cents higher than in April, 1957. Milk used in manufacture increased from \$2.77 per hundred in April, 1957, to \$2.83 per hundred in April, 1958. Cheese milk declined to \$2.53 per hundred, a decrease of 3 cents per hundred in comparison with the same month a year earlier.

PRODUCTION AND PRICES OF DAIRY PRODUCTS IN APRIL, 1958

BUTTER

Production: Total butter production including creamery, dairy and whey butter amounted to $24\frac{3}{4}$ million pounds in April, 1958. This was 4 million pounds or approximately 19 per cent more than that produced in the same month of the previous year.

Stocks: Holdings of butter in store and transit on May 1 amounted to $35\frac{1}{4}$ million pounds, approximately $1\frac{1}{2}$ million pounds less than last year. On April 1, 1958, the stock holdings of $37\frac{1}{4}$ million pounds represented a decrease of $6\frac{3}{4}$ million pounds as compared with the previous year.

Supply: The quantity of butter represented by stocks on April 1, plus production and imports during April, amounted to 62 million pounds. This was a decrease of approximately $2\frac{3}{4}$ million pounds in comparison with April, 1957.

Domestic Disappearance: The domestic disappearance of butter in April, including creamery, dairy and whey butter, amounted to $26\frac{3}{4}$ million pounds, a decrease of $1\frac{1}{4}$ million pounds or 4 per cent. On a per capita basis the domestic disappearance amounted to 1.58 pounds as compared with 1.58 pounds a year ago.

Prices: Butter prices at Montreal, based on dealers' quotations for first grade solids, averaged $62\frac{1}{4}$ cents per pound in April as against 58 cents last year.

CHEDDAR CHEESE

Production: Cheddar cheese production amounted to approximately $5\frac{1}{4}$ million pounds, representing a decrease of about $\frac{1}{2}$ million pounds as compared with that produced in the same month of the previous year.

Prices: The Montreal price of Ontario coloured cheese averaged $34\frac{7}{8}$ cents per pound in April. The comparative price in 1957 was $35\frac{3}{8}$ cents.

CONCENTRATED MILK PRODUCTS

The total quantity of concentrated milk products manufactured in April was approximately $54\frac{1}{4}$ million pounds, an increase of 10 million pounds as compared with last year. Concentrated whole milk products increased 4 million pounds while milk by-products increased 6 million pounds. Evaporated milk, the most important of the whole milk products, showed an increase of 4 million pounds and the production of skim milk powder, the leading skim milk product, increased $6\frac{1}{4}$ million pounds.

ICE CREAM

The quantity of ice cream manufactured in April was approximately 3 million gallons or 320 thousand gallons more than that produced a year ago.
