PRODUCTION OF CREAMERY BUTTER IN CANADA, AFRIL, 1933.

The monthly statistics of creamery butter production, issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics, are based on statements furnished by the Provincial Departments of Agriculture.

The total quantity of creamery butter made in Canada in April, 1933, was 12,815,434 pounds, compared with a total of 9,405,532 pounds in the preceding month and 13,715,060 pounds in April, 1932. The following tables give statistics of production by provinces.
