MONTHLY POULTRY ESTIMATES

The first estimate of net production of hen eggs in Canada during June 1948 was 41,941,000 dozens, being 38,592,000 dozens on farms and 3,349,000 dozens on property of other producers. This production was at the rate of 1,507 eggs per 100 layers. The average number of layers <u>on farms</u> was 31,085,000. The cumulative net production from January 1 to June 30 totalled 258,227,000 dozens eggs of which 237,319,000 dozens were produced on farms, while 20,908,000 dozens were non-farm production.

The egg disposition during June amounted to 34,182,000 dozens sold for consumption (of which 31,454,300 dozens came from farms) at a total value of \$13,550,200; 440,300 dozens were sold for hatching for \$258,500 and 7,668,000 dozens were used on farms, and by other producers, for food and for hatching. The difference between total net production and total disposition represents the difference in quantities of fresh ergs on hand on farms on 31st May and 30th June.
