

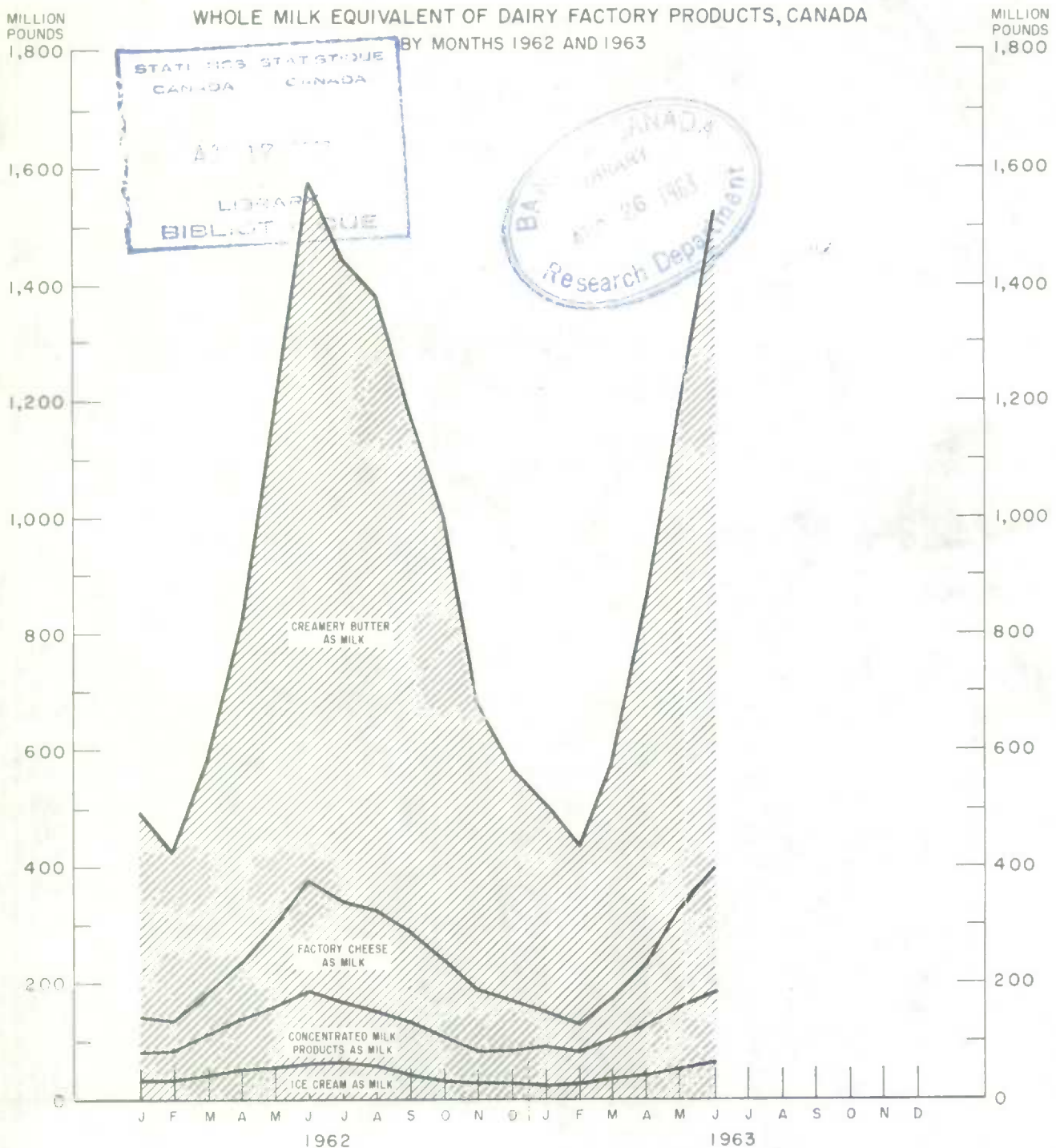

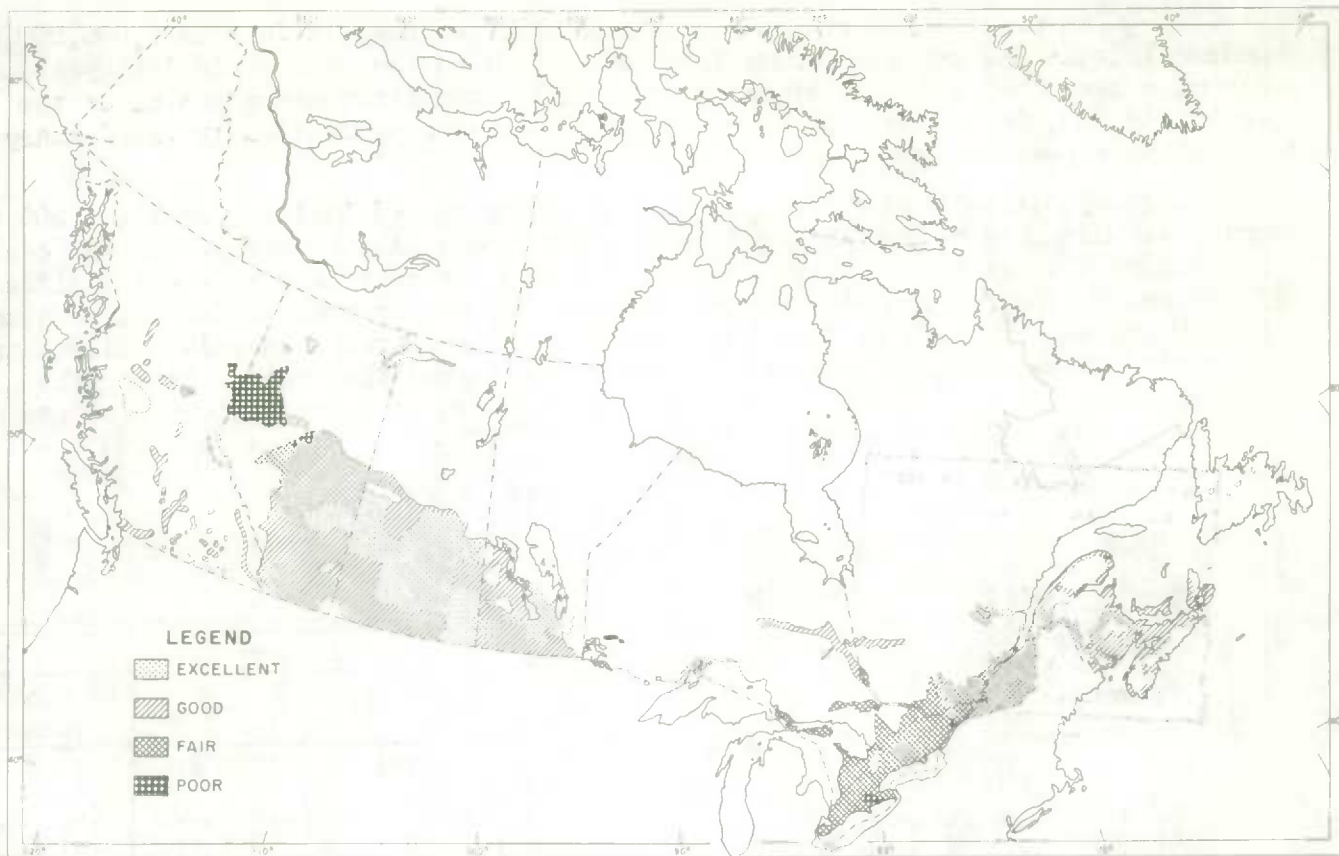

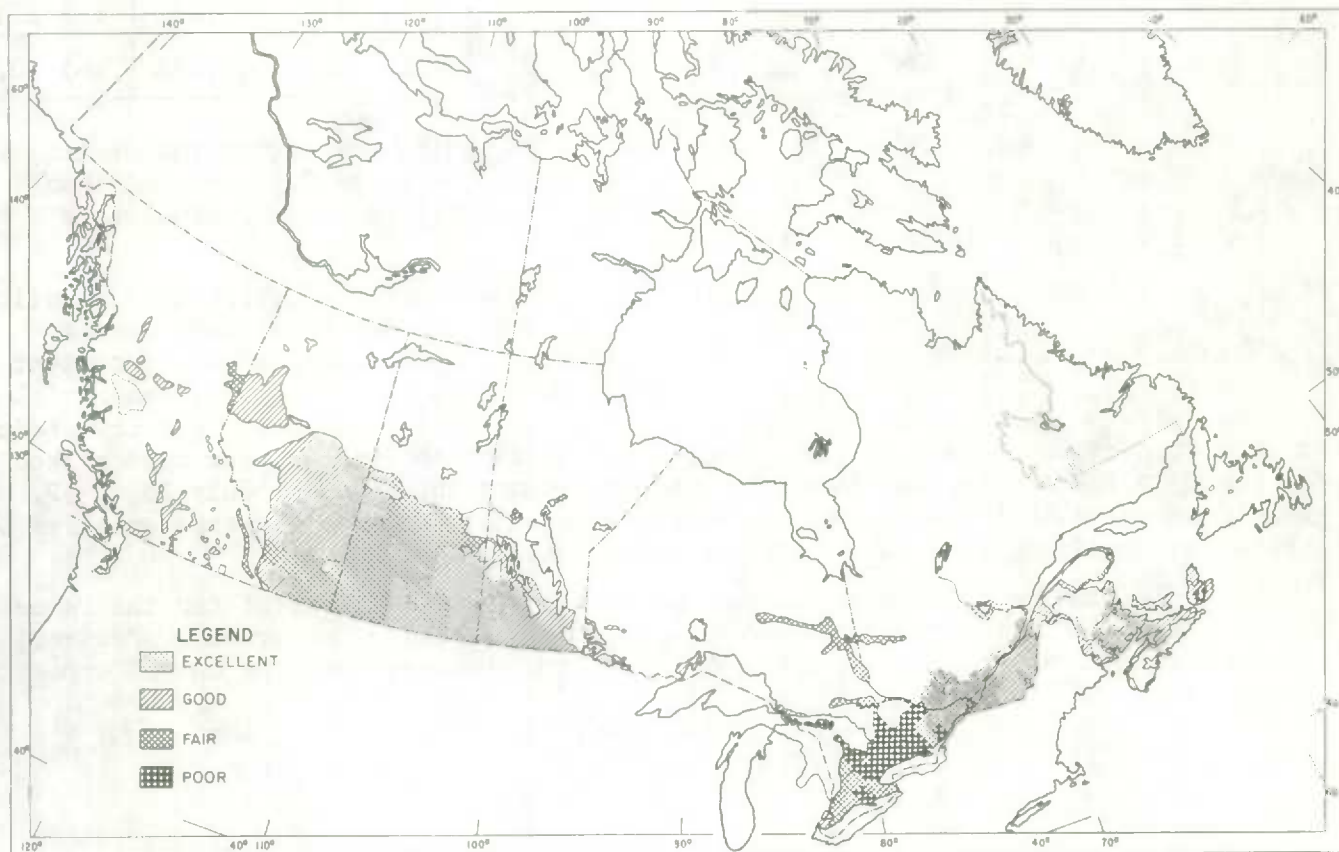

Preliminary Indications of the Dairy Situation, July, 1963

The preliminary estimate of fluid milk produced in July is 2,096,000,000 pounds. This is 0.4 per cent lower than production in the same month last year and would make the total estimate of production during the first seven months of the year 11,268,000,000 pounds. This is 0.3 per cent below production in the January - July period a year ago.

Approximately 70 per cent of the milk produced in July, or 1,469,000,000 pounds, was used for dairy factory products. This was an increase of 0.5 per cent over factory utilization in July, 1962. About 4.0 per cent less milk was utilized for the manufacture of creamery butter in July than a year ago. This decline almost