

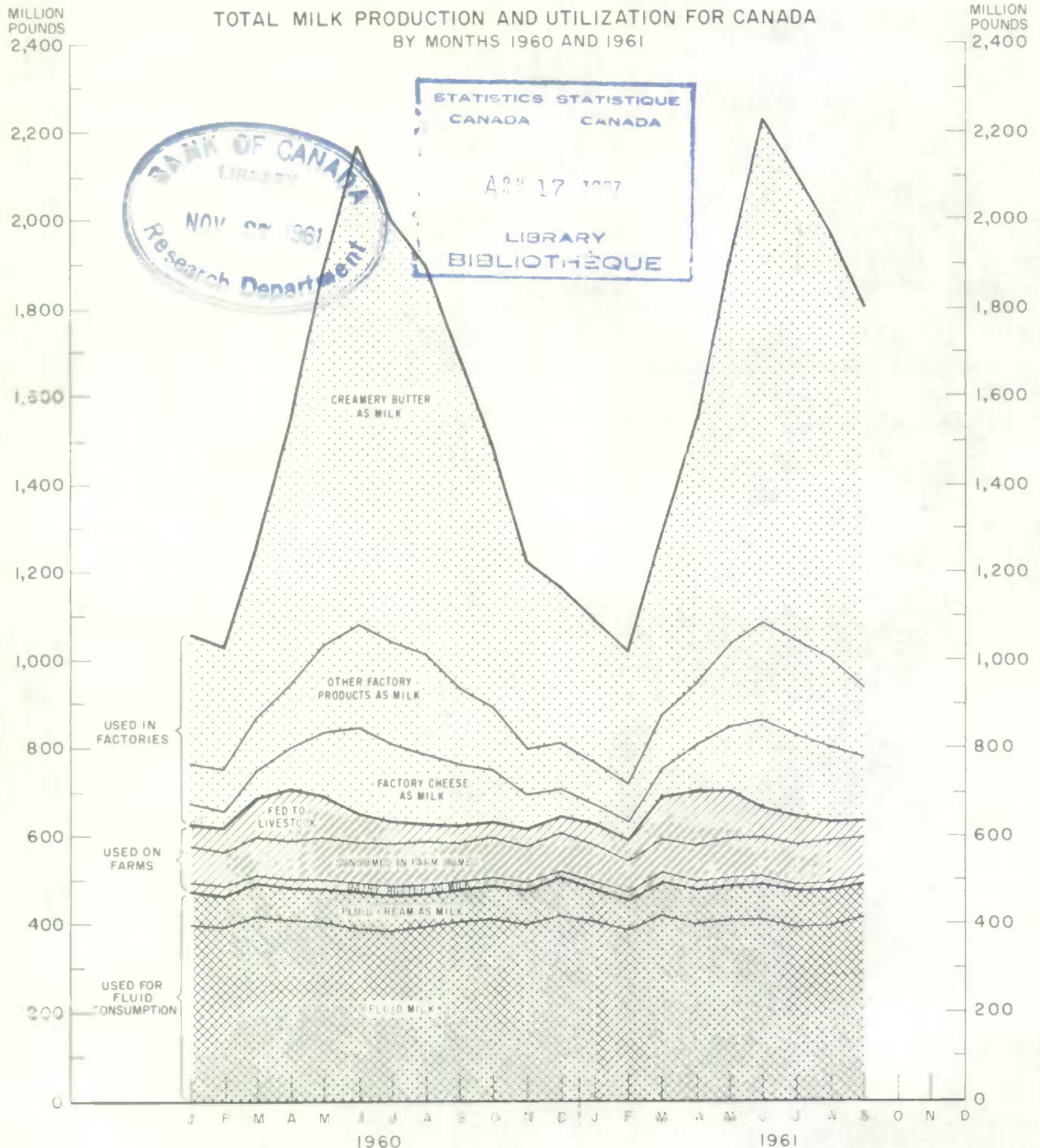


THE DAIRY REVIEW

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Preliminary Indications of the Dairy Situation, October, 1961

The preliminary estimate of milk produced in October is 1,665,600,000 pounds. This is an increase of 11.6 per cent over milk production in October, 1960. Milk production for the first ten months of the year was estimated at 16,618,700,000 pounds, 3.7 per cent above production in the January - October period a year ago.

About 61 per cent of the milk produced in October, or 1,021,800,000 pounds, was used for dairy factory products. Dairy factory utilization was 18.7 per cent greater than in October, 1960, with increased quantities going into all except concentrated milk products. Creamery butter manufacture during the month accounted for 757,500,000 pounds of milk, an increase of 26.7 per cent over last year. More milk was used for the production of cheese and ice cream mix than in October last year, with increases of 13.0 and 8.7 per cent, respectively, for these two products. During the January - October period, 5.6 per cent more milk was used in dairy factory products than in the same ten-month period a year ago.

