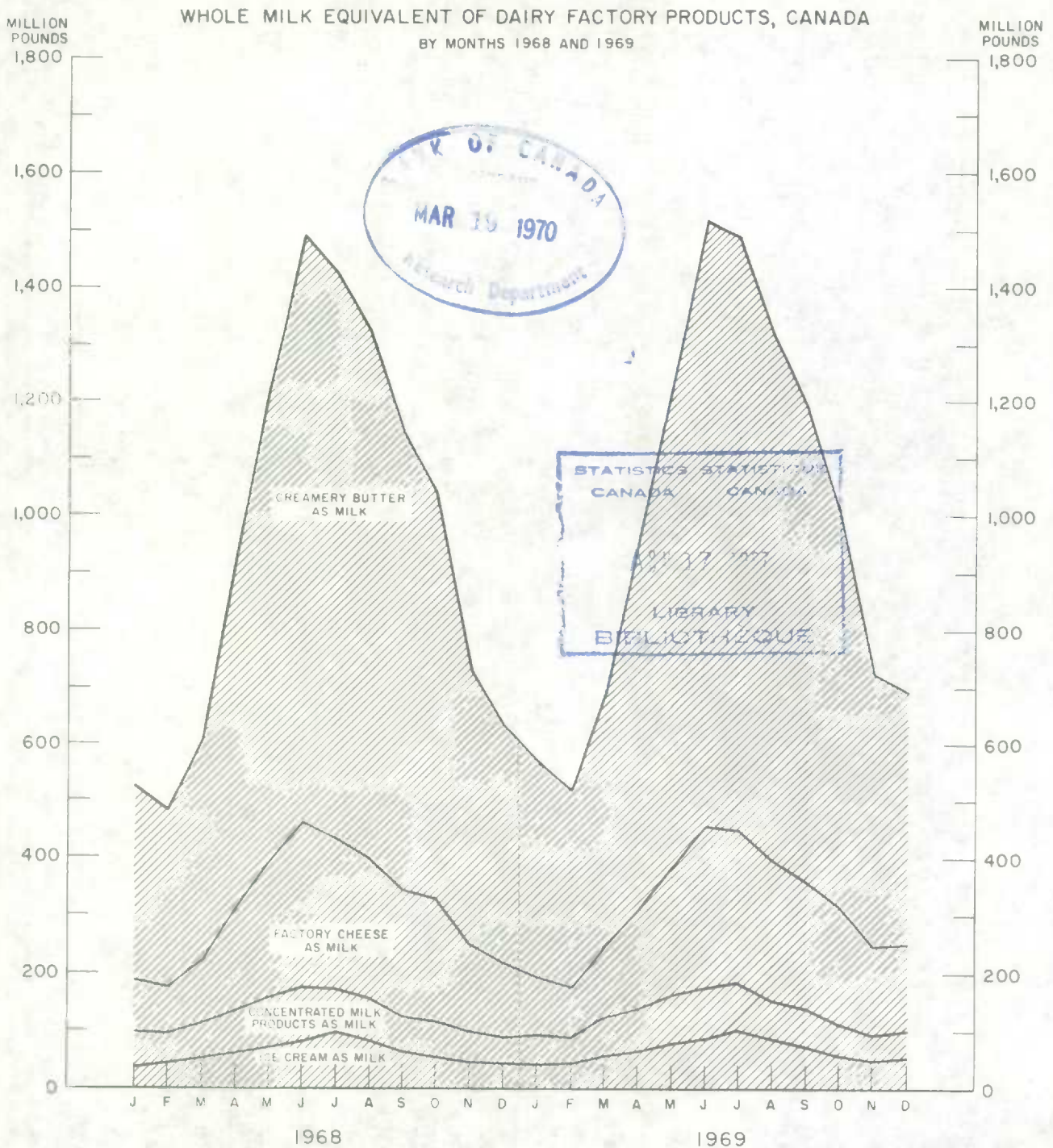

Preliminary Indications of the Dairy Situation, January 1970

The preliminary estimate of milk produced in January is 1,157,000,000 pounds which is 3.5 per cent above production in the corresponding month last year.