offset increases of 19.2, 8.5 and 15.7 per cent, respectively, in milk utilization for factory cheese, concentrated whole milk products and ice cream. During the January - July period, 0.5 per cent less milk was used in dairy factory products than in the corresponding period in 1962.

Fluid sales of milk and cream in July, for the purpose of the preliminary estimate, are calculated at 472,900,000 pounds, a decrease of 0.9 per cent from fluid sales in July, 1962. This assumes the same relationship to year-earlier estimates as for the month of June.

According to indications from the monthly survey of farms keeping milk cows, milk and cream consumed in farm homes was 1.0 per cent above that used in July, 1962, while milk used for livestock feeding dropped 11.1 per cent from that of a year ago. Farm dairy correspondents participating in the survey, report 1.1 per cent fewer milk cows kept on farms at July 15, and 1.1 per cent less cows being milked than at the same date last year. Milk production per cow, for cows milked on farms in the sample, increased 4.0 per cent above the level at July 15, 1962. It should be noted that these sample indications are not necessarily representative of production conditions on all farms producing milk.

Pasture conditions throughout Canada at July 15, except for the Peace River areas of Alberta and British Columbia, were generally favourable. Regional pasture conditions at July 15, 1962 and 1963, are shown by the maps on the opposite page.

It should be noted here that the 1962 comparative data used and published throughout this report with respect to milk production, utilization and income, are unrevised and exactly as published during the year.

