## PRODUCTION OF EGGS

June, 1959

The preliminary estimate of egg production in Canada 1/during June was 37,314,000 as compared with 34,977,000 for the same month last year. This increase, amounting to 6.7 per cent, was attributable to an increase in both rate of lay and number of layers. Between May and June 1959 a seasonal decline of 4.5 per cent in the number of layers, together with a lower rate of lay, resulted in a decline in production of 10.7 per cent. Revised estimates for the first 6 months of 1959, based on the Semi-Annual Crop and Livestock Survey, will be published in the July issue of this publication.

Producers sold 31.8 million dosen eggs for market during June compared to 29.7 million dozen in June 1958 and 35.5 in May 1959. Although more eggs were sold for market than in June 1958 their value decreased from \$10,991,000 to \$9,969,000.

The preliminary estimate of egg production for the first six months of 1959 was 243,443,000 an increase of 5.3 per cent from the first half of 1958. Of the eggs produced up to the end of June, the three Maritime Provinces accounted for 7.6 per cent; Quebec, 14.3 per cent; Ontario, 41.4 per cent; the Prairies, 28.5 per cent; and British Columbia, 8.2 per cent.

FROZEN EGGS: Processing to frozen egg in all plants under inspection reporting to the Department of Agriculture during June 1959 was 4,319,354 pounds as compared with 2,754,048 pounds in June 1958.
