

Preliminary Indications of the Dairy Situation, January 1960

Milk production amounted to about 1,065,000,000 pounds in January, according to all information available at this time. This is an increase of 3 per cent over milk production in January, 1959.

The manufacture of dairy factory products utilized about 430,000,000 pounds of milk during the month, an increase of 5 per cent over milk used for manufacturing in January, 1959. The creamery butter make was down but cheese, concentrated milk and ice cream used substantially more milk than in the same month a year earlier.

The quantity of milk utilized for dairy factory products in 1959 was nearly identical to that used in 1958. Creamery butter manufacture used 3 per cent less milk during the year, but cheese, creamed cottage cheese, concentrated whole milk products and ice cream, with increases over production in 1958 of 17 per cent, 1 per cent, 2 per cent and 9 per cent respectively, compensated for the decline in creamery butter. Commencing in July, cheddar cheese output accelerated strongly in response to improved export demand. Ice cream production gained impetus from the unusually warm summer although production was high during most of the year.

Fluid milk and cream sales in December were 2 per cent higher than in the same month a year earlier. For the purpose of the preliminary estimate, sales in January were estimated, at 484,000,000 pounds, to have been 2 per cent greater than fluid sales in January, 1959.

From the monthly survey of farms keeping milk cows, indications are that about 150,000,000 pounds of milk was used on farms during January. This is about equal to milk used on farms in the first month of 1959. Compared to January last year, 1 per cent less milk was consumed in farm homes and 5 per cent more milk was fed to livestock. Milk cow numbers on the farms covered by the survey were reported to be about 1/2 per cent greater than in January last year with 2 per cent more cows being milked. Production per cow on these farms was reported to be about 1 per cent higher than in the same month a year earlier.

FARM MILK PRODUCTION, UTILIZATION AND INCOME IN DECEMBER, 1959

Farm Milk Production: The estimated quantity of milk produced on farms in December amounted to 1,165,173,000 pounds. This represents an increase of 50 million pounds, 4.5 per cent above production in December, 1958. Of this amount, 531 million pounds or 46 per cent was utilized in factory production, while fluid sales absorbed approximately 488 million pounds or 42 per cent of the total milk supply.

Fluid Sales: During December, sales of fluid milk and cream (the latter expressed as milk) amounted to 488,049,000 pounds, an increase of approximately 10 million pounds in comparison with the previous December. This included about 405 million pounds of fluid milk, comprising about 35 per cent of the farm milk supply and fluid cream sales of 83 million pounds representing 7 per cent.

Farm Butter: Farm butter production estimated at 804,000 pounds for December showed a decrease from the corresponding month of last year of 104,000 pounds.

Farm Cash Income: Cash income from the sale of dairy products in December amounted to \$35,621,000. This represented an increase of 6.8 per cent or \$2,273,000 in comparison with the same month last year. The weighted average price of \$3.49 per hundred pounds of milk was 4 cents higher than in December, 1958. Fluid milk at \$4.79 per hundred was 9 cents higher than that of December, 1958. Creamery butter-fat increased from 66.3 cents to 69.2 cents per pound, and farm butter at 62 cents was 2 cents lower than in December, 1958. Milk used in manufacture declined from \$3.12 per hundred in December, 1958 to \$3.02 per hundred in December, 1959. Cheese milk at \$2.87 per hundred, was 10 cents higher than in December, 1958. Creamery Butter

Production: Creamery butter production amounted to 15.8 million pounds in December, 1959. This was 0.8 million pounds or approximately 5 per cent more than that produced in the same month of the previous year.

Stocks: Holdings of creamery butter in store and transit on January 1, amounted to 105.5 million pounds, approximately 11.8 million pounds greater than at January 1, last year. On December 1, 1959, stock holdings at 116.1 million pounds were 9.5 million pounds greater than at the same date a year earlier.

Supply: The quantity of creamery butter represented by stocks on December 1, plus production and imports during the month, amounted to 131.9 million pounds at December 31, 1959. This was an increase of approximately 10.3 million pounds compared to the corresponding supply figure at December 31, 1958.

Domestic Disappearance: The domestic disappearance of creamery butter in December amounted to 23.1 million pounds, a decrease of 4.8 million pounds or 17 per cent from the corresponding figure for the same month last year. On a per capita basis, it amounted to 1.32 pounds as compared with 1.64 pounds in December, 1958.

Prices at Montreal: Butter prices at Montreal, based on dealers' quotations for first grade solids, averaged 64 cents per pound in December as against 64 cents in December, 1958.

Cheddar Cheese

Production: Cheddar cheese production amounted to approximately 5.7 million pounds, an increase of 2.2 million pounds compared to production in the same month of the previous year.

Prices: Although very little trading occurred, the Montreal price of Ontario coloured cheese averaged 37 cents per pound in December. The comparative price in 1958 was 35 1/4 cents.

Ice Cream

The quantity of ice cream manufactured in December was approximately 2.2 million gallons or 225 thousand gallons more than that produced a year ago.

The Dairy Situation in 1959

Tr

Total milk production in Canada during 1959 amounted to about 18,200,000,000 pounds, an increase of 0.7 per cent over milk production in 1958. Pasture conditions were generally a little more favourable than in 1958. Growth in the spring was retarded following a prolonged and severe winter. Winter killing of legumes was serious in many areas, particularly in the maritime provinces. Dry weather adversely affected pasture conditions in central and western provinces in July but was relieved by mid August and abundant rainfall continued during the fall months. Hay and fodder production was higher than in 1958 but quality was reduced in some areas. Milk production was probably affected by the relentless heat experienced through July and August.

Dairy factory products utilized about 10,500,000,000 pounds of milk during the year, nearly the same as in 1958. Creamery butter production, using 7,600,000,000 pounds of milk was down 4 per cent from a year earlier, but 17 per cent more cheese was made. About 5,600,000,000 pounds of milk was used for fluid milk and cream sales during 1959, almost 2.5 per cent more than in 1958. Milk used on farms at 2,000,000,000 pounds remained at approximately the same level as in 1958. Milk production increased over the previous year in Prince Edward Island, Nova Scotia, Ontario and British Columbia; remained about the same in Quebec, Saskatchewan and Alberta but declined slightly in New Brunswick and Manitoba.

Farm cash income from the sale of milk, cream and farm butter increased 3 per cent over that of 1958 to reach about 515,000,000 dollars in 1959.
