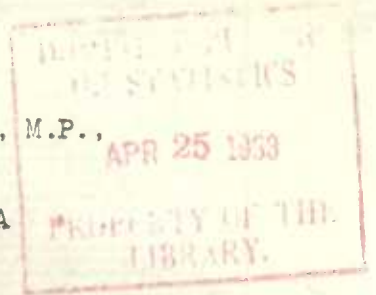

CORRECTED STATEMENT OF THE PRODUCTION OF CREAMERY BUTTER
IN CANADA, MARCH, 1933.

The present report on the production of creamery butter in Canada in March, 1933, should be substituted for the statement issued April 21st. An error was made in the previous report whereby the figures of Ontario's production in March, 1932 and 1933 were transposed, and an incorrect figure was given of the production of Alberta in March, 1932.
