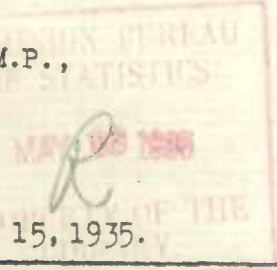

PRODUCTION OF CREAMERY BUTTER IN CANADA, APRIL, 1935.

The monthly statistics of creamery butter production, issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics, are based on estimates furnished by the Provincial Departments of Agriculture.

The production of creamery butter in Canada in April, 1935, amounted to 13,329,216 pounds, compared with 8,734,605 pounds in the preceding month and 14,254,486 pounds in April, 1934. The following tables give production by provinces.
