PRODUCTION OF EGGS

October, 1957

The estimated production of eggs in Canada 1/ during October was 37.2 million dozen, as compared with 34.6 million dozen last month and the 33.8 million dozen for October last year. The estimate of egg production during the first ten months of 1957 was 368.0 million dozen compared with 327.9 2/ million dozen for the same period in 1956.

Average egg production per layer during October was 13.7 eggs compared with 13.2 eggs last month. The rate of lay for October, 1956 was 13.2.

Producers sold 33.0 million dozen eggs for market during October compared with the September estimate of 30.3 million dozen. Estimated consumption of eggs by producers during October was 3.7 million dozen.

FROZEN EGGS: Processing to frozen egg during October, 1957 in all plants under inspection reporting to the Department of Agriculture and in uninspected plants reporting to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics was 1,200,636 pounds.
