Preliminary Indications of the Dairy Situation, January, 1962

The preliminary estimate of milk produced in January is 1,127,000,000 pounds. This is an increase of 3.7 per cent over milk production in January, 1961.

The manufacture of dairy factory products during the month utilized 499,100,000 pounds of milk, 8 per cent more than in the first month of 1961. The increase was primarily due to a 10 per cent increase in the amount of milk used in the manufacture of creamery butter, which represented almost three-quarters of the milk used in dairy factory products. More milk was also used for the production of factory cheese and ice cream mix than in January last year, with increases of 26 and 8 per cent, respectively, for these products. About 12 per cent less milk was used for concentrated whole milk products in January, 1962, as compared with January a year ago.

Revised data for 1960 and 1961 indicate that 11.4 billion pounds of milk went into the manufacture of dairy factory products last year. This is an increase of 6.6 per cent over the corresponding figure for 1960. Creamery butter production required about 8.2 billion pounds of milk during the year, almost 10 per cent more than in 1960. Factory cheese and ice cream mix production accounted for almost 2.1 billion pounds of milk, while the remaining billion pounds of milk was used for concentrated whole milk products.

Fluid milk and cream sales during December, 1961, were 0.4 per cent lower than in December, 1960, but for the purpose of the preliminary estimate, fluid sales in January were assumed to have followed the 0.5 per cent increase shown by fluid sales in the last quarter of 1961, compared with the same three months of 1960. This led to a fluid sales estimate for January of 482,000,000 pounds.

According to indications from the monthly survey of farms keeping milk cows, milk and cream consumed in farm homes was only slightly above that used in January, 1961, while milk used for livestock feeding was 3.6 per cent above that of a year ago. Farm dairy correspondents reported 2.4 per cent more milk cows kept on farms at January 15, and 3.7 per cent more cows being milked than on the same date last year.

Farm Milk Production, Utilization and Income in December, 1961

Farm Milk Production: The estimated quantity of milk produced on farms in December amounted to 1,201 million pounds. This is an increase of more than 28 million pounds compared to production in December, 1960. Of the total, 557 million pounds or 46 per cent was utilized in dairy factory production, while fluid sales absorbed approximately 501 million pounds or 42 per cent of the total milk supply.

Fluid Sales: During December, sales of fluid milk and cream (the latter expressed as milk) amounted to 501 million pounds, a decrease of approximately 2 million pounds compared to the previous December. This included about 413 million pounds of fluid milk, comprising about 35 per cent of the farm milk supply and fluid cream sales of 88 million pounds representing 7 per cent.

Farm Butter: Farm butter production, estimated at 583 thousand pounds for December, showed a decrease from the corresponding month of last year of 105 thousand pounds.

Farm Cash Income: Cash income from the sale of dairy products in December amounted to \$36,172,000. This was an increase of 1.2 per cent or \$428,000 in comparison with the same month last year. The weighted average value f.o.b. farm of \$3.42 per hundred pounds of milk was 5 cents lower than in December, 1960. Fluid milk at \$4.80 per hundred was 2 cents higher than in December, 1960. Creamery butter-fat decreased from 69.5 cents to 68.5 cents per pound, and farm butter at 62 cents was 1 cent higher than in December, 1960. Milk used in manufacture declined from \$2.85 per hundred in December, 1960 to \$2.82 per hundred in December, 1961. Cheese milk at \$2.70 per hundred, was 2 cents lower than in December, 1960.

Farm cash income estimates cover all money received by farmers for the sale of milk, cream and farm butter. Government subsidies and bonuses are included in these estimates.

Production and Prices of Dairy Products in December, 1961

Creamery Butter

Production: Greamery butter production amounted to 17.0 million pounds in December, 1961. This was 1.5 million pounds or approximately 9 per cent more than that produced in the same month of the previous year.

Stocks: Combined holdings of creamery butter and butter oil (in butter equivalent) in store and transit on January 1, 1962, amounted to 197.2 million pounds, approximately 63.9 million pounds higher than at January 1 last year. On December 1, 1961, stock holdings at 206.9 million pounds were 63.5 million pounds greater than at the same date a year earlier.

Supply: The combined quantity of creamery butter and butter oil represented by stocks on December 1, plus production and imports during the month, amounted to 224.0 million pounds of butter at December 31, 1961. This was an increase of approximately 65.0 million pounds compared to the corresponding supply figure at December 31, 1960.

Domestic Disappearance: The combined domestic disappearance of creamery butter and butter oil in December amounted to 26.8 million pounds of butter, an increase of 1.1 million pounds or 4 per cent more than the corresponding figure for the same month last year. On a per capita basis, it amounted to 1.47 pounds as compared with 1.44 pounds in December, 1960.

Prices at Montreal: Butter prices at Montreal, based on dealers' quotations for first grade solids, averaged 63 1/2 cents per pound in December, as against 64 cents in December, 1960.

Cheddar Cheese

Production: Cheddar cheese production in December amounted to approximately 5.5 million pounds, an increase of about 1.2 million pounds compared to production in the same month of the previous year.

Prices: The Belleville price of Ontario coloured cheese averaged 33 1/2 cents per pound in December. The comparative price in 1960 was 32 1/2 cents.

Ice Cream Mix

The quantity of ice cream mix manufactured in December was approximately 1.2 million gallons or 7 thousand gallons more than that produced a year ago.

SUPPLEMENT TO THE DAIRY REVIEW, JANUARY, 1962

The green pages of this supplement contain revised statistics of milk production and utilization for 1960 and 1961. Utilization data include butter made on farms, the milk equivalent of dairy factory products and fluid sales, milk fed to livestock and milk consumed in farm homes. The 1961 data differ from previously published information which appeared in monthly issues of The Dairy Review in that virtually 100 per cent of the dairy factories and milk distributors known to be operating in Canada have forwarded complete monthly information for the year. Some have corrected monthly reports forwarded earlier. When monthly publications go to press, publication deadlines make it necessary to estimate production of sales for late reporting firms. The 1960 data has been revised slightly from that shown in the supplement to the January 1961 issue of The Dairy Review. Minor changes result from further corrections submitted by firms for that year.

Milk production estimates are the sum of the quantities of milk used in factories, by milk distributors and on farms. Since reporters supply information in terms of dairy products, these products must be converted to milk equivalent. The conversion factors used are found on page 10 of the supplement.

The yellow pages contain revised farm cash income data that correspond to the revised production data appearing in the green pages. Generally the average values used are similar to those used for 1960 and 1961 in the monthly issues of The Dairy Review. Most of the revisions in farm cash income are caused by related changes in milk utilization estimates.
