MONTHLY POULTRY ESTIMATES

The hens of Canada were estimated to have had a net egg production of 24,468,000 dozens during September 1948. Of these, 22,410,000 dozens were produced on farms and 2,058,000 dozens on places other than farms. While there was an increase in eggs per 100 layers to 1,033 from 1,019 in September 1947 there was a decrease in the average number of layers and a reduction of four million dozen eggs in the total net production.

The data on layers as at June 1, 1948 and subsequent months are reported below. They show a Canada total of 26,217,000 hens on June 1 with a monthly decrease until September, when pullets became layers in sufficient number to overcome the reduction from culling and to raise the total to 26,773,000 layers.

The figures <sup>for</sup> previous months of 1948 have been revised in accordance with the new data on layers as at June 1 and the net production for each month has been revised as has also the monthly disposition. These revisions are also contained in the new cumulative net production figures for January to September inclusive.
