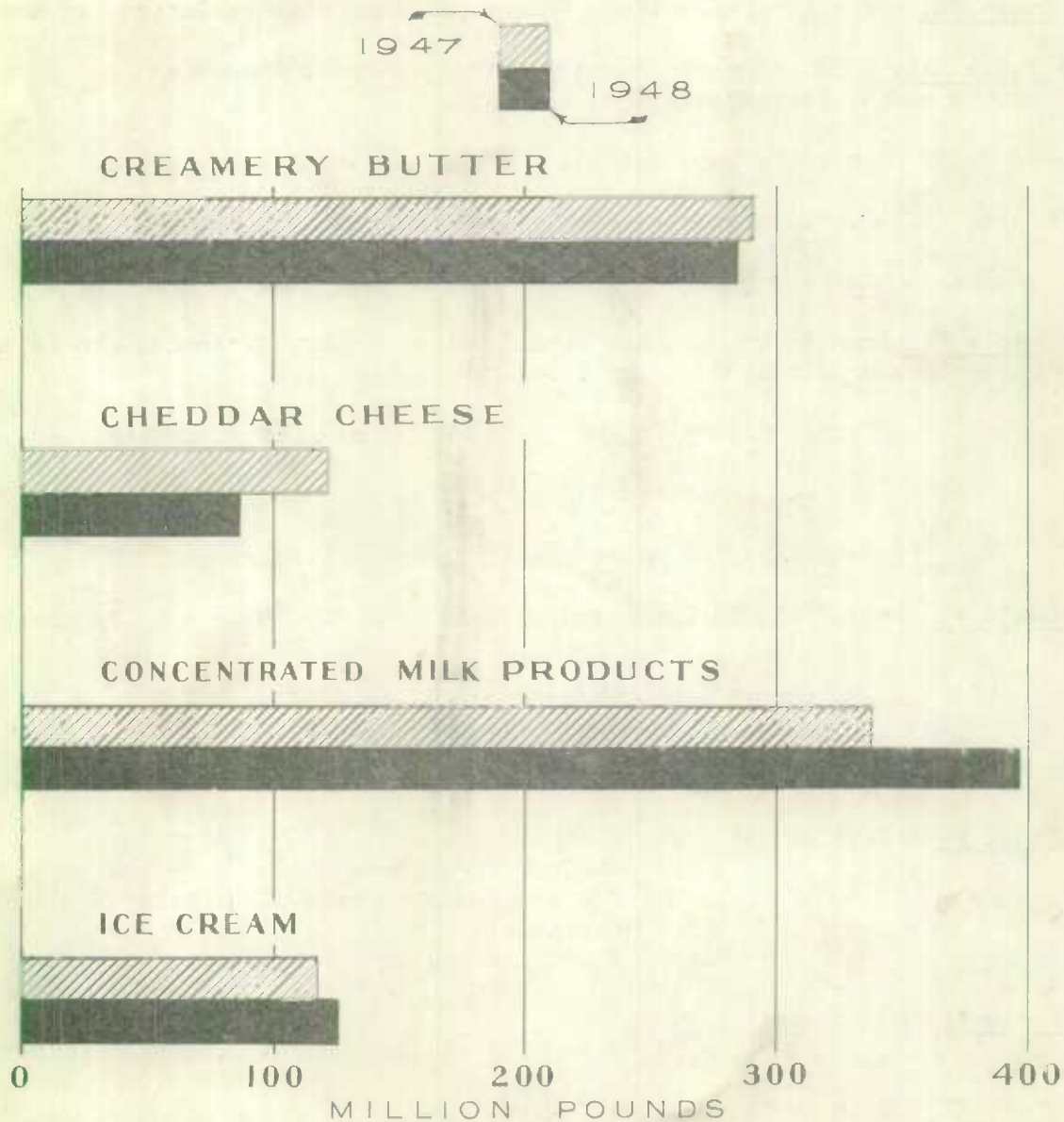

CALENDAR OF IMPORTANT HAPPENINGS AFFECTING DAIRYING IN 1948

The more important happenings and policy announcements affecting dairying during 1948 are summarized in chronological order below:

January 15th: The Hon D.C. Abbott, Minister of Finance, announced the re-imposition of **ceiling** prices on butter. Under this order the maximum prices that could be charged wholesalers or wholesale buyers by producers of creamery, dairy and whey butter were **as follows:**

The above prices were subject to a reduction of 1 cent for each grade lower than the first grade. On sales made to retailers and others these prices would be subject to an increase of 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ cents per pound. Wholesalers were allowed a markup of $\frac{3}{4}$ of a cent on butter sold to other wholesalers and wholesale buyers, and 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ cents on butter sold to retailers and others.