Slightly over 53 per cent of the milk produced in January, or 615,000,000 pounds, was used for dairy factory products. This is 6.1 per cent above factory utilization in January 1969. Creamery butter production during the month accounted for 394,000,000 pounds of milk, 3.7 per cent more than in January a year ago; however, milk used for factory cheese and ice cream mix increased 19.6 and 13.9 per cent, respectively. Approximately 10.8 per cent less milk was used for concentrated whole milk products than in January 1969.

Revised data for 1968 and 1969 indicate that 12.0 billion pounds of milk went into the manufacture of dairy factory products during 1969, which is an increase of 3.5 per cent over the corresponding figure for 1968. Creamery butter production required about 8.2 billion pounds of milk during 1969, 4.2 per cent more than in 1968. All factory cheese accounted for 2.3 billion pounds of milk, while the remaining 1.5 billion pounds of milk was used for concentrated whole milk products and ice cream mix.

Fluid sales of milk and cream during January, for purposes of the advance preliminary estimate, are calculated at 425,000,000 pounds of milk, an increase of 0.9 per cent from the sales in January 1969. This assumes the same relationship to year-earlier estimates as for the October - December period.

According to indications from the monthly survey of farms keeping milk cows, milk and cream consumed in farm homes was 0.5 per cent above that used in January 1969, while milk used for livestock feeding increased 0.6 per cent from that of a year ago. Reports from farm dairy correspondents participating in the survey indicate 1.9 per cent fewer cows kept on farms at January 15, and 0.4 per cent less cows being milked than at the same date last year. Milk production per cow, for cows milked on farms in the sample, increased 6.4 per cent from the level at January 15, 1969.

FARM MILK PRODUCTION, UTILIZATION AND CASH RECEIPTS IN DECEMBER 1969

Farm Milk Production. — The estimated quantity of milk produced on farms in December amounted to 1,258 million pounds, an increase of 78 million pounds or 6.6 per cent over that of December 1968. Of this amount, 692 million pounds or 55 per cent was utilized in factory production, and approximately 451 million pounds or 36 per cent was used for fluid sales. During the January-December period, the estimated production was 18,698 million pounds, an increase of 336.5 million pounds from the corresponding period last year. The quantity of milk utilized for factory production in the January-December period amounted to 12,035 million pounds while fluid sales accounted for 5,088 million pounds.

Fluid Sales. — Sales of fluid milk and cream, the latter expressed as milk, amounted to 451 million pounds in December, an increase of approximately 20 million pounds from December of last year. This included about 379 million pounds of fluid milk, comprising about 30 per cent of the farm milk supply, and fluid cream sales of 72 million pounds representing about 6 per cent. During the twelve month period, fluid sales totalled 5,088 million pounds, a decrease of 41.5 million pounds or 0.8 per cent less than the corresponding period a year earlier.

Farm Butter. — Butter made on farms in December amounted to 226,000 pounds, decreasing 3 per cent from the corresponding month in 1968. For the January-December period, 2,869,000 pounds were produced, a decrease of 6 per cent from the same period last year.

Farm Cash Receipts. — Cash receipts from the sale of dairy products in December amounted to \$49,119,000. This represented an increase of 7.9 per cent or \$3,591,000 from the corresponding month last year. The weighted average value of \$4.30 per hundred pounds of milk was 3 cents higher than in December 1968. Fluid milk at \$6.42 per hundred was 7 cents higher than in December 1968. Cream for butter at 65.2 cents per pound butterfat was 0.4 cents lower than in December 1968, and farm butter at 63 cents per pound was the same as in December 1968. Milk used in the manufacture of all dairy products averaged \$3.44 per hundred, 3 cents higher than in December 1968. Cheese milk increased to \$3.57 per hundred, an increase of 2 cents per hundred from the corresponding month a year earlier. Of all the milk utilized for factory dairy products in December 1969, not more than 62 per cent was eligible for Federal government subsidy.

Estimates of farm cash receipts from the sale of dairy products, as set forth in this report, include the basic plant paying price less haulage and, where applicable, quality premiums, bonuses, patronage dividends and those government subsidies which have been paid indirectly through plants as part of the plant price. They do not include government payments made direct to farmers by government cheque, nor do they reflect any allowance for costs incurred by farmers in the production of dairy products.

