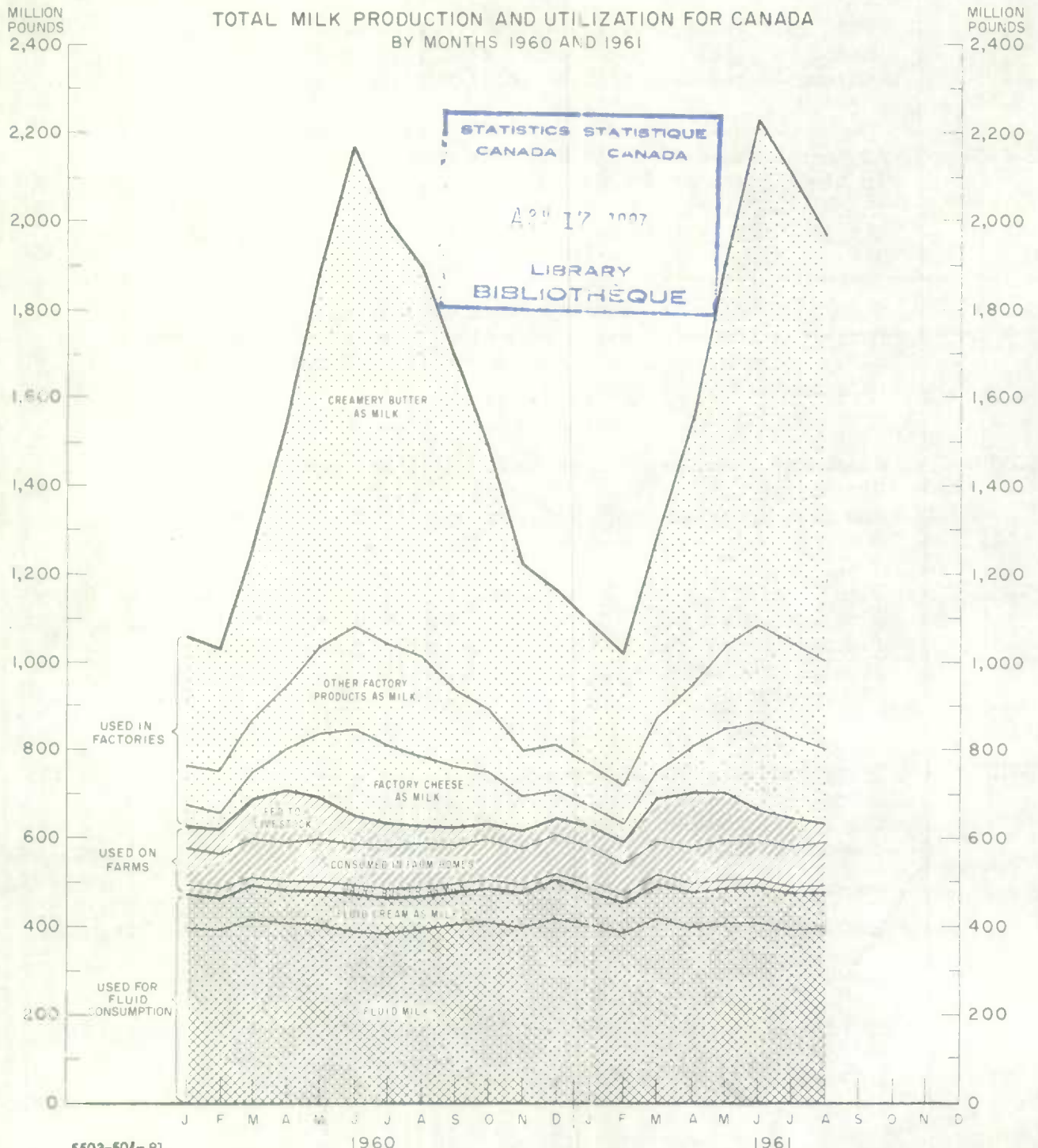

Preliminary Indications of the Dairy Situation, September, 1961

The preliminary estimate of milk produced in September is 1,795,000,000 pounds. This is an increase of 6.2 per cent over milk production in September, 1960. Milk production for the first nine months of the year was estimated at 14,946,600,000 pounds, 2.8 per cent above production in the January - September period a year ago.

