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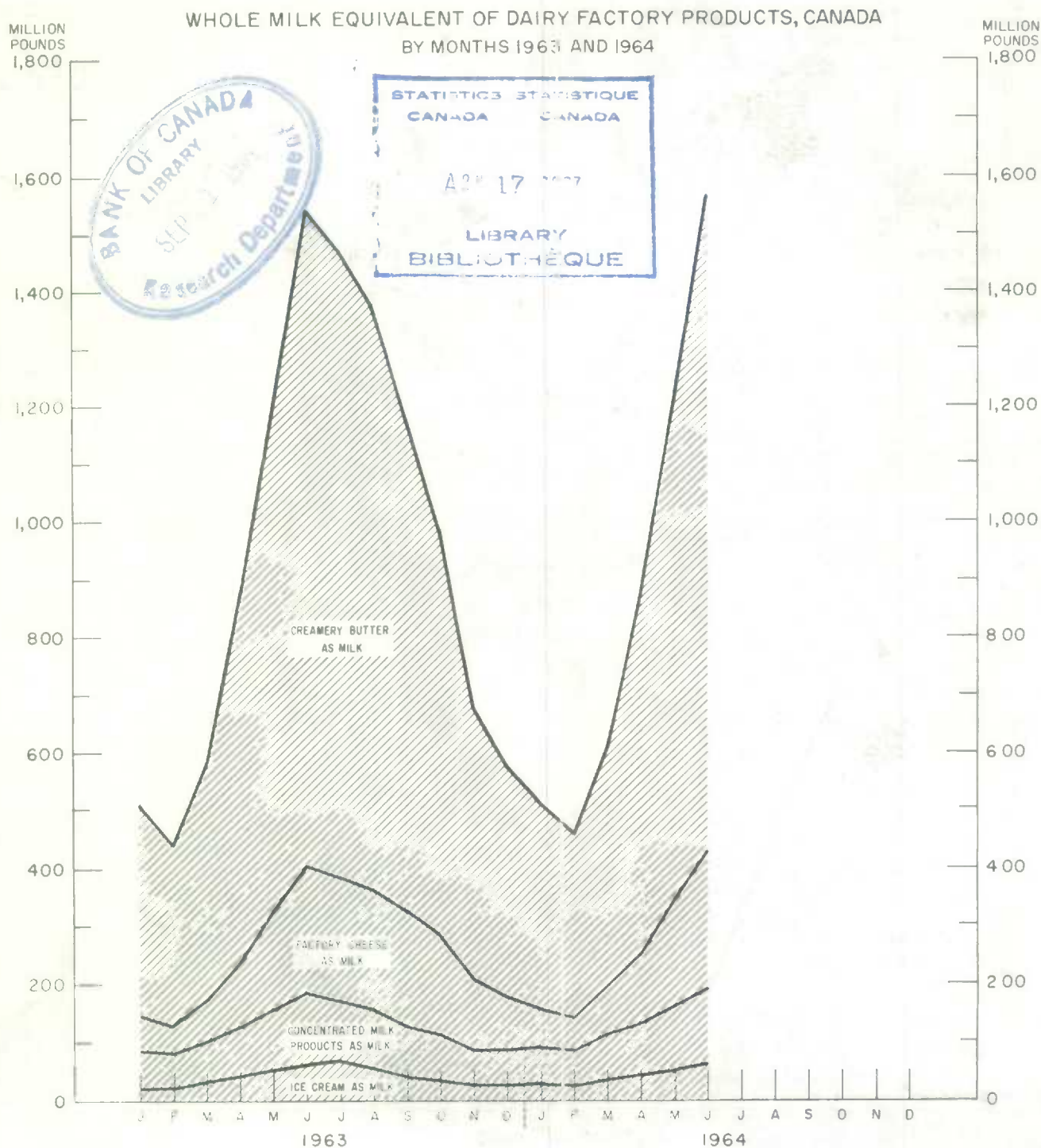