Direct Federal subsidy payments during the 1967-68 dairy year amounted to approximately \$1.10 per hundred pounds for 3.5 per cent processing milk or the equivalent of 31.42 cents per pound butterfat. Commencing on April 1, 1968, these net payments were increased to \$1.16 and 36.42 cents, respectively, for milk and cream; however, effective with August 1968 deliveries, payments were reduced from \$1.16 to \$1.10 per hundred for milk but that for cream remained unchanged. On April 1, 1969, average payments were reduced to approximately 96 cents per hundred

pounds of milk and 34.71 cents for cream, dependent on deliveries up to quota and on those in excess of quota during the dairy year and under certain conditions subject to adjustment.

Direct Federal and Provincial payments have been designated as Supplementary Payments and are as follows in thousands of dollars for each province for 1969 (1968 in brackets): Canada, \$86,942 (\$109,700); P.E.I., \$1,509 (\$1,863); N.S., \$417 (\$606); N.B., \$982 (\$1,276); Que., \$38,234 (\$47,474); Ont., \$29,767 (\$36,757); Man., \$4,041 (\$5,313); Sask., \$3,252 (\$4,748); Alta., \$7,911 (\$10,154); and B.C., \$829 (\$1,509).

PRODUCTION AND PRICES OF DAIRY PRODUCTS IN DECEMBER 1969

Creamery butter

Production. — Creamery butter production amounted to 19.1 million pounds in December 1969, an increase of approximately 1.3 million pounds from production in the same month of the previous year.

Stocks. — Holdings of creamery butter in store on January 1, 1970, amounted to 90.0 million pounds, approximately 27.5 million pounds higher than at January 1 last year. On December 1, 1969, stock holdings at 99.7 million pounds were 28.2 million pounds more than at the same date a year earlier.

Supply. — Stocks of creamery butter on December 1, plus production and imports during the month, amounted to 118.8 million pounds of butter at December 31, 1969. This was an increase of approximately 26.1 million pounds compared to the corresponding supply figure at December 31, 1968.

Domestic disappearance. — The domestic disappearance of creamery butter in December amounted to 28.8 million pounds of butter, a decrease of 1.4 million pounds or 4.8 per cent less than the corresponding figure for the same month last year. On a per capita basis, it amounted to 1.36 pounds as compared with 1.46 pounds in December 1968.

Prices at Montreal. — Butter prices at Montreal, based on dealers' quotations for first grade solids, averaged 65 cents per pound in December, the same as in December 1968.

Cheddar cheese

Production. — Cheddar cheese production in December amounted to approximately 9.7 million pounds, an increase of about 1.1 thousand pounds from production in the same month of the previous year.

Prices. — The Belleville price of Ontario coloured cheese averaged 47 1/4 cents per pound in December, as against 46 1/4 cents in December, 1968.

Ice cream mix

The quantity of ice cream mix manufactured in December was approximately 1.8 million gallons or 142 thousand gallons more than that produced a year ago.

