PRODUCTION OF EGGS

January, 1958

The estimated production of eggs in Canada 1/ during January, 1958 was 41.6 million dozen as compared with revised estimates of 42.0 million dozen in December, 1957 and 40.1 million dozen in January, 1957.

Average egg production per layer during January was 16.3 eggs as compared with 16.1 during December and 15.6 in January, 1957.

Producers sold 36.5 million dozen eggs for market during January, 1958 compared with the revised estimate of 37.1 million dozen eggs during the previous month. The estimated consumption of eggs by producers during January was 4.1 million dozen,

FROZEN EGGS: Processing to frozen egg in all plants under inspection reporting to the Department of Agriculture and in uninspected plants reporting to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics during January. 1958 was 1,299,139 pounds as compared with 2,241,696 pounds in January, 1957.

NOTE: Revised estimates of numbers of layers and of egg production for the months June to December, 1956 and 1957, are included on pages 3 and 4 of this report. This revision makes these estimates comparable to the revised estimates for the months January to May as published in the July issue. That is, monthly estimates have been revised on the basis of semi-annual survey and Census data. The revised estimate of net egg production for the year 1957 was 446.476 million dozen compared to 404,311 million dozen in 1956.