Fluid sales of milk and cream in October, for the purpose of the preliminary estimate, were assumed to have amounted to 495,000,000 pounds, an increase of 2.3 per cent over fluid sales in October, 1960. This is the average increase of July, August and September this year compared with the corresponding period a year earlier.

According to indications from the monthly survey of farms keeping milk cows, milk and cream used in farm homes was only slightly less than that used in October, 1960, while milk used for livestock feeding was 10.4 per cent above that of a year ago. Dairy correspondents report 0.9 per cent more milk cows kept on farms at October 15, and 1.3 per cent more cows being milked than at this time last year. Probably influenced by excellent pasture conditions in most parts of eastern Canada, combined with generally mild weather throughout Canada, milk production per cow, for cows milked, increased 3.4 per cent above the level at October 15, 1960.

Farm Milk Production, Utilization and Income in September, 1961

Farm Milk Production: The estimated quantity of milk produced on farms in September amounted to 1,802 million pounds, an increase of 113 million pounds or 6.7 per cent over that of September, 1960. Of this amount, 1,168 million pounds or 65 per cent was utilized in factory production, and approximately 489 million pounds or 27 per cent was used for fluid sales. During the January - September period, the estimated production was 14,953 million pounds, an increase of 418 million pounds over that produced in the same period of the previous year. The quantity of milk utilized for factory production in the January - September period amounted to 9,065 million pounds while fluid sales accounted for 4,324 million pounds.

Fluid Sales: Sales of fluid milk and cream, the latter expressed as milk, amounted to 489 million pounds in September, an increase of approximately 15 million pounds in comparison with September of the previous year. This included about 414 million pounds of fluid milk, comprising about 23 per cent of the farm milk supply, and fluid cream sales of 75 million pounds representing 4 per cent. During the nine-month period, fluid sales totalled 4,324 million pounds, an increase of 54 million pounds or 1.3 per cent over those of the corresponding 1960 period.

Farm Butter: Butter made on farms in September amounted to 758,000 pounds, decreasing 10 per cent from the corresponding month in 1960. For the January - September period, 6,207,000 pounds were produced, a decrease of 14 per cent from the same period last year.

Farm Cash Income: Cash income from the sale of dairy products in September amounted to \$50,149,000. This represented an increase of 5.9 per cent or \$2,804,000 in comparison with the same month last year. The weighted average value of \$3.02 per hundred pounds of milk was 5 cents lower than in September, 1960. Fluid milk at \$4.75 per hundred was 3 cents higher than in September, 1960. Creamery butter-fat decreased from 68.2 cents to 67.9 cents per pound, and farm butter at 61 cents per pound was one cent lower than in September, 1960. Milk used in manufacture averaged \$2.63 per hundred, 6 cents lower than in September, 1960. Cheese milk decreased to \$2.52 per hundred, a decrease of 6 cents per hundred in comparison with the same month a year earlier.

Farm cash income estimates cover all money received by farmers for the sale of milk, cream and farm butter. Government subsidies and bonuses are included in these estimates.

Production and Prices of Dairy Products in September, 1961

Creamery Butter

Production: Creamery butter production amounted to 37.0 million pounds in September, 1961. This was 4.9 million pounds or approximately 15 per cent more than that produced in the same month of the previous year.

Stocks: Holdings of creamery butter in store and transit on October 1 amounted to 159.0 million pounds, approximately 20.0 million pounds higher than at October 1 last year. On September 1, 1961, stock holdings at 152.4 million pounds were 16.1 million pounds greater than at the same date a year earlier. It should also be noted that 37.4 million pounds of butter oil was reported held in cold storage on October 1, compared with 33.7 million pounds reported in storage on September 1, 1961.

Supply: The quantity of creamery butter represented by stocks on September 1, plus production and imports during the month, amounted to 189.4 million pounds at September 30, 1961. This was an increase of approximately 21.0 million pounds compared to the corresponding supply figure at September 30, 1960.

Domestic Disappearances: The domestic disappearance of creamery butter in September amounted to 25.1 million pounds, an increase of 1.0 million pounds or 4 per cent more than the corresponding figure for the same month last year. On a per capita basis, it amounted to 1.39 pounds as compared with 1.36 pounds in September, 1960.

Prices at Montreal: Butter prices at Montreal, based on dealers' quotations for first grade solids, averaged 62 1/2 cents per pound in September as against 63 cents in September, 1960.

Cheddar Cheese

Production: Cheddar cheese production amounted to approximately 12.1 million pounds, an increase of about 0.4 million pounds compared to production in the same month of the previous year.

Prices: The Belleville price of Ontario coloured cheese averaged 34 1/4 cents per pound in September. The comparative price in 1960 was 34 cents.

Ice Cream Mix

The quantity of ice cream mix manufactured in September was approximately 2.0 million gallons or 153 thousand gallons more than that produced a year ago.