About 65 per cent of the milk produced in September, or 1,168,100,000 pounds, was used for dairy factory products. Dairy factory utilization was 9.3 per cent greater than in September, 1960, with increased quantities going into all except concentrated milk products. Creamery butter, the most important of the products, accounted for 865,000,000 pounds of milk, an increase of 15.1 per cent over last year. During the January - September period, 4.3 per cent more milk was used in dairy factory products than in the first nine months of 1960.

Fluid sales of milk and cream for September, for the purpose of the preliminary estimate, were assumed to have amounted to 481,400,000 pounds, an increase of 1.6 per cent from fluid sales in September, 1960. This was the percentage increase for August compared to the same month a year earlier.

According to indications from the monthly survey of farms keeping milk cows, milk used for livestock feeding was 6.6 per cent above the quantity used in September, 1960, while milk and cream used in farm homes was 2.0 per cent below that of a year ago. The number of cows on farms covered by the survey was 1.1 per cent higher than at this time last year and milk production per cow, for cows milked, increased 4.4 per cent above the level at September 15, 1960.

As shown by the map on page 3, and reflected in the increase in milk production, pasture conditions at mid September, except for the very dry areas in the West, were generally more favourable to dairying than at this time last year.

## Farm Milk Production, Utilization and Income in August, 1961

**Farm Milk Production:** The estimated quantity of milk produced on farms in August amounted to 1,970 million pounds, an increase of 72 million pounds or 3.8 per cent over that of August, 1960. Of this amount, 1,338 million pounds or 68 per cent was utilized in factory production, and approximately 475 million pounds or 24 per cent was used for fluid sales. During the January - August period, the estimated production was 13,151 million pounds, an increase of 305 million pounds over that produced in the same period of the previous year. The quantity of milk utilized for factory production in the January - August period amounted to 7,896 million pounds while fluid sales accounted for 3,835 million pounds.

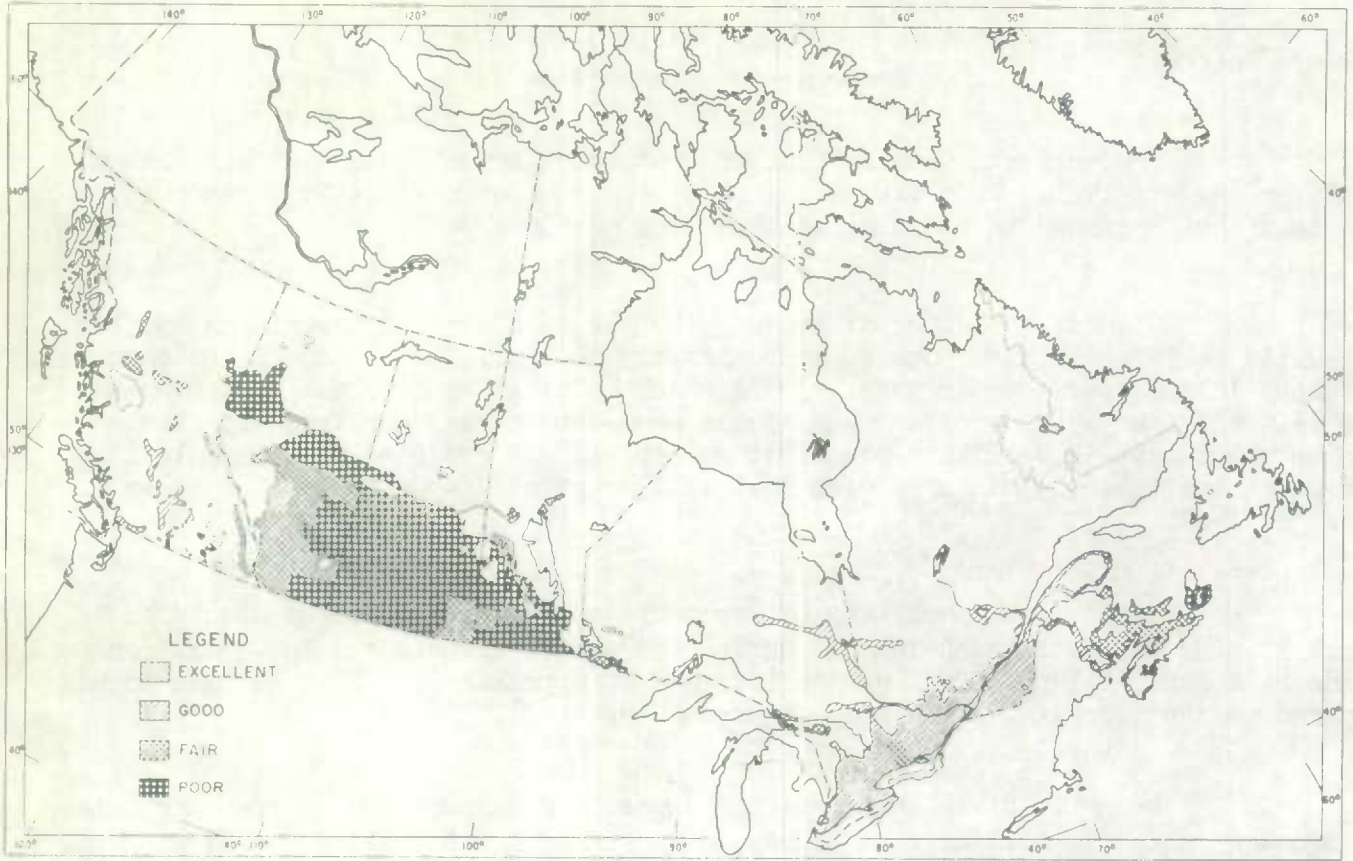
**Fluid Sales:** Sales of fluid milk and cream, the latter expressed as milk, amounted to 475 million pounds in August, an increase of approximately 8 million pounds in comparison with August of the previous year. This included about 398 million pounds of fluid milk, comprising about 20 per cent of the farm milk supply, and fluid cream sales of 77 million pounds representing 4 per cent. During the eight month period, fluid sales totalled 3,835 million pounds, an increase of 39 million pounds or 1 per cent over those of the corresponding 1960 period.