Farm Milk Production, Utilization and Income in June, 1963

Farm Milk Production: The estimated quantity of milk produced on farms in June amounted to 2,195 million pounds, a decrease of 53 million pounds or 2.3 per cent below that of June, 1962. Of this amount, 1,527 million pounds or 69 per cent was utilized in factory production, and approximately 502 million pounds or 23 per cent was used for fluid sales. During the January - June period, the estimated production was 9,172 million pounds, a decrease of 30 million pounds below that produced in the same period of the previous year. The quantity of milk utilized for factory production in the January - June period amounted to 5,090 million pounds while fluid sales accounted for 3,024 million pounds.

Fluid Sales: Sales of fluid milk and cream, the latter expressed as milk, amounted to 502 million pounds in June, a decrease of approximately 4.5 million pounds in comparison with June of the previous year. This included about 416 million pounds of fluid milk, comprising about 19 per cent of the farm milk supply, and fluid cream sales of 86 million pounds representing 4 per cent. During the six month period, fluid sales totalled 3,024 million pounds, an increase of 41 million pounds or 1.4 per cent over those of the corresponding 1962 period.

Farm Butter: Butter made on farms in June amounted to 452,000 pounds, decreasing 33 per cent from the corresponding month in 1962. For the January - June period, 2,553,000 pounds were produced, a decrease of 28 per cent from the same period last year.

Farm Cash Income: Cash income from the sale of dairy products in June amounted to \$58,655,000. This represented a decrease of 1.4 per cent or \$807,000 in comparison with the same month last year. The weighted average value of \$2.89 per hundred pounds of milk was 2 cents higher than in June, 1962. Fluid milk at \$4.71 per hundred was 1 cent lower than in June, 1962. Creamery butter-fat decreased from 67.1 cents to 66.6 cents per pound, and farm butter at 57 cents per pound was 1 cent lower than in June, 1962. Milk used in manufacture averaged \$2.61 per hundred, 1 cent higher than in June, 1962. Cheese milk increased to \$2.75 per hundred, an increase of 17 cents per hundred in comparison with the same month a year earlier.

Farm cash income estimates cover all money received by farmers for the sale of milk, cream and farm butter. Government subsidies and bonuses are included in these estimates.

Production and Prices of Dairy Products in June, 1963

Creamery Butter

Production: Creamery butter production amounted to 48.2 million pounds in June, 1963, a decrease of approximately 3.0 million pounds as compared to production in the same month of the previous year.

Stocks: Combined holdings of creamery butter and butter oil (in butter equivalent) in store and transit on July 1, 1963, amounted to 229.6 million pounds, approximately 15.8 million pounds higher than at July 1 last year. On June 1, 1963, stock holdings at 210.5 million pounds were 20.0 million pounds greater than at the same date a year earlier.

Supply: The combined quantity of creamery butter and butter oil represented by stocks on June 1, plus production and imports during the month, amounted to 258.7 million pounds of butter at June 30, 1963. This was an increase of approximately 16.9 million pounds compared to the corresponding supply figure at June 30, 1962.

Domestic Disappearance: The combined domestic disappearance of creamery butter and butter oil in June amounted to 29.1 million pounds of butter, an increase of 1.1 million pounds or 4.1 per cent more than the corresponding figure for the same month last year. On a per capita basis, it amounted to 1.55 pounds as compared with 1.51 pounds in June, 1962.

Prices at Montreal: Butter prices at Montreal, based on dealers' quotations for first grade solids, averaged 50 1/4 cents per pound in June, as against 50 1/2 cents in June, 1962.

Cheddar Cheese

Production: Cheddar cheese production in June amounted to approximately 18.1 million pounds, an increase of 1.8 million pounds as compared to production in the same month of the previous year.

Prices: The Belleville price of Ontario coloured cheese averaged 36 1/4 cents per pound in June. The comparative price in 1962 was 33 3/4 cents.

Ice Cream Mix

The quantity of ice cream mix manufactured in June was approximately 2.9 million gallons or 148 thousand gallons more than that produced a year ago.

Skim Milk Powder Sales in July, 1963

As additional statistical service to the dairy industry a new survey on net f.o.b. plant selling prices of skim milk powder was started in April. In this survey manufacturing plants are required to report the quantity of product sold in price ranges with intervals of 0.5 cents.

Table 17 is a summary of these reports for the month of July. At time of publication reports had not been received from 4 of 68 plants listed as producing in Quebec and Ontario, therefore, the table should not be interpreted as covering total sales in these provinces.
