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

BY MONTHS 1971 AND 1972



PRELIMINARY INDICATIONS OF THE DAIRY SITUATION, JANUARY 1973

The preliminary estimate of milk produced in January is 1,098,000,000 pounds, which is 2.5 % below production in the corresponding month last year.

Slightly over 51 % of the milk produced in January, or 563,000,000 pounds, was used for dairy factory products. This is 7.1 % below factory utilization in January 1972. Creamery butter production during the month accounted for 298,000,000 pounds of milk, 8.1 % less than in January a year ago, while milk used in the manufacture of factory cheese declined 12.3 %. Approximately 13.6 and 2.7 % more milk was used for concentrated whole milk products and ice cream mix, respectively, than in January 1972.

Revised data for 1971 and 1972 indicate that 11.1 billion pounds of milk went into the manufacture of dairy factory products during 1972, which is an increase of 1.0 % from the corresponding figure for 1971. Creamery butter production required about 6.8 billion pounds of milk during 1972, 1.4 % more than in 1971. All factory cheese accounted for 2.8 billion pounds of milk, while the remaining 1.5 billion pounds of milk was used for concentrated whole milk products and ice cream mix.

Fluid sales of milk and cream during January, for purposes of the advance preliminary estimate, are calculated at 449,000,000 pounds, an increase of 3.6 % from the sales in January 1972. This assumes the same relationship to year-earlier estimates as for the October-December period.

According to indications from the monthly survey of farms keeping milk cows, milk and cream consumed in farm homes was 1.6 % below that used in January 1972, while milk used for livestock feeding increased 0.7 % from that of a year ago. Reports from farm dairy correspondents participating in the survey indicate 0.4 % fewer cows kept on farms at January 15 and 2.5 % less cows being milked than at the same date last year. Milk production per cow, for cows milked on farms in the sample, increased 3.1 % from the level at January 15, 1972.

FORM MILK PRODUCTION, UTILIZATION AND CASH RECEIPTS IN DECEMBER 1972

Farm Milk Production. — The estimated quantity of milk produced on farms in December amounted to 1,130 million pounds, a decrease of 51 million pounds or 4.2 per cent below that of December 1971. Of this amount, 668 million pounds or 51 per cent was utilized in factory production, and approximately 493 million pounds or 42 per cent was used for fluid sales. During the January-December period, the estimated production was 17,709 million pounds, a decrease of 66 million pounds from the corresponding period last year. The quantity of milk utilized for factory production in the January-December period amounted to 11,119 million pounds while fluid sales accounted for 5,427 million pounds.

Fluid Sales. — Sales of fluid milk and cream, the latter expressed as milk, amounted to 493 million pounds in December, an increase of approximately 25 million pounds from December of last year. This included about 412 million pounds of fluid milk, comprising about 35 per cent of the farm milk supply, and fluid cream sales of 81 million pounds representing about 7 per cent. During the twelve month period, fluid sales totalled 5,427 million pounds, an increase of 152 million pounds or 2.9 per cent over those of the corresponding period a year earlier.

Farm Butter. — Butter made on farms in December amounted to 180,000 pounds, decreasing 6 per cent from the corresponding month in 1971. For the January-December period, 2,257,000 pounds were produced, a decrease of 9 per cent from the same period last year.

Farm Cash Receipts. — Cash receipts from the sale of dairy products in December amounted to \$56,161,000. This represented an increase of 2.4 per cent or \$1,305,000 from the corresponding month last year. The weighted average value of \$5.15 per hundred pounds of milk was 18 cents higher than in December 1971. Fluid milk at \$6.94 per hundred was 15 cents higher than in December 1971. Cream for butter at 68.4 cents per pound butterfat was 1.2 cents lower than in December 1971, and farm butter at 65 cents per pound was 2 cents higher than in December 1971. Milk used in the manufacture of all dairy products averaged \$4.28 per hundred, 2 cents higher than in December 1971. Cheese milk at \$4.50 per hundred, was 10 cents higher than the corresponding month a year earlier. Of all the milk utilised for factory dairy products in December 1972, not more than 74 per cent was eligible for Federal government subsidy.