**Farm Butter:** Butter made on farms in August amounted to 718,000 pounds, decreasing 10 per cent from the corresponding month in 1960. For the January - August period, 5,449,000 pounds were produced, a decrease of 15 per cent from the same period last year.

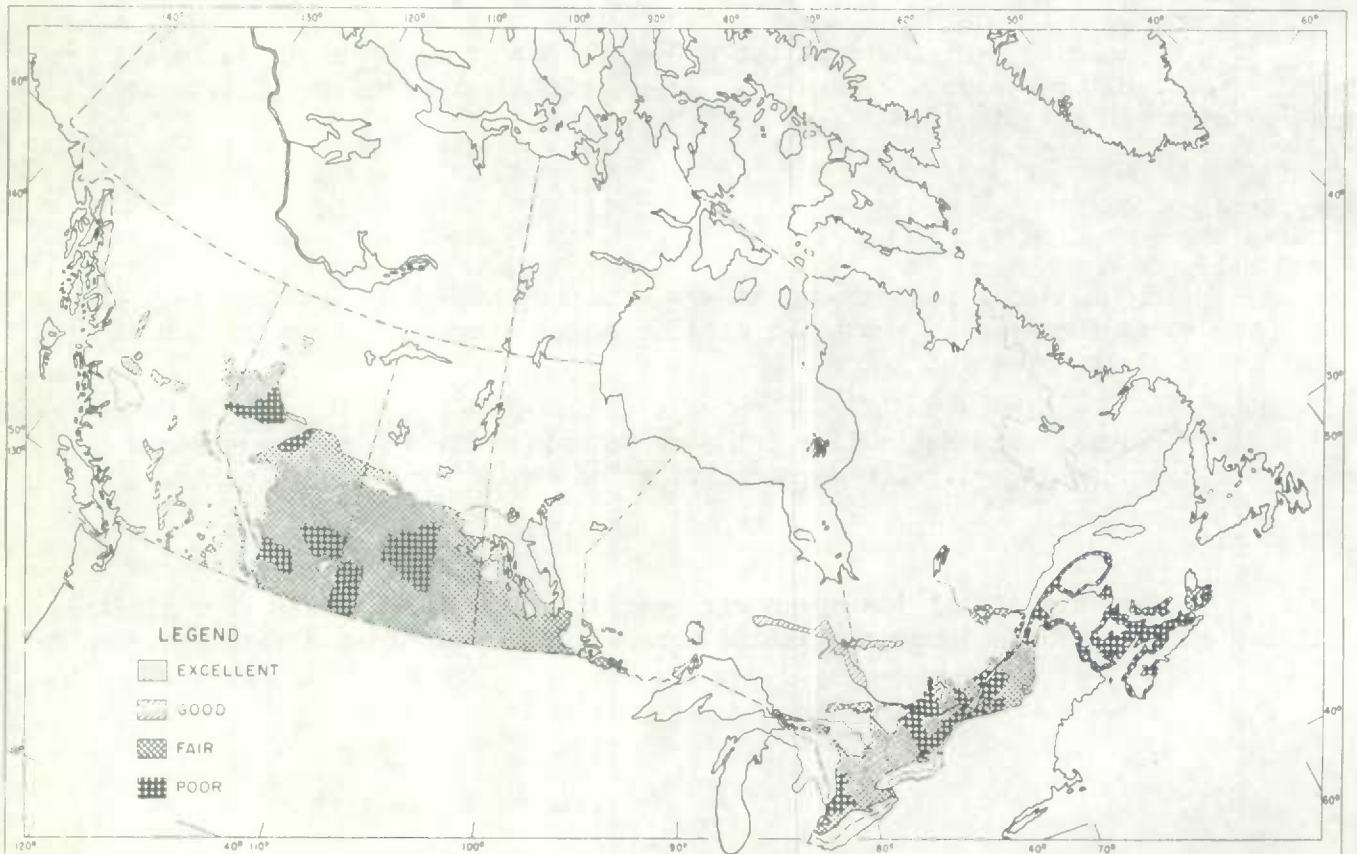
**Farm Cash Income:** Cash income from the sale of dairy products in August amounted to \$53,334,000. This represented an increase of 3.3 per cent or \$1,700,000 in comparison with the same month last year. The weighted average value of \$2.94 per hundred pounds of milk was 2 cents lower than in August, 1960. Fluid milk at \$4.70 per hundred was 1 cent higher than in August, 1960. Creamery butter-fat increased from 67.8 cents to 67.9 cents per pound, and farm butter at 61 cents per pound was the same as in August, 1960. Milk used in manufacture averaged \$2.59 per hundred, 3 cents lower than in August, 1960. Cheese milk decreased to \$2.48 per hundred, a decrease of 6 cents per hundred in comparison with the same month a year earlier.

Farm cash income estimates cover all money received by farmers for the sale of milk, cream and farm butter. Government subsidies and bonuses are included in these estimates.

## Production and Prices of Dairy Products in August, 1961

### Creamery Butter

**Production:** Creamery butter production amounted to 41.2 million pounds in August, 1961. This was 3.2 million pounds or approximately 8 per cent more than that produced in the same month of the previous year.

