#### PRODUCTION OF EGGS

May, 1958

The estimated production of eggs in Canada 1/during May was 38.6 million dozen, as compared with 39.9 million dozen last month and the 38.5 million dozen for May last year. The estimate of egg production during the first five months of 1958 was 197.1 million dozen compared with 195.8 million dozen for the same period in 1957.

Average egg production per layer during May was 17.3 eggs compared with 17.3 eggs last month. The rate of lay for May 1957 was 17.0.

Producers sold 32.9 million dozen eggs for market during May compared with the April estimate of 33.4 million dozen. Estimated consumption of eggs by producers during May was 4.6 million dozen, 4.5 million dozen in May 1957.

FROZEN EGGS: Processing to frozen egg during May 1958, in all plants under inspection reporting to the Department of Agriculture was 2,319,530 pounds as compared with 2,222,125 pounds in May 1957.
