PRODUCTION OF EGGS

August, 1958

The estimated production of eggs in Canada 1/ during August was 34.0 million dozen as compared with the July estimate of 33.9 million dozen and the 32.4 million dozen during August last year. The estimate of egg production during the first eight months of 1958 was 299.1 million dozen compared with 295.4 for the same period in 1957.

Average egg production per layer during August was 14.5 eggs as compared with 15.6 eggs last month, and 13.7 in August 1957.

Producers sold 29.0 million dozen eggs for market during August compared with the July estimate of 28.7 million dozen. Estimated consumption of eggs by producers during August was 4.1 million dozen.

FROZEN EGGS: Processing to frozen egg during August, 1958 in all plants under inspection reporting to the Department of Agriculture was 2,141,002 pounds.

Turkey Marketings in 1958. According to marketing intentions reported by turkey producers at August 1 in a special survey conducted by the Bureau of Statistics, the total number of turkeys to be marketed this year is expected to be about 15 per cent greater than last year's output. However, due to a larger proportion of light weight birds in this year's marketings, total turkey meat production is not expected to change appreciably from that of last year.

Output of turkeys to the end of July is estimated at 1,565,000 birds of which over 1,000,000 were under ten pounds live weight. Almost 75 per cent of the birds marketed before the end of July were from Eastern Canada but total marketings for the rest of the year are expected to be almost equal as between East and West.

If the turkey marketing intentions reported at the beginning of August are carried out 45 per cent of the balance of this year's output in the East will be marketed before Thanksgiving and 55 per cent later. August to December marketings in the West are expected to be in the proportions of 35 and 65 per cent before and after Thanksgiving, respectively.