**Stocks:** Holdings of creamery butter in store and transit on September 1 amounted to 152.4 million pounds, approximately 16.1 million pounds higher than at September 1 last year. On August 1, 1961, stock holdings at 140.1 million pounds were 12.9 million pounds greater than at the same date a year earlier. It should also be noted that 33.7 million pounds of butter oil was reported held in cold storage on September 1, compared with 30.1 million pounds reported in storage on August 1, 1961.

**Supply:** The quantity of creamery butter represented by stocks on August 1, plus production and imports during the month, amounted to 181.3 million pounds at August 31, 1961. This was an increase of approximately 16.1 million pounds compared to the corresponding supply figure at August 31, 1960.

**Domestic Disappearance:** The domestic disappearance of creamery butter in August amounted to 23.4 million pounds, a decrease of 0.8 million pounds or 3 per cent less than the corresponding figure for the same month last year. On a per capita basis, it amounted to 1.30 pounds as compared with 1.36 pounds in August, 1960.

**Prices at Montreal:** Butter prices at Montreal, based on dealers' quotations for first grade solids, averaged 62 1/2 cents per pound in August, as against 63 cents in August, 1960.

### Cheddar Cheese

**Production:** Cheddar cheese production amounted to approximately 14.6 million pounds, an increase of about 1.1 million pounds compared to production in the same month of the previous year.

**Prices:** The Belleville price of Ontario coloured cheese averaged 34 cents per pound in August. The comparative price in 1960 was 33 3/4 cents.

### Ice Cream Mix

The quantity of ice cream mix manufactured in August was approximately 2.8 million gallons or 102 thousand gallons more than that produced a year ago.