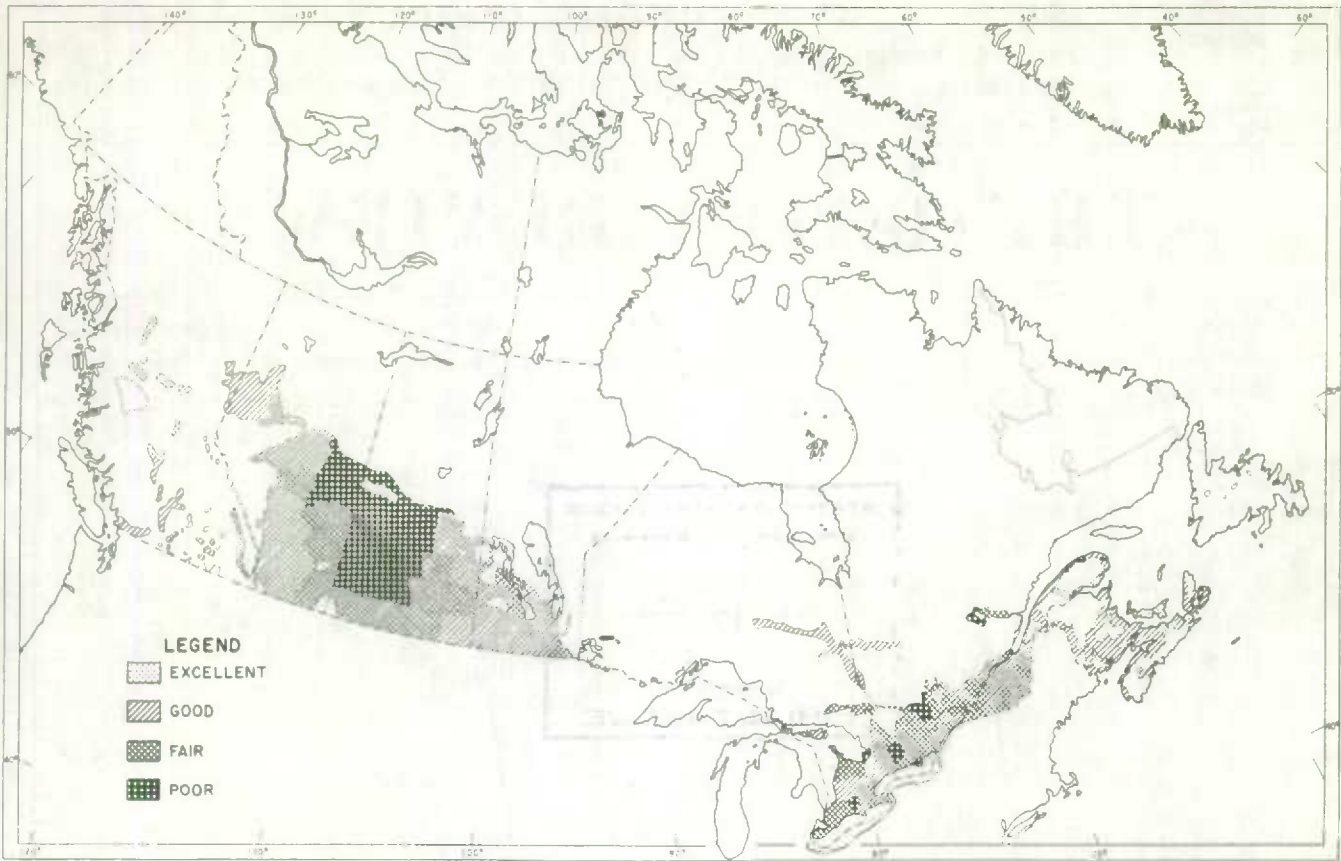

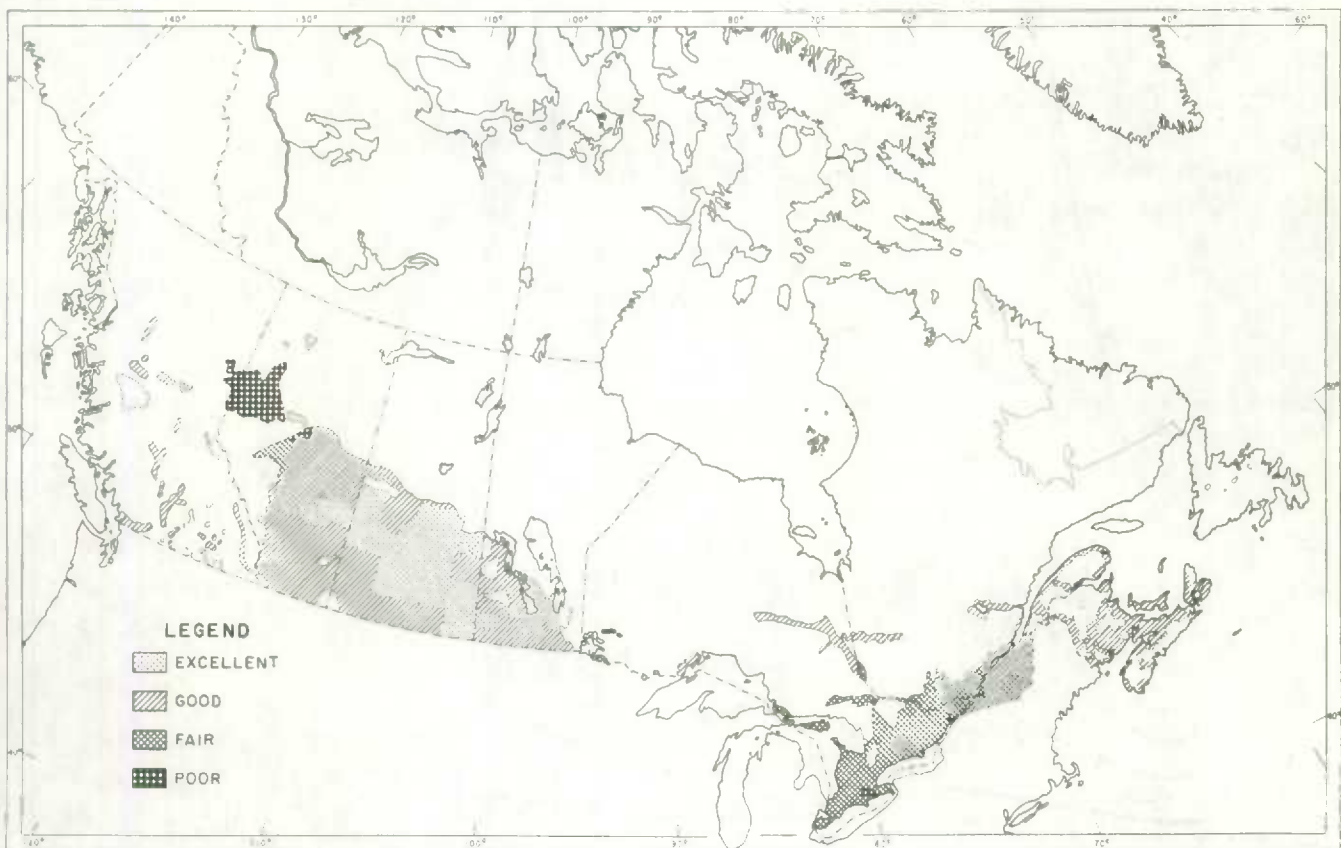
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# PASTURE CONDITIONS ON FARMS KEEPING MILK COWS

PRELIMINARY INDICATIONS OF THE DAIRY SITUATION, JULY 1964(1)

The preliminary estimate of milk produced in July is 2,040,000,000 pounds. This is 0.7 per cent lower than production in the same month last year and would make the total estimate of production during the first seven months of the year 10,861,000,000 pounds. This is 1.0 per cent above production in the January-July period a year ago.

Slightly over 71 per cent of the milk produced in July, or 1,455,000,000 pounds, was used for dairy factory products. This was 1.1 per cent below factory utilization in July, 1963. Factory cheese production during the month used 216,000,000 pounds of milk, 3.5 per cent more than in July, 1963, while milk used in the manufacture of creamery butter, concentrated whole milk products and ice cream mix decreased 1.7, 0.9 and 6.3 per cent, respectively, from that of a year ago. During the January-July period, 1.3 per cent more milk was used in dairy factory products than in the corresponding period in 1963.

Fluid sales of milk and cream during July, for the purpose of the preliminary estimate, are calculated at 427,300,000 pounds, an increase of 1.9 per cent over fluid sales in July, 1963. This assumes the same relationship to year-earlier estimates as for the April - June period.

According to indications from the monthly survey of farms keeping milk cows, milk and cream consumed in farm homes was 0.5 per cent below that used in July, 1963, while milk used for livestock feeding dropped 3.1 per cent from that of a year ago. Farm dairy correspondents participating in the survey report the same number of cows kept on farms at July 15 as a year ago and 0.1 per cent more cows being milked than at the same date last year. Milk production per cow, for cows milked on farms in the sample, decreased 0.6 per cent below the level at July 15, 1963.

