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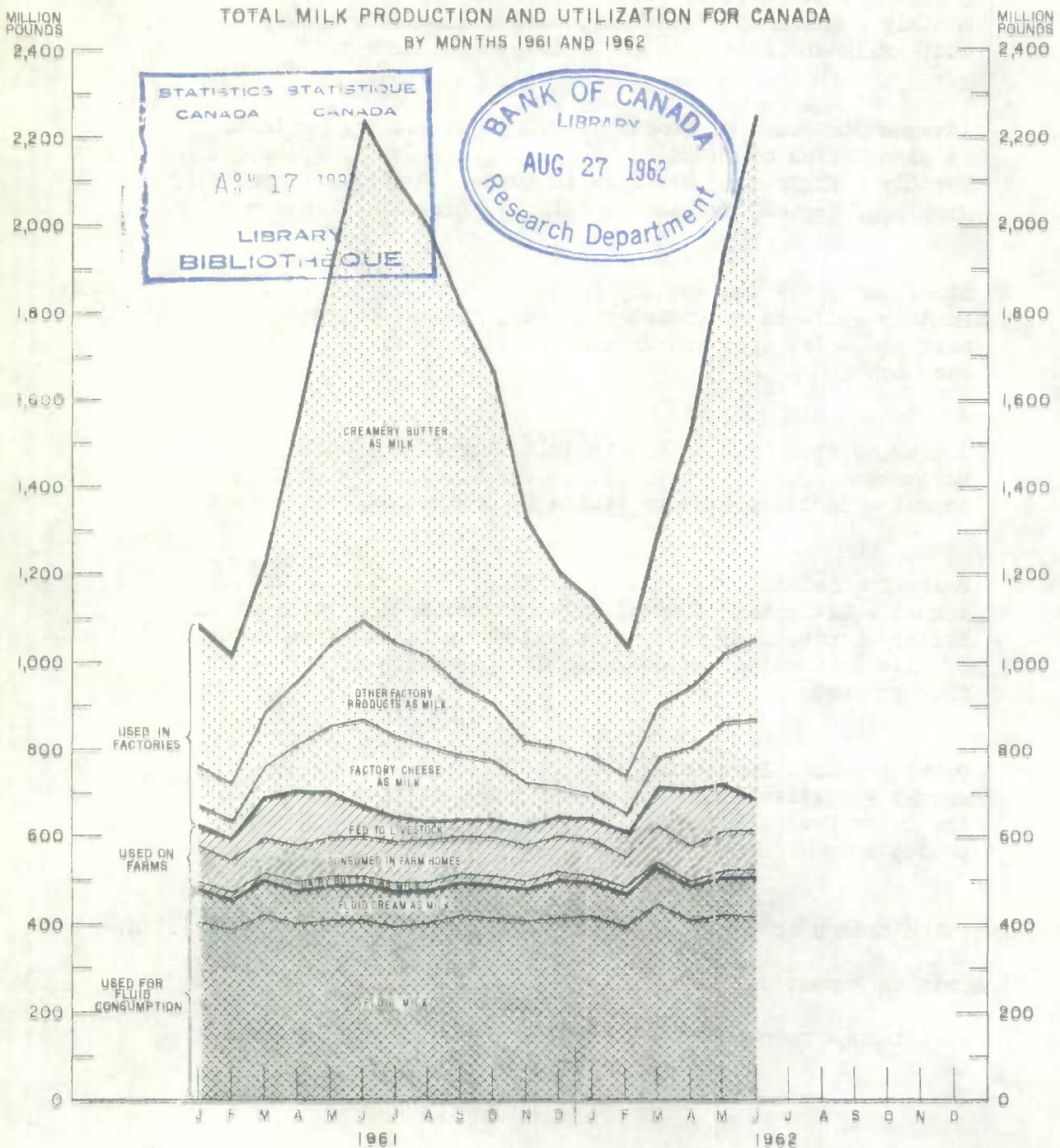

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Preliminary Indications of the Dairy Situation, July, 1962

The preliminary estimate of milk produced in July is 2,112,000,000 pounds. This is 0.3 per cent greater than production in the same month last year and would make the estimate of production for the first seven months of the year 11,314,000,000 pounds. This is 0.8 per cent above production in the January to July period a year ago.

