

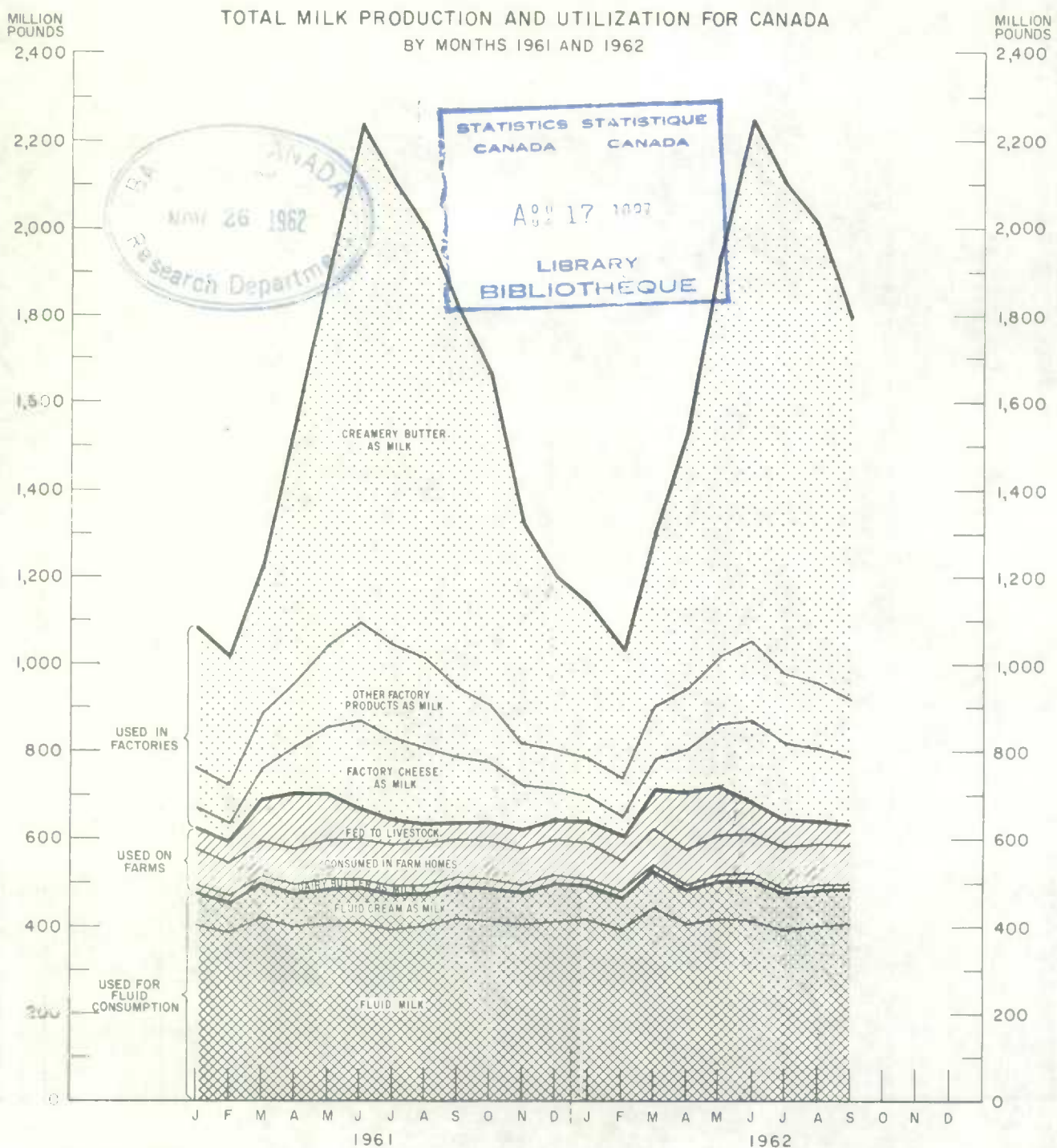

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Preliminary Indications of the Dairy Situation, October, 1962

The preliminary estimate of milk produced in October is 1,630,000,000 pounds. This is 1.9 per cent below production in the same month last year and would make the estimate of production for the first ten months of the year 16,745,000,000 pounds. This is 0.3 per cent above production in the January to October period a year ago.

About 61 per cent of the milk produced in October, or 993,000,000 pounds, was used for factory dairy products. This represented a decrease of 2.9 per cent from factory utilization in October, 1961. Creamery butter production during the month used 755,000,000 pounds, 0.3 per cent less than in October, 1961, while milk used for cheese and concentrated whole milk products was down 0.5 and 12.5 per cent, respectively. The 36.2 per cent decrease in the quantity of milk used for ice cream mix was due mainly to the increased use of creamery butter in the manufacture of that product. Ice cream mix production increased 1.0 per cent over a year ago, both for the month of October and the ten-month period ending October. During the January to October period, milk utilized for factory products was down 0.3 per cent from the corresponding period a year ago.