Pasture conditions throughout Canada at July 15 were generally fair to good. Drought still persisted in large areas of central and north-central Saskatchewan and the adjacent areas of Alberta. Regional pasture conditions at July 15, 1963 and 1964, are shown by the maps on the opposite page.

FARM MILK PRODUCTION, UTILIZATION AND INCOME IN JUNE, 1964

**Farm Milk Production:** The estimated quantity of milk produced on farms in June amounted to 2,163 million pounds, an increase of 26 million pounds or 1.2 per cent over that of June, 1963. Of this amount 1,564 million pounds or 72 per cent was utilized in factory production, and approximately 428 million pounds or 20 per cent was used for fluid sales. During the January-June period, the estimated production was 8,821 million pounds, an increase of 121 million pounds over that produced in the same period of the previous year. The quantity of milk utilized for factory production in the January-June period amounted to 5,240 million pounds while fluid sales accounted for 2,546 million pounds.

**Fluid Sales:** Sales of fluid milk and cream, the latter expressed as milk, amounted to 428 million pounds in June, an increase of approximately 13 million pounds in comparison with June of the previous year. This included about 356 million pounds of fluid milk, comprising about 17 per cent of the farm milk supply, and fluid cream sales of 72 million pounds representing about 3 per cent. During the six month period, fluid sales totalled 2,546 million pounds, an increase of 65 million pounds or 2.6 per cent over those of the corresponding 1963 period.

**Farm Butter:** Butter made on farms in June amounted to 397,000 pounds, decreasing 28 per cent from the corresponding month in 1963. For the January-June period, 2,277,000 pounds were produced, a decrease of 25 per cent from the same period last year.

**Farm Cash Income:** Cash income from the sale of dairy products in June amounted to \$58,925,000. This represented an increase of 4.5 per cent or \$2,562,000 in comparison with the same month last year. The weighted average value of \$2.96 per hundred pounds of milk was 9 cents higher than in June, 1963. Fluid milk at \$4.86 per hundred was 12 cents higher than in June, 1963. Creamery butter-fat increased from 69.3 cents to 70.8 cents per pound, and farm butter at 57 cents per pound was one cent higher than in June, 1963. Milk used in manufacture averaged \$2.64 per hundred, 7 cents higher than in June, 1963. Cheese milk increased to \$2.87 per hundred, an increase of 12 cents per hundred in comparison with the same month a year earlier.

Farm cash income estimates cover all money received by farmers for the sale of milk, cream and farm butter. Government subsidies and bonuses are included in these estimates. The estimates, however, do not make any allowances for costs incurred by farmers in the production of dairy products.



PRODUCTION AND PRICES OF DAIRY PRODUCTS IN JUNE, 1964

Creamery Butter

Production: Creamery butter production amounted to 48.7 million pounds in June, 1964, a decrease of approximately 14 thousand pounds as compared to production in the same month of the previous year.

Stocks: Combined holdings of creamery butter and butter oil (in butter equivalent) in store and transit on July 1, 1964, amounted to 170.7 million pounds, approximately 59.5 million pounds lower than at July 1 last year. On June 1, 1964, stock holdings at 162.3 million pounds were 48.2 million pounds less than at the same date a year earlier.

Supply: The combined quantity of creamery butter and butter oil represented by stocks on June 1, plus production and imports during the month amounted to 211.0 million pounds of butter at June 30, 1964. This was a decrease of approximately 48.3 million pounds compared to the corresponding supply figure at June 30, 1963.

Domestic Disappearance: The combined domestic disappearance of creamery butter and butter oil in June amounted to 29.1 million pounds of butter, an increase of 31 thousand pounds or 0.1 per cent more than the corresponding figure for the same month last year. On a per capita basis, it amounted to 1.52 pounds as compared with 1.54 pounds in June, 1963.

Prices at Montreal: Butter prices at Montreal, based on dealers' quotations for first grade solids, average 51 3/4 cents per pound in June, as against 50 1/4 cents in June, 1963.

Cheddar Cheese

Production: Cheddar cheese production in June amounted to approximately 19.6 million pounds, an increase of about 1.1 million pounds compared to production in the same month of the previous year.

Prices: The Belleville price of Ontario coloured cheese averaged 38 cents per pound in June. The comparative price in 1963 was 36 1/4 cents.

Ice Cream Mix

The quantity of ice cream mix manufactured in June was approximately 2.9 million gallons or 4 thousand gallons more than that produced a year ago.
