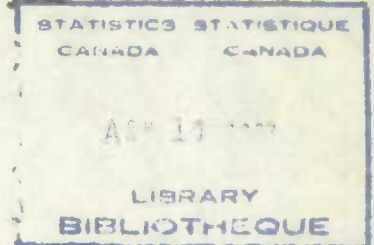

PRODUCTION OF EGGS

November, 1957



The estimated production of eggs in Canada ^{1/} during November was 40.1 million dozen, as compared with 37.2 million dozen last month and the 36.4 million dozen for November last year. The estimate of egg production during the first eleven months of 1957 was 408.1 million dozen compared with 364.4 ^{2/} million dozen for the same period in 1956.

Average egg production per layer during November was 14.6 eggs compared with 13.7 eggs last month. The rate of lay for November 1956 was 14.0.

Producers sold 35.8 million dozen eggs for market during November compared with the October estimate of 33.0 million dozen. Estimated consumption of eggs by producers during November was 3.6 million dozen.

FROZEN EGGS: Processing to frozen egg during November 1957, in all plants under inspection reporting to the Department of Agriculture and in uninspected plants reporting to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics was 911,643 pounds.
