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PRODUCTION OF CREAMERY BUTTER IN CANADA, JANUARY, 1936

The monthly statistics of creamery butter production, issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics, are based on estimates furnished by the Provincial Department of Agriculture.

The production of creamery butter in Canada in January 1936, amounted to 9,388,090 pounds, compared with 10,326,672 pounds in the preceding month and 7,998,141 pounds in January, 1935. The following tables give production by provinces.
