PRODUCTION OF EGGS

September, 1958

The estimated production of eggs in Canada^{1/} during September was 34.1 million dozen as compared with the August estimate of 34.0 million dozen and the 33.9 million dozen produced during September last year. The estimate of egg production during the first nine months of 1958 was 333.2 million dozen compared with 329.3 for the same period in 1957.

Average egg production per layer during September was 13.3 eggs as compared with 14.5 eggs last month, and 13.2 in September 1957.

Producers sold 29.5 million dozen eggs for market during September compared with the August estimate of 29.0 million dozen. Estimated consumption of eggs by producers during August was 4.0 million dozen.

FROZEN EGGS: Processing to frozen egg during September, 1958 in all plants under inspection reporting to the Department of Agriculture was 1,145,882.