February 10th: A Committee of the House of Commons was appointed to inquire into the cause of the rising prices. When the Committee convened later in the month, one of the first items considered was the question of butter prices and the factors responsible for price increases during previous months.

March 23rd: The first postwar consignment of Canadian Dairy Cattle for shipment to the Orient was loaded at Vancouver and consigned to Hong Kong.

April 8th: The Board of Transport Commissioners gave permission to Canadian Railways to increase freight charges 21 per cent.

May 28th: The Dairy Products Board was authorized by order-in-council to support the butter market by purchasing first grade butter in car lots, basis Charlottetown, Halifax, St. John, Montreal, Toronto and Vancouver at the following prices:

July 8th: Professor C.A. Curtis of Queens University was appointed Chairman of the Price Inquiry Commission set up by order-in-council to continue the price probe conducted by the Committee of the House of Commons during the session.

July 21st: Following the upward adjustment in freight rates, the ceiling prices for creamery butter established on January 15th were increased as follows: In the Maritime Provinces, Quebec, Ontario and British Columbia an increase of $\frac{3}{4}$ of a cent was allowed; in Manitoba and Alberta prices were increased $\frac{1}{4}$ of a cent, and in northern Ontario the prices set forth in the former schedule were advanced a $\frac{1}{2}$ cent per pound. No change was made in the ceiling prices in Saskatchewan. On dairy butter the additional charges of $\frac{3}{4}$ of a cent applied to the Maritimes, Quebec and Ontario, while the $\frac{1}{2}$ cent increase applied to all four of the Western Provinces. On whey butter an increase of 1 cent per pound was allowed in the Maritime Provinces, Ontario, Quebec and British Columbia, while the rate in other provinces was advanced $\frac{1}{2}$ cent per pound.

July 26th: The Dairy Products Board requisitioned cheese for export, the requisition period to terminate October 1, 1948.

September 24th: Rt. Hon C.D. Howe, Minister of Trade and Commerce announced that the Canadian Government had completed arrangements for the purchase of 15 million pounds of butter from Denmark, Australia and New Zealand; Denmark to supply 11 million pounds, while 2 million pounds would be supplied by each of the other two countries. The announcement stated that the first shipment would arrive in October and the total quantity would be delivered in Canada before the end of January.

December 6th to 8th: The Dominion-Provincial Agricultural Conference was held in Ottawa to discuss the present position and to lay plans for 1949. On the last day of the Conference the Minister of Agriculture announced a new contract with the United Kingdom which called for the delivery of 50 million pounds of cheese during the fiscal year 1949-1950 at the same price as the previous contract, namely, 30 cents per lb.f.o.b. factory. Reports submitted to the Conference stressed exchange difficulties and the shortage of American dollars to finance the purchase of exportable products, although it was indicated that the United Kingdom was willing to use dollars to purchase Canadian cheese which continues to hold favour with British consumers. The conference was warned, however, that farmers must be prepared to expect somewhat lower prices for farm products in subsequent years.

December 14th: By decision of the Supreme Court of Canada, the prohibition covering the sale and manufacture of oleo margarine in Canada as provided for in the Dairy Industry Act was declared to be ultra vires of the powers of the Dominion Parliament.

THE PURPOSE AND USE OF THIS REPORT

The supplement to the Monthly Dairy Review of Canada is published at this time to provide revised data which will be used for comparative purposes in current issues of the Monthly Review in 1949. While all essential statistics are shown, it has been impossible in some cases to offer a complete break-down for individual items on both a product basis and on a milk basis. Attention, therefore, is directed to the following:

1. Milk and cream sales for Canada are shown separately, by provinces, in Table VI, and by months provincially in Tables VII and VIII. To obtain these data for Canada, by months, it is necessary to add the data shown on Tables VII and VIII.