Fluid sales of milk and cream during October, for the purpose of the preliminary estimate, amounted to 489,800,000 pounds, a decrease of 0.1 per cent from fluid sales in October, 1961. This assumes the same relationship to year-earlier estimates as the July to September average.

According to indications from the monthly survey of farms keeping milk cows, milk and cream consumed in farm homes declined 4.1 per cent below the quantity used in October, 1961, while the use of milk for livestock feeding was moderately greater than a year ago. Farm dairy correspondents participating in the survey, report 1.4 per cent less cows being milked than at the same date last year, but milk production per cow, for cows milked, increased 0.8 per cent above the level at October 15, 1961.

Farm Milk Production, Utilization and Income in September, 1962

Farm Milk Production: The estimated quantity of milk produced on farms in September amounted to 1,798 million pounds, a decrease of 16 million pounds or 0.9 per cent below that of September, 1961. Of this amount, 1,168 million pounds or 65 per cent was utilized in factory production, and approximately 485 million pounds or 27 per cent was used for fluid sales. During the January - September period, the estimated production was 15,115 million pounds, an increase of 77 million pounds over that produced in the same period of the previous year. The quantity of milk utilized for factory production in the January - September period amounted to 9,131 million pounds while fluid sales accounted for 4,428 million pounds.

Fluid Sales: Sales of fluid milk and cream, the latter expressed as milk, amounted to 485 million pounds in September, a decrease of approximately 9 million pounds in comparison with September of the previous year. This included about 408 million pounds of fluid milk, comprising about 23 per cent of the farm milk supply, and fluid cream sales of 77 million pounds representing 4 per cent. During the nine month period, fluid sales totalled 4,428 million pounds, an increase of 86 million pounds or 2.0 per cent over those of the corresponding 1961 period.

Farm Butter: Butter made on farms in September amounted to 533,000 pounds, decreasing 30 per cent from the corresponding month in 1961. For the January - September period, 5,251,000 pounds were produced, a decrease of 17 per cent from the same period last year.

Farm Cash Income: Cash income from the sale of dairy products in September amounted to \$50,077,000. This represented a decrease of 0.1 per cent or \$51,000 in comparison with the same month last year. The weighted average value of \$3.03 per hundred pounds of milk was 3 cents higher than in September 1961. Fluid milk at \$4.75 per hundred was 1 cent higher than in September 1961. Creamery butter-fat increased from 67.3 cents to 67.9 cents per pound, and farm butter at 57 cents per pound was 4 cents lower than in September 1961. Milk used in manufacture averaged \$2.67 per hundred, 4 cents higher than in September 1961. Cheese milk increased to \$2.75 per hundred, an increase of 23 cents per hundred in comparison with the same month a year earlier. Part of the increase may be attributed to the collection of more detail information from Ontario cheese factories since the beginning of the year, which has resulted in higher calculated average unit values than a year ago.

Farm cash income estimates cover all money received by farmers for the sale of milk, cream and farm butter. Government subsidies and bonuses are included in these estimates.

Production and Prices of Dairy Products in September, 1962

Creamery Butter

Production: Creamery butter production amounted to 37.6 million pounds in September, 1962, an increase of approximately 0.6 million pounds as compared to production in the same month of the previous year.

Stocks: Combined holdings of creamery butter and butter oil (in butter equivalent) in store and transit on October 1, amounted to 258.2 million pounds, approximately 53.6 million pounds higher than at October 1 last year. On September 1, 1962, stock holdings at 248.5 million pounds were 54.5 million pounds greater than at the same date a year earlier.

Supply: The combined quantity of creamery butter and butter oil represented by stocks on September 1, plus production and imports during the month, amounted to 286.1 million pounds at September 30, 1962. This was an increase of approximately 55.1 million pounds compared to the corresponding supply figure at September 30, 1961.

Domestic Disappearance: The combined domestic disappearance of creamery butter and butter oil in September amounted to 27.9 million pounds, an increase of 1.5 million pounds or 5.6 per cent more than the corresponding figure for the same month last year. On a per capita basis, it amounted to 1.51 pounds as compared with 1.45 pounds in September, 1961.

Prices at Montreal: Butter prices at Montreal, based on dealers' quotations for first grade solids, averaged 50 1/2 cents per pound in September, as against 62 1/2 cents in September, 1961.

Cheddar Cheese

Production: Cheddar cheese production amounted to approximately 13.3 million pounds, a decrease of approximately 0.7 million pounds as compared to production in the same month of the previous year.

Prices: The Belleville price of Ontario coloured cheese averaged 37 1/2 cents per pound in September. The comparative price in 1961 was 34 1/4 cents.

Ice Cream Mix

The quantity of ice cream mix manufactured in September was approximately 1.8 million gallons or 239 thousand gallons less than that produced a year ago.