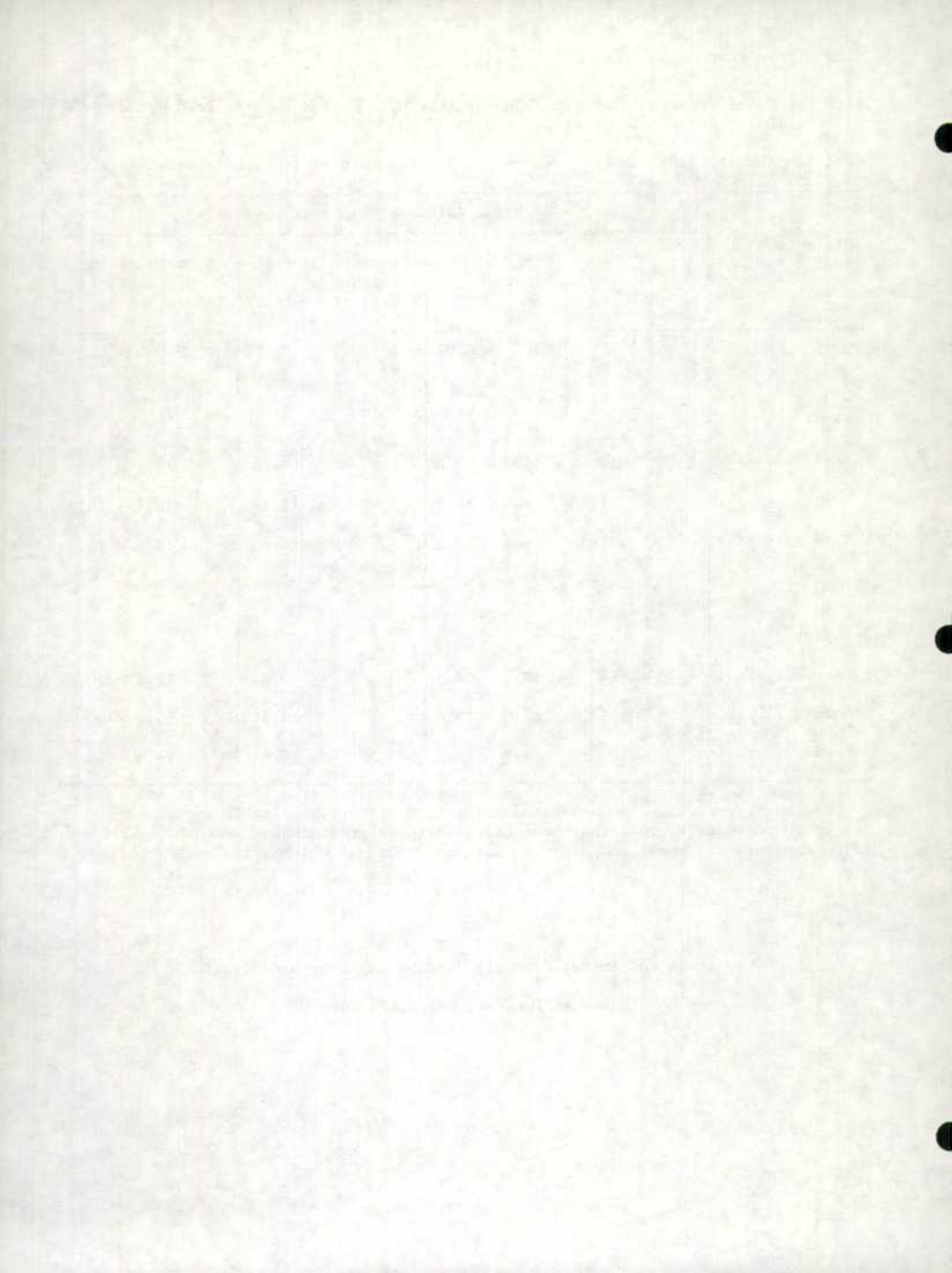

SUPPLEMENT TO THE DAIRY REVIEW, JANUARY, 1970

The green pages of this supplement contain revised statistics of milk production and utilization for 1968 and 1969. Utilization data include butter made on farms, the milk equivalent of dairy factory products and fluid sales, milk fed to livestock and milk consumed in farm homes. The 1969 data differ from previously published information which appeared in monthly issues of The Dairy Review in that virtually 100 per cent of the dairy factories and milk distributors known to be operating in Canada have forwarded complete monthly information for the year. Some have corrected monthly reports forwarded earlier. When monthly publications go to press, publication deadlines make it necessary to estimate production and/or sales for late reporting firms. The 1968 data has been revised slightly from that shown in the supplement to the January 1969 issue of The Dairy Review. Minor changes result from further corrections submitted by firms for that year.

Milk production estimates are the sum of the quantities of milk used in factories, by milk distributors and on farms. Since reporters supply information in terms of dairy products, these products must be converted to milk equivalent. The conversion factors used are found on page 10 of the supplement.

The yellow pages contain revised farm cash receipts data that correspond to the revised production data appearing in the green pages. Generally the average values used are similar to those used for 1968 and 1969 in the monthly issues of The Dairy Review. Most of the revisions in farm cash receipts are caused by related changes in milk utilization estimates.

Farm cash receipts exclude federal and provincial Supplementary Payments made to producers in 1968 and 1969, but include butter-fat premium payments for milk and cream used exclusively for manufacturing purposes in Quebec during the period January 1, 1968 to March 31, 1968, inclusive. Combined federal and provincial Supplementary Payments in 1969 (1968 in brackets) were distributed as follows: (in thousands of dollars) Canada, \$86,942 (\$109,700; P.E.I., \$1,509 (\$1,863); N.S., \$417 (\$606); N.B., \$982 (\$1,276); Que., \$38,234 (\$47,474); Ont., \$29,767 (\$36,757); Man., \$4,041 (\$5,313); Sask., \$3,252 (\$4,748); Alta., \$7,911 (\$10,154); and B.C., \$829 (\$1,509).