Approximately 69 per cent of the milk produced in July, or 1,459,000,000 pounds, was used for dairy factory products. This represented a decline of 0.3 per cent from factory utilization in July, 1961. Again, declines in milk used in the manufacture of cheese, concentrated whole milk products and ice cream mix, were sufficient to offset an increase in the quantity of milk utilized for creamery butter, compared with a year ago. It will be noted from the table below that because of the above-normal use of butter in the manufacture of ice cream mix, it was necessary to reduce the milk equivalent of this product in order to avoid duplication between the milk equivalent of butter and ice cream mix. Milk utilized for dairy factory products in the period, January to July, was only slightly below that of the corresponding period a year earlier.

Fluid sales of milk and cream in July, for the purpose of the preliminary estimate, amounted to 485,900,000 pounds, an increase of 2.1 per cent over fluid sales in July, 1961. This assumes the same rate of increase obtained when fluid sales in the April to June period are compared with those of the corresponding period last year.

According to indications from the monthly survey of farms keeping milk cows, milk and cream consumed in farm homes was 1.6 per cent below that used in July, 1961, while milk used for livestock feeding was 6.6 per cent greater than that of a year ago. Cows milked on these farms were reported to be down 2.0 per cent from those milking at the same date last year.

Pasture conditions throughout Canada at July 15, except for central Ontario, were generally fair to good and remained favourable to dairying, as shown by the map on page 3. Heavy precipitation in Ontario during the latter part of July brought about rapid recovery while fair to good rains helped to improve pastures and the winter fodder supply in the Prairies.

Farm Milk Production, Utilization and Income in June, 1962

Farm Milk Production: The estimated quantity of milk produced on farms in June, amounted to 2,248 million pounds, an increase of 5 million pounds or 0.2 per cent over that of June, 1961. Of this amount, 1,562 million pounds or 69 per cent was utilized in factory production, and approximately 507 million pounds or 23 per cent was used for fluid sales. During the January - June period, the estimated production was 9,202 million pounds, an increase of 79 million pounds over that produced in the same period of the previous year. The quantity of milk utilized for factory production in the January - June period amounted to 5,129 million pounds while fluid sales accounted for 2,983 million pounds.

Fluid Sales: Sales of fluid milk and cream, the latter expressed as milk, amounted to 507 million pounds in June, an increase of approximately 16 million pounds in comparison with June of the previous year. This included about 417 million pounds of fluid milk, comprising about 19 per cent of the farm milk supply, and fluid cream sales of 90 million pounds representing 4 per cent. During the six month period fluid sales totalled 2,983 million pounds, an increase of 88 million pounds or 3.0 per cent over those of the corresponding 1961 period. -

Farm Butter: Butter made on farms in June amounted to 670,000 pounds, decreasing 9 per cent from the corresponding month in 1961. For the January - June period, 3,567,000 pounds were produced, a decrease of 13 per cent from the same period last year.

Farm Cash Income: Cash income from the sale of dairy products in June amounted to \$59,462,000. This represented an increase of 1.1 per cent or \$667,000 in comparison with the same month last year. The weighted average value of \$2.87 per hundred pounds of milk was 2 cents higher than in June, 1961. Fluid milk at \$4.72 per hundred was 2 cents higher than in June, 1961. Creamery butter-fat increased from 67.0 cents to 67.1 cents per pound, and farm butter at 58 cents per pound was 2 cents lower than in June, 1961. Milk used in manufacture averaged \$2.60 per hundred, 2 cents higher than in June, 1961. Cheese milk increased to \$2.58 per hundred, an increase of 13 cents per hundred in comparison with the same month a year earlier. Part of the increase may be attributed to the collection of more detail information from Ontario cheese factories since the beginning of the year, which has resulted in higher calculated average unit values than a year ago.

Farm cash income estimates cover all money received by farmers for the sale of milk, cream and farm butter. Government subsidies and bonuses are included in these estimates.