Estimates of farm cash receipts from the sale of dairy products, as set forth in this report, include the basic plant paying price less haulage and, where applicable, quality premiums, bonuses, patronage dividends and those government subsidies which have been paid indirectly through plants as part of the plant price. They do not include government payments made direct to farmers by government cheque, nor do they reflect any allowance for costs incurred by farmers in the production of dairy products.

PRODUCTION AND PRICES OF DAIRY PRODUCTS IN DECEMBER 1972

Creamery Butter

Production. — Creamery butter production amounted to 13.8 million pounds in December 1972, a decrease of approximately 1.2 million pounds from production in the same month of the previous year.

Stocks. — Holdings of creamery butter in store on January 1, 1973 amounted to 29.6 million pounds, approximately 21.7 million pounds less than at January 1, last year. On December 1, 1972 stock holdings at 41.5 million pounds were 16.6 million pounds less than at the same date a year earlier.

Supply. — Stocks of creamery butter on December 1, plus production and imports during the month, amounted to 59.3 million pounds of butter at December 31, 1972. This was a decrease of approximately 21.5 million pounds compared to the corresponding supply figure at December 31, 1971.

Domestic disappearance. — The domestic disappearance of creamery butter in December amounted to 29.7 million pounds of butter, an increase of 0.2 million pounds or 0.7 per cent more than the corresponding figure for the same month last year. On a per capita basis, it amounted to 1.36 pounds as compared with 1.37 pounds in December 1971.

Prices at Montreal. — Butter prices at Montreal, based on dealers' quotations for first grade solids, averaged 68 cents per pound in December, the same as in December 1971.

Cheddar Cheese

Production. — Cheddar cheese production in December amounted to approximately 11.9 million pounds, a decrease of about 3.6 million pounds from production in the same month of the previous year.

Prices. — The Belleville price of Ontario coloured cheese averaged 63 1/4 cents per pound in December. The comparative price in 1971 was 67 1/8.

Ice Cream Mix

The quantity of ice cream mix manufactured in December was approximately 1.9 million gallons or 120 thousands gallons more than that produced a year ago.





SUPPLEMENT TO THE DAIRY REVIEW, JANUARY, 1973

The green pages of this supplement contain revised statistics of milk production and utilization for 1971 and 1972. Utilization data include butter made on farms, the milk equivalent of dairy factory products and fluid sales, milk fed to livestock and milk consumed in farm homes. The 1972 data differ from previously published information which appeared in monthly issues of The Dairy Review in that virtually 100 per cent of the dairy factories and milk distributors known to be operating in Canada have forwarded complete monthly information for the year. Some have corrected monthly reports forwarded earlier. When monthly publications go to press, publication deadlines make it necessary to estimate production and/or sales for late reporting firms. The 1971 data has been revised slightly from that shown in the supplement to the January 1972 issue of The Dairy Review. Minor changes result from further corrections submitted by firms for that year.

Milk production estimates are the sum of the quantities of milk used in factories, by milk distributors and on farms. Since reporters supply information in terms of dairy products, these products must be converted to milk equivalent. The conversion factors used are found on page 10 of the supplement.

The yellow pages contain revised farm cash receipts data that correspond to the revised production data appearing in the green pages. Generally the average values used are similar to those used for 1971 and 1972 in the monthly issues of The Dairy Review. Most of the revisions in farm cash receipts are caused by related changes in milk utilization estimates.

Farm cash receipts exclude federal Supplementary Payments made to producers in 1971 and 1972. Federal Supplementary Payments in 1972 (1971 in brackets) were distributed as follows: (in thousands of dollars) Canada, \$101,410 (\$100,336); P.E.I., \$1,730 (\$1,405); N.S. \$230 (\$269); N.B., \$805 (\$800); Que., \$50,133 (\$51,511); Ont., \$33,359 (\$33,099); Man., \$3,913 (\$3,471); Sask., \$3,060 (\$2,748); Alta., \$7,851 (\$6,743); and B.C., \$329 (\$290).

The pink pages contain revised statistics of quarterly cottage cheese and yogurt production, as well as monthly ice cream, milkshake mix, sherbet, water ices and ice milk production for 1971 and 1972. In addition, factory cheese other than cheddar and unsalted butter production statistics have been included in this publication.


