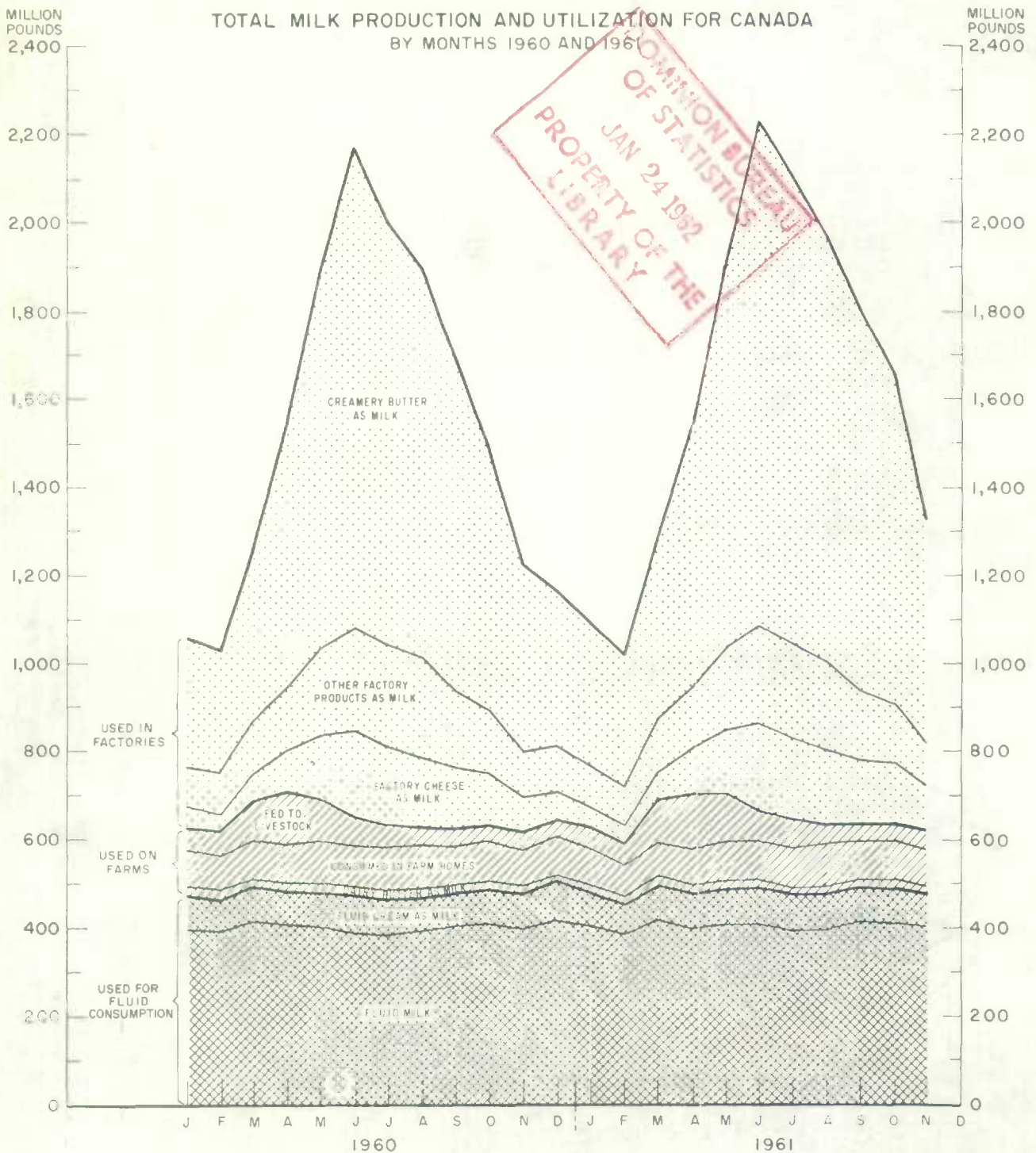


THE DAIRY REVIEW

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Preliminary Indications of the Dairy Situation, December, 1961

The preliminary estimate of milk produced in December is 1,207,500,000 pounds. This is an increase of 3.3 per cent over milk production in December, 1960. Milk production for the twelve months of the year was estimated at 19,141,700,000 pounds, 3.9 per cent above production in the January - December period a year ago.

About 46 per cent of the milk produced in December, or 555,800,000 pounds, was used for dairy factory products. Dairy factory utilization was 6.3 per cent greater than in December, 1960, with increased quantities going into all products except concentrated milk. Creamery butter manufacture during the month accounted for 399,500,000 pounds of milk, an increase of 10.1 per cent over last year. More milk was also used for the production of factory cheese and ice cream mix than in December last year, with increases of 20.8 and 2.6 per cent, respectively, reported for these two products. Concentrated milk products on the other hand, utilized 27.5 per cent less milk in December than a year ago. During the January - December period, 6.2 per cent more milk was used in dairy factory products than in the same twelve months of 1960.