Production and Prices of Dairy Products in June, 1962

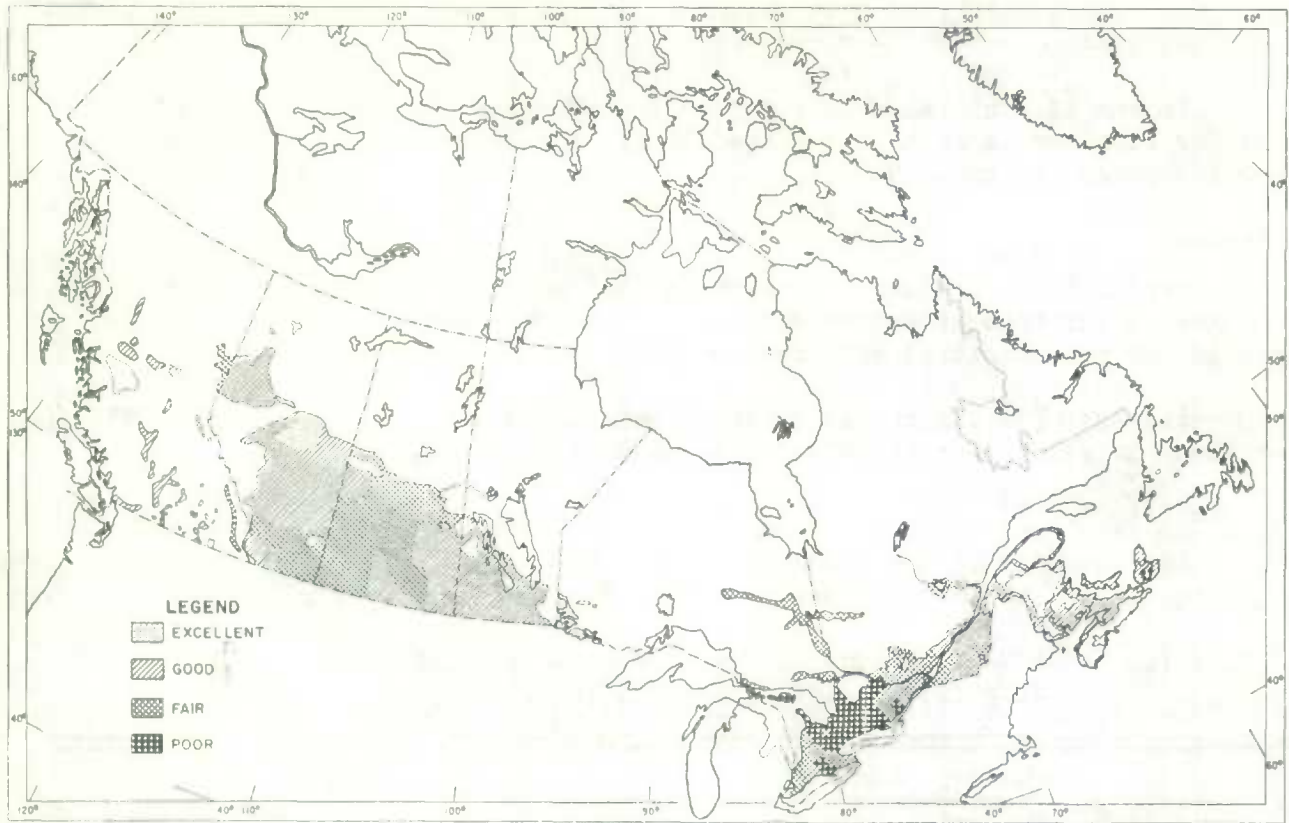
Creamery Butter

Production: Creamery butter production amounted to 51.1 million pounds in June, 1962, an increase of approximately 2.2 million pounds as compared to production in the same month of the previous year.

