PRODUCTION OF CREAMERY BUTTER IN CAMADA, OCTOBER, 1934.

The monthly statistics of creamery butter production, issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics, are based on estimates furnished by the Provincial Departments of Agriculture.

The production of creamery butter in Canada in October, 1934, amounted to 20,583,372 pounds, compared with 23,827,181 pounds in the preceding month and 17,969,111 pounds in October, 1933. The following tables give production by provinces.

ERRATUM - (September Report)

The butter production for Manitcha should have been shown as 2,003,147 pounds instead of 2,300,147 and the cumulative figures for the nine months were 18,183,652 instead of 18,480,652. This changes the percentage comparison from an increase of 12.12 to a decrease of 2.26 for the month and from an increase of 11.68 to 9.88 for the nine months ending September 30th.