2. Milk production and utilization statistics, by products, are shown for Canada, and by months for each province (See Table IX, pages 18 to 27). However, cheddar cheese and other cheese are not separately reported. These can be obtained by Provinces, by deducting other cheese shown on Table VI from factory cheese in Table IX. But, to obtain the milk equivalent of these two classes of cheese separately, by months, it is necessary to refer to Table II (Canada) and Table III (by Provinces), and to convert the separate products to milk (1 pound = 11.14 pounds of milk). This also applies to miscellaneous factory products. Ice cream shown on Tables II and III, may be converted to milk by using the factor 14.29. The result deducted from miscellaneous products on Table IX will provide the milk equivalent of concentrated milk products.

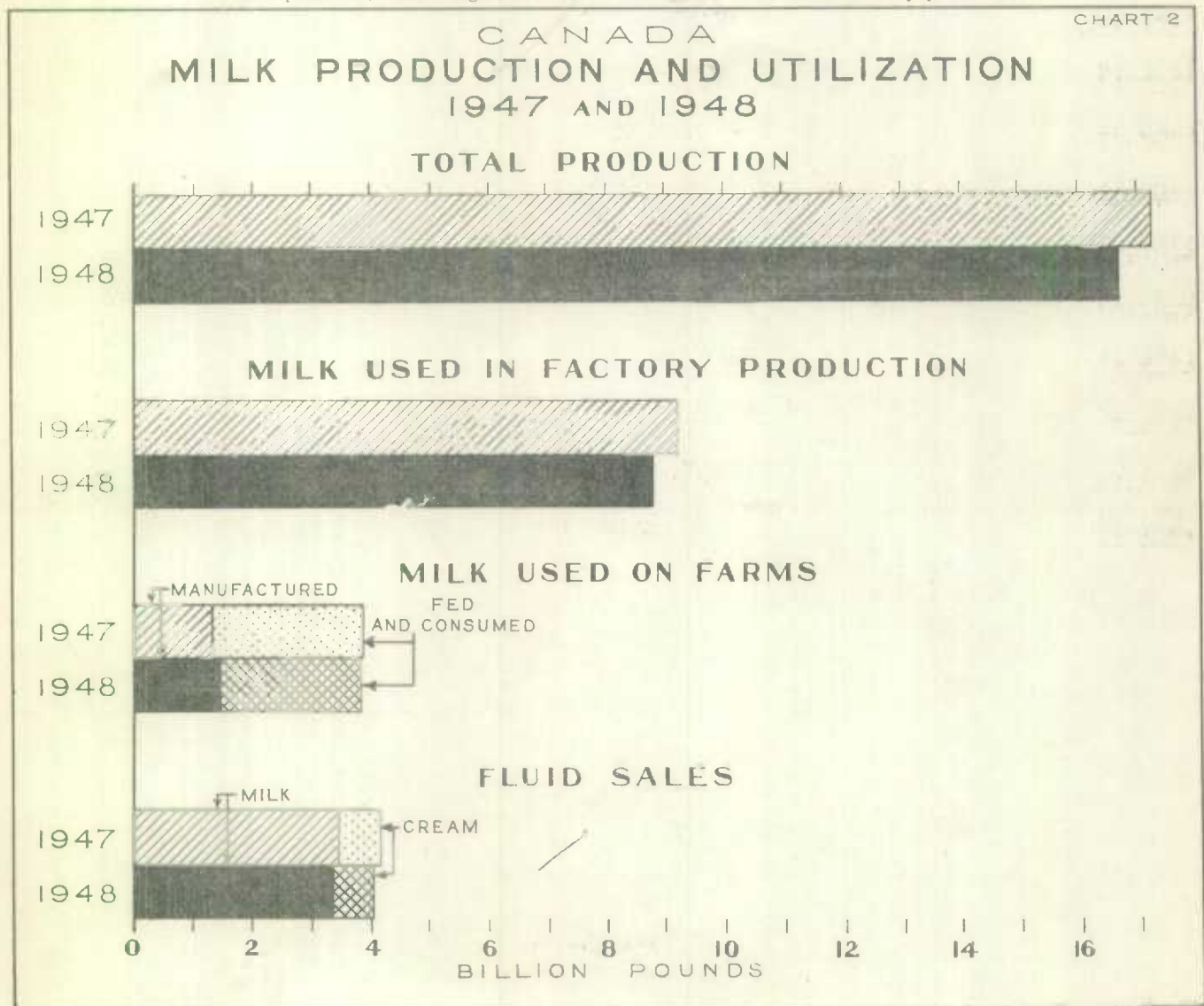

AVERAGE FARM CASH INCOME PER 100 POUNDS OF MILK UTILIZED AS SPECIFIED 1947 AND 1948

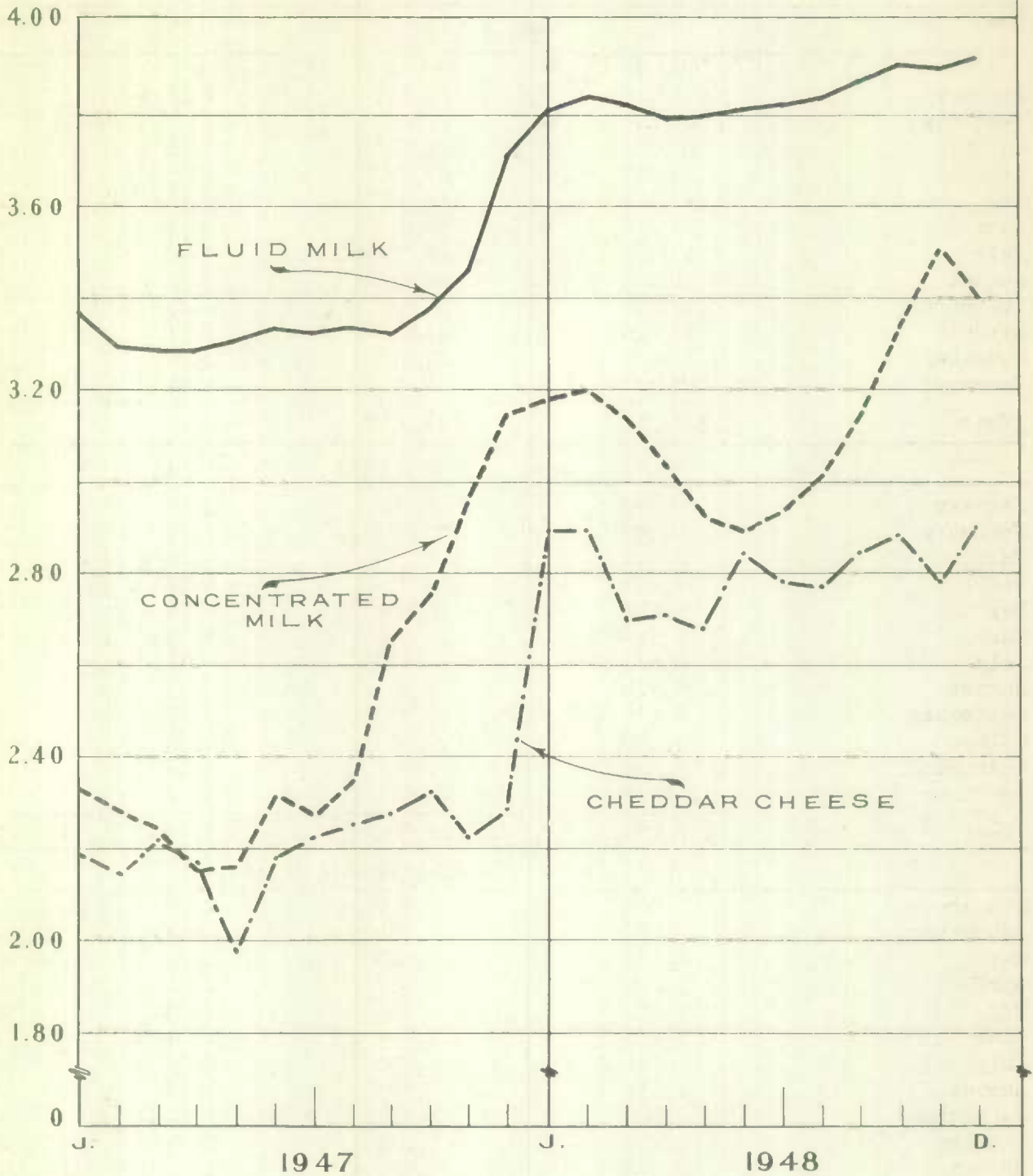