The pink pages contain revised statistics of quarterly cottage cheese production, as well as monthly ice cream, milkshake mix, sherbet, water ices and ice milk production for 1968 and 1969.

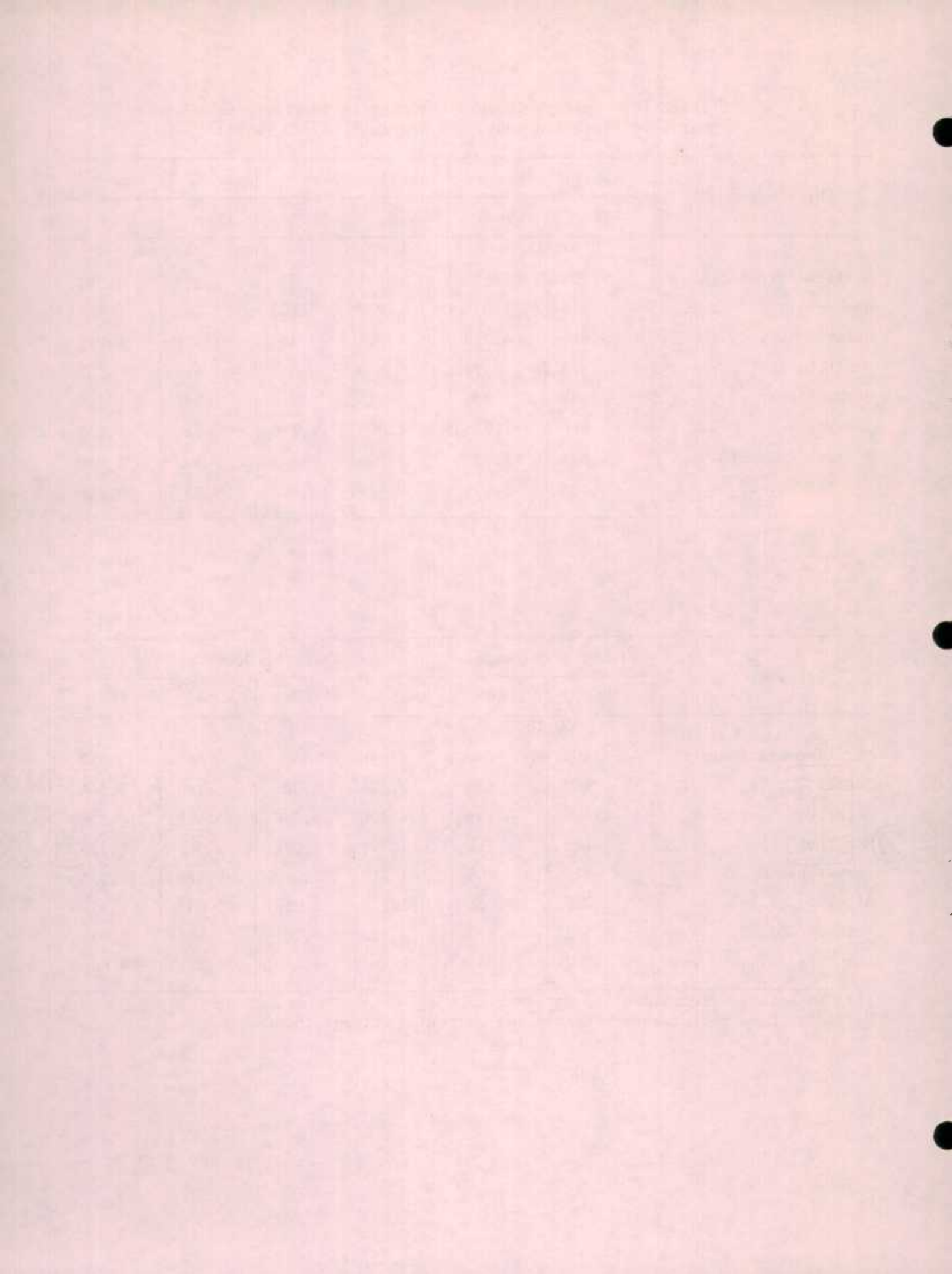