Fluid sales of milk and cream in November increased 1.0 per cent over sales last year. Assuming about the same rate of increase for December, fluid sales accounts for 506,500,000 pounds or about 42 per cent of the preliminary estimate of total milk production.

According to indications from the monthly survey of farms keeping milk cows, milk and cream consumed in farm homes was only slightly above that used in December, 1960, while milk used for livestock feeding was 5.0 per cent above that of a year ago. Farm dairy correspondents report 2.8 per cent more milk cows kept on farms at December 15, and 3.8 per cent more cows being milked than at the same time last year. Milk production per cow, for cows milked on farms in the sample, declined 0.4 per cent below the level at December 15, 1960.

Farm Milk Production, Utilization and Income in November, 1961

Farm Milk Production: The estimated quantity of milk produced on farms in November, amounted to 1,323 million pounds, an increase of 101 million pounds or 8.3 per cent over that of November, 1960. Of this amount, 704 million pounds or 53 per cent was utilized in factory production, and approximately 478 million pounds or 36 per cent was used for fluid sales. During the January - November period, the estimated production was 17,934 million pounds, an increase of 684 million pounds over that produced in the same period of the previous year. The quantity of milk utilized for factory production in the January - November period amounted to 10,790 million pounds while fluid sales accounted for 5,288 million pounds.

Fluid Sales: Sales of fluid milk and cream, the latter expressed as milk, amounted to 478 million pounds in November, an increase of approximately 5 million pounds in comparison with November of the previous year. This included about 401 million pounds of fluid milk, comprising about 30 per cent of the farm milk supply, and fluid cream sales of 77 million pounds representing 6 per cent. During the eleven month period, fluid sales totalled 5,288 million pounds, an increase of 62 million pounds or 1.2 per cent over those of the corresponding 1960 period.

Farm Butter: Butter made on farms in November amounted to 668,000 pounds, decreasing 12 per cent from the corresponding month in 1960. For the January - November period, 7,631,000 pounds were produced, a decrease of 14 per cent from the same period last year.

Farm Cash Income: Cash income from the sale of dairy products in November amounted to \$39,275,000. This represented an increase of 6.7 per cent or \$2,449,000 in comparison with the same month last year. The weighted average value of \$3.32 per hundred pounds of milk was 8 cents lower than in November, 1960. Fluid milk at \$4.82 per hundred was 4 cents higher than in November, 1960. Creamery butter-fat decreased from 70.0 cents to 69.3 cents per pound, and farm butter at 61 cents per pound was one cent lower than in November, 1960. Milk used in manufacture averaged \$2.83 per hundred, 9 cents lower than in November, 1960. Cheese milk increased to \$2.69 per hundred, an increase of 3 cents per hundred in comparison with the same month a year earlier.

Farm cash income estimates cover all money received by farmers for the sale of milk, cream and farm butter. Government subsidies and bonuses are included in these estimates.

Production and Prices of Dairy Products in November, 1961

Creamery Butter

Productions: Creamery butter production amounted to 21.7 million pounds in November, 1961. This was 3.6 million pounds or approximately 20 per cent more than that produced in the same month of the previous year.

Stocks: Holdings of creamery butter in store and transit on December 1 amounted to 145.3 million pounds, approximately 19.9 million pounds higher than at December 1 last year. On November 1, 1961, stock holdings at 159.7 million pounds were 25.0 million pounds greater than at the same date a year earlier. It should also be noted that 50.7 million pounds of butter oil was reported held in cold storage on December 1, compared with 43.7 million pounds reported in storage on November 1, 1961.

Supply: The quantity of creamery butter represented by stocks on November 1, plus production and imports during the month, amounted to 181.4 million pounds at November 30, 1961. This was an increase of approximately 28.6 million pounds compared to the corresponding supply figure at November 30, 1960.

Domestic Disappearance: The domestic disappearance of creamery butter in November amounted to 27.2 million pounds, an increase of 2.1 million pounds or 8 per cent more than the corresponding figure for the same month last year. On a per capita basis, it amounted to 1.51 pounds as compared with 1.41 pounds in November, 1960.

Prices at Montreal: Butter prices at Montreal, based on dealers' quotations for first grade solids, averaged 62 1/2 cents per pound in November, as against 63 3/4 cents in November, 1960.

Cheddar Cheese

Productions: Cheddar cheese production amounted to approximately 8.0 million pounds, an increase of about 1.6 million pounds compared to production in the same month of the previous year.

Prices: The Belleville price of Ontario coloured cheese averaged 34 1/2 cents per pound in November. The comparative price in 1960 was 32 1/2 cents.

Ice Cream Mix

The quantity of ice cream mix manufactured in November was approximately 1.2 million gallons or 76 thousand gallons more than that produced a year ago.