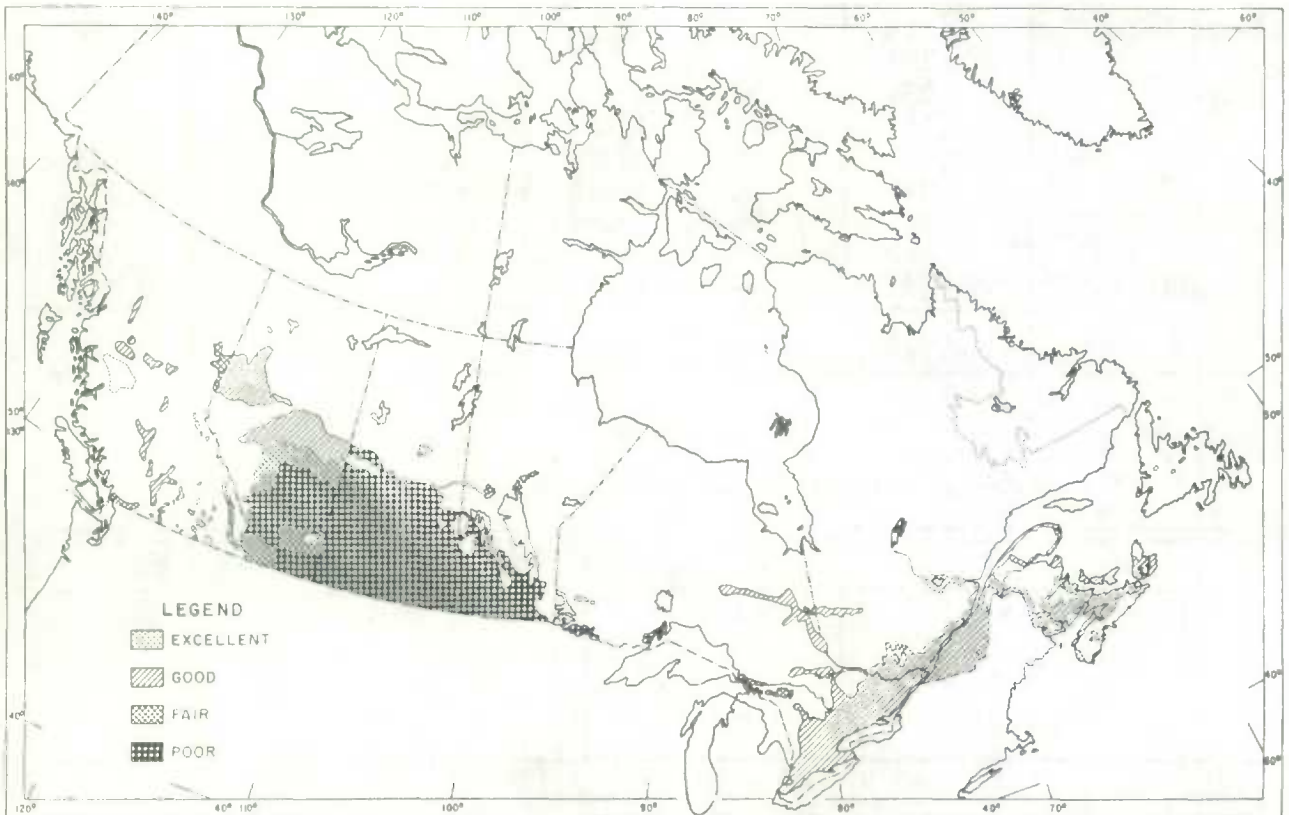
Stocks: Combined holdings of creamery butter and butter oil (in butter equivalent) in store and transit on July 1 amounted to 213.3 million pounds, approximately 59.2 million pounds higher than at July 1 last year. On June 1, 1962, stock holdings at 190.6 million pounds were 61.3 million pounds greater than at the same date a year earlier.

Supply: The combined quantity of creamery butter and butter oil represented by stocks on June 1, plus production and imports during the month, amounted to 241.7 million pounds at June 30, 1962. This was an increase of approximately 63.5 million pounds compared to the corresponding supply figure at June 30, 1961.

Domestic Disappearance: The combined domestic disappearance of creamery butter and butter oil in June amounted to 28.4 million pounds, an increase of 4.3 million pounds or 17.8 per cent more than the corresponding figure for the same month last year. On a per capita basis, it amounted to 1.54 pounds as compared with 1.32 pounds in June, 1961.

Prices at Montreal: Butter prices at Montreal, based on dealers' quotations for first grade solids, averaged 50 1/2 cents per pound in June, as against 62 1/2 cents in June, 1961.

Cheddar Cheese

Production: Cheddar cheese production amounted to approximately 15.5 million pounds, a decrease of approximately 1.5 million pounds as compared to production in the same month of the previous year.

Prices: The Belleville price of Ontario coloured cheese averaged 33 3/4 cents per pound in June. The comparative price in 1961 was 32 1/4 cents.

Ice Cream Mix

The quantity of ice cream mix manufactured in June was approximately 2.8 million gallons or 44 thousand gallons more than that produced a year ago.
