PRODUCTION OF EGGS

August, 1957

The estimated production of eggs in Canada 1/during August was 32.9 million dozen, as compared with 33.0 million dozen last month and the 29.8 million dozen for August last year. The estimate of egg production during the first eight months of 1957 was 296.2 million dozen compared with 264.0 2/million dozen for the same period in 1956.

Average egg production per layer during August was 13.7 eggs compared with 14.9 eggs last month. The rate of lay for August, 1956 was 14.4.

Producers sold 28.4 million dozen eggs for market during August compared with the July estimate of 28.3 million dozen. Estimated consumption of eggs by producers during August was 4.0 million dozen.

FROZEN EGGS: Processing to frozen egg during August, 1957 in all plants under inspection reporting to the Department of Agriculture and in uninspected plants reporting to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics was 905,442 pounds.
